OUR VISITORS



RTFC was originally founded in 1875 but it's not until 1896 that we find references to a Reserve Team which seems to be playing friendlies against Cambridge based sides. During the early years of the 20th century this pattern continued before we find the team playing in the Cambs League before switching to the Buntingford and District League where they were crowned League champions twice in three seasons [1921/22 and 1923/24]

Throughout the 1930's they had switched back to the Cambs League and immediately after the end of WW2 won the Cambs Junior Cup 1946/47 beating Swavesey 2-1 in the final. The Club then moved into the Herts County League, then to the South Midlands League in 1959/60 before completing a full circle by returning to the Herts County league where both the first and reserve teams enjoyed successful championship winning campaigns. But it didn't stop there, and in 1977/78 both teams were back in the South Midlands League where the Reserves won successive League titles in 1978/79 and 1979/80.

The period 1984-1994 saw the club competing in the Isthmian League which for the first team proved a very challenging period but in contrast the Reserve under the management of John Halliwell picked up two pieces of silverware by winning the Herts Intermediate Cup and the T.V. Sports Cup with a squad of very talented young Royston based players.

The next 18 seasons saw the Club competing in the South Midlands League with the low point being in 2006/07 with relegation from the Premier League to

Division 1 at Step 6 in the non-league pyramid. The appointment of Paul Attfield as Club manager at the start of 2007/08 season proved highly significant. Paul had previously worked for the Club as Youth/ Reserve Team manager and had continued to put his faith in young players which proved to be the bedrock of his success in taking the Club to win promotion to Step 4 football in the Southern Central League. It was during this period that Kevin Wilson led the Reserves to a South Midlands double, winning the League Championship and the Reserve Challenge Cup followed later by the South Midlands Floodlit Reserve Cup in 2009/10.

For the season 2012-13 the Reserves were elected to the Suburban League North and by winning their last three games they managed to snatch the League Title by one

point from Ashford Town. The following season they won the title again in even more dramatic style overtaking Tring Athletic on the last day of the season by a goal difference of 3!

Having secured promotion the team played for the next six seasons in the Suburban Premier League under the management of Aidrian Cambridge until the challenges of travelling to most of our away games south of the Thames began to inhibit the recruitment and retention of players. A return to the Herts County Premier League proved to be a much more workable option with Lewis Endacott at the helm. In the season 2021/22 the Reserves were the last club to win the Aubrey Cup, considered by many to be one of most prestigious trophies in the Hertfordshire football.

In the following season Dan Evans took on the task of developing a more integrated approach between our under 18's and the Reserves by forming the Under 23's who went on to finish 4th and accepted the invitation to play at Step 6 by joining the South Midlands Division One League.

After a successful first season in 23/24 where we finished a respectable 10th position as well as being the team of the month in December 2023 we go into our 2nd season with a new manager after Dan Evans left in the summer to take up a joint manager position at a Step 3 club. With a new manager at the helm, Franco Nacca, and an exciting young team, we are looking forward to the 24/25 season.

A LITTLE more than 11 miles separate Aldershot Town and Woking with the rivals sharing some epic encounters down the years.

We could be in for another next month when the duo meet at the Shots' EBB Stadium in the Isuzu FA Trophy semi-final – a place at Wembley on the line. Aldershot have never played at the home of English football. Woking have lifted the Trophy three times, although not since 1997. It's a huge game guaranteed to command a full house.

Aldershot beat Sittingbourne 3-0 in the quarter-finals, finally ending the Step 4 side's remarkable campaign that saw them beat National League Southend United in the last 16.

"A lot of teams from divisions above Sittingbourne have fallen on their sword," Aldershot boss Tommy Widdrington said. "They have had an unbelievable run and we were under no illusions. We knew it wasn't going to be a walk in the park."

Woking certainly had no stroll in their quarter at Oxford City. Needing a late Inih Effiong equaliser to make it 2-2 and force penalties, the two sides then shared a miss-filled shoot-out. The Cards won it 2-1 after keeper Will Jaaskelainen saved three of Oxford's four misses before planting home the winner himself.

"I am standing here due to fantastic goalkeeping heroics and even then we nearly blew them through the penalties, and I am really flat we were that bad," an irked Woking boss Neal Ardley admitted.

Spennymoor Town led the headlines on Saturday evening. Main man Glen Taylor scored twice as the National League North side dumped out Step 1 Sutton United.

"It's hard work winning football games, it hurts and it's painful, but when you get a result like that it's worth it," boss Graeme Lee said.

Spenny will face Rochdale in the semis, who came through a tricky encounter against Altrincham 2-0.

Of course, Spennymoor lifted the FA Vase back in 2013 when they beat Tunbridge Wells on the hallowed turf.

The Vase is also down to the final four. There was late drama at Whistable Town where a 2,656 crowd saw the hosts come from 2-0 down to win 3-2 when Harry Smith converted the rebound of his own penalty.

“It was an unbelievable turnaround from being 2-0 down,” manager Jamie Coyle said. “To turn that around and into a win, that’s testament to the players.”

They have been drawn against Hartpury University for the two-legged semi-finals, with Andover New Street making the most of their reprieve earlier in the competition to reach this stage and set-up a semi with AFC Whyteleafe.

Wembley awaits on Sunday, May 11. We’re close to knowing which four teams will be there.

CLUB HISTORY

Buckingham Football Club is a football club based in Buckingham, Buckinghamshire, England. Formed by a merger of Buckingham Athletic and Buckingham United in 2023, they are currently members of the Spartan South Midlands League Division One and play at Stratford Fields.

The club was first formed in 1933 as **Buckingham Juniors**, but it was three years before a ground was found, allowing the club to enter the Brackley and District League. When they got their ground, it was originally called Timm's Meadow, before later becoming Stratford Fields. In 1939 the club adopted **Buckingham Athletic FC** as its name. It then took the club 27 years to win its first trophy when in 1960–61 they won their first trophy, the North Bucks League Shield.

In 1965 they applied and was accepted to the Hellenic League where they played in Division 1 finishing a creditable mid-table position in their first season but also won the Berks & Bucks FA Junior Cup. Their success continued and in 68/69 was promoted to the Premier Division after finishing Division runners-up.

The late 60's brought about some good success for the whole club with the Youth, Reserve and First teams all picking up trophies with the First winning the Buckinghamshire Senior Cup for the first time.

After a steady decline in fortunes in 78/79 the club returned to the North Bucks League and it wasn't until the mid-80's that further success was achieved.

This was the start of a successful period for the club and after winning the North Bucks Premier League title they moved to the South Midlands Division 1 in 1985 winning the league at their first attempt, losing only 3 games throughout the season.

However, success came too quickly, and the ground facilities were not ready for promotion to the Premier Division so they had to remain in Division 1.

The following season they were once again knocking on the door of the Premier League as they finished runners-up but a last minute hold up on planning permission once again stalled promotion. However, promotion was achieved the following year when they did the league and cup double and with correct ground grading in place the club was promoted to the Premier League for the first time.

Throughout the 90's all the teams in the club consistently won trophies

although the highest the first team achieved in the Premier League was in 97 when they finished 5th.

The late 90's the club struggled financially, and they made a very difficult decision to drop out of the top flight and they were placed back in Division 2. A level of stability was brought about the club and in 2003 they were promoted back to Division 1.

Once again ground grading held the club back as in 2004 they finished runners-up in Division 1 and promotion back to the Premier league was denied.

Since 05/06 a huge amount of work has taken place to upgrade the clubhouse and football facilities but unfortunately success on the field has been sparse.

In 2023 Buckingham Athletic started talks with Buckingham United to bring the two clubs together with the sole purpose of having one senior football team in the town.

Buckingham United FC were formed in 2011 with the sole aim of providing local grassroots football. This began as a single Sunday side playing in Deanshanger due to a lack of local facilities. After the first season the club moved to Tingewick but it was not until 2016 when the club finally moved into Buckingham to the new Lace Hill Sports and Community Centre. The club joined the North Bucks and District League before joining the South Midlands League Division Two in 2019. Here the club grew quickly providing grassroots football across various levels and abilities which peaked with eight teams by 2021, this included Saturday First and Reserves, Sunday League A & B sides, Veterans, Ladies along with an Under 21s and Under 18s.

The club reached many cup finals across the teams including winning the North Bucks and District League Division One shield in 2018. In the final season under Buckingham United the ladies side really gave the club a wonderful finally winning the Northants Premier Division Title and League Cup double.

As a result of many meetings between the clubs, both Buckingham Athletic & Buckingham United formally agreed to pass the motion to combine both clubs, creating Buckingham Football Club, which now has one of the largest offerings of adult football in the region with a structured youth pathway with our strategic partners Moretonville Junior FC.

This is not an end to Buckingham Athletic or Buckingham United, this is very much a continuation in the story of these clubs and football within the town. The history of which won't be forgotten.

The ultimate aim of combining the clubs is to provide the town with a sustainable non-league football club by sharing resources, passionate volunteers, and great sporting facilities. A club with the aim of pushing up the pyramid while also providing structured football for the community, maintaining the fun and enjoyment of the game that everyone loves.
