Directions to Easthampstead Park

By Road:

Easthampstead Park is easily accessible from the M4, M40 and M3 motorways.

From the M4: Exit at Junction 10 and follow signs for Bracknell (A329(M)). Continue on the A329 and take the exit for the A3095 towards Wokingham. Follow signs to Easthampstead Park.

From the M40: Exit at Junction 4, take the A404 towards Maidenhead. Continue and pick up the M4 at Junction 10. Follow directions as for M4 above.

From the M3: Exit at Junction 3, take the A322 towards Bracknell, then follow the A3095 towards Wokingham. Easthampstead Park is well signposted.

By Rail:

The nearest train station is Wokingham Station, which is approximately 3 miles away. Bracknell Station is also nearby (about 4 miles). Both stations are on the South Western Railway line, with regular services from London Waterloo and Reading. The Elizabeth Line also runs from Reading and nearby Twyford (8 miles)

By Public Transport:

From Wokingham or Bracknell Station, you can take a taxi or use local bus services. Bus routes serving the area include the Courtney Buses and Thames Valley Buses, which have stops within a short distance of the venue. Check local timetables for the latest schedules.
