Illinois' Game-Changing Pay Transparency Law is Here!

Attention Illinois Businesses with 15+ Employees: A significant shift in hiring practices has arrived. The Pay Transparency amendment to the Illinois Equal Pay Act of 2023 is now in effect, as of January 1st. This means some crucial changes to how you advertise jobs and internal promotions. Are you prepared to comply?

Here's what you need to know:

- Show the Money (and Benefits): Forget vague salary ranges. For every external job posting, you're now required to clearly state the pay scale and a general description of the benefits offered.
- Internal Opportunities Out in the Open: When a promotion opportunity arises, you have 14 days to announce it, post it, or otherwise make it known to all your current employees.

This amendment isn't just a suggestion – it's the law. Understanding and implementing these requirements is essential for your business. Don't get caught off guard! **MORE**







Apartment rents expected to accelerate across country as demand stays solid, completions moderate

U.S. Apartment Rent Growth



Apartment rents across the United States are expected to accelerate at a quicker clip in the second quarter as demand remains solid and the number of units completed continues to slow.

Nationally, year-over-year multifamily asking rents grew 1.1% this year through March, according to a report from Apartments.com, owned by CoStar Group. That is the same rate as the fourth quarter of 2024. Actual rents rose about 1% from the first quarter of 2024, according to the report.

The national average on a rent-per-unit basis ended the first quarter at \$1,754 monthly compared to \$1,735 monthly at the end of the first quarter of last year, Apartments.com found. MORE
