This final year of undergraduate study gives you a bachelor's level qualification.



Financial Support

Don't let finances get in the way of studying.

We understand that it's important to get to grips with the cost of studying a university-level course. Whether you are thinking about how you will manage to pay your tuition fee or the everyday living expenses, we're here to help.

There are two types of loans to help new students cover the costs of their higher education course in college. Tuition fee and living cost loans are available if you study a full-time course, and tuition fee loans cover course fees if you study part-time.

What will I have to pay back?

You'll have to repay anything you borrow, but it works a bit differently than you might expect. How much you repay each month depends on your income, not how much you borrowed.

You won't have to repay anything until you're earning over £25,000 per annum. Once you're earning over this threshold, we'll work out your repayments at 9% of your income.

Tuition fee loans.

Tuition fee loans are available to help full-time and part-time students to pay for the cost of tuition fees. They are paid directly to the university or college by the Government.

Living cost loans (Maintenance Loans)

Students can apply for a maintenance loan

to help with living costs as long as you and AND the course you're applying for is eligible. Maintenance Loans are paid into your bank account at the start of each term.
