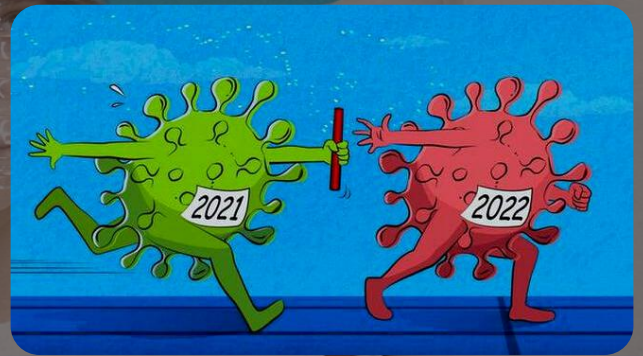
Greetings from the Coronavirus Community!

If there is any interesting and viral world affairs right now it is between Ukraine and Russia. All of us have heard about this or read it in newspapers. There is so much happening that it is hard to keep track of and to know everything as the situation and news keeps changing every second.



THE INVASION

On 21 February 2022, the Russian government claimed that Ukrainian shelling had destroyed an FSB border facility on the Russia-Ukraine border, and claimed that it had killed 5 Ukrainian soldiers who tried to cross into Russian territory. Ever since Russian troops are continuously entering Ukraine, surrounding major cities to act as a blockade while Russian military attacks with missiles. Russia has been playing siege in this war to prevent its men from dying. Russian President Vladimir Putin denies to all accusations of war crime.



HOW DID THE WAR START?

The event which has led to the current war started way back in 2014 about 8 years ago. The Verkhovna Rada had overwhelmingly supported the agreement with the EU. Russia had put pressure on Ukraine to reject it. The scope of the protests widened, with protesters opposing widespread government corruption, police brutality, and repressive anti-protest laws. In February 2014, clashes in Kyiv between protesters and Berkut special police. Leaders in Russian-speaking eastern Ukraine declared continuing loyalty to Yanukovich, leading to pro-Russian unrest. Russian state-controlled media portrayed the crisis as having been instigated by the post-Yanukovich Ukrainian government, and represented Euromaidan as being controlled by "ultranationalist", "fascist", "neo-Nazi", and "anti-Semitic" groups. The unrest was followed by the annexation of Crimea by Russia in March 2014 and the war in Donbas, which started in April 2014 with the formation of two Russia-backed separatist quasi-states: the Donetsk People's Republic and the Luhansk People's Republic. These actions were described by commentators and Western officials as attempts to justify war

INDIA'S STAND ON THIS

What is India's stand on this?

It has been almost a month since Russia began its assault on Ukraine, killing hundreds of people and displacing more than 2 million. Besides generating a humanitarian crisis and sending shockwaves around the world, Russian President Vladimir Putin's actions in Ukraine have also put the foreign policies of the countries in the spotlight. After the Russian invasion hit India closer to home, with the killing of an Indian student in Ukraine's Kharkiv city, and hundreds of Indian students still awaiting evacuation, Last week, P Chidambaram, an Indian parliamentarian from the opposition Congress party, tweeted: "The Government of India should stop its verbal balancing act and sternly demand that Russia stop immediately the bombing of key cities in Ukraine. Meanwhile, Modi has held talks with both Putin and Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy and called for an immediate cessation of violence. Yet, on the global stage, India has abstained five times so far from condemning Russia's actions at the United Nations

EFFECTS OF WAR ON INDIAN ECO.

India's trade, comprises only 1% oil imports from Russia, but there could be a spillover impact in the form of high inflation and sluggish growth. On March 13, Morgan Stanley lowered India's GDP forecast for the fiscal year 2023 by 50 basis points to 7.9%,

citing risks to macro stability due to high crude oil prices. India depends on imports to meet up to 85% of its crude oil needs. The surge in international oil prices to a 14-year high will now result in broader price pressures. Analysts conclude that the impact on India's economy will be felt mostly through higher cost-push inflation weighing in on all economic agents—households, businesses, and government..

PEACE TALKS

No breakthrough has been achieved so far, but Zelenskyy on Monday again called for talks with his Russian counterpart Vladimir Putin as Ukrainian cities are reeling from war and devastation, and with nearly a quarter of the country's 44 million people displaced from their homes. Russia has sought assurances that Ukraine will renounce any plans to join NATO – a demand Kyiv seems willing to agree. President Putin has accused the United States of using Ukraine to threaten Moscow. The Russian leader has also justified the invasion saying Moscow was defending against the "genocide" of Russian-speaking people by Ukraine. He recognised the breakaway regions days before launching the invasion on February 24. Ukraine says Putin's claims of genocide are nonsense.

Since then, many national civil calendars in the Western World and beyond have changed to using one fixed date for New Year's Day, January 1—most doing so when they adopted the Gregorian calendar.

VACCINATION DRIVE



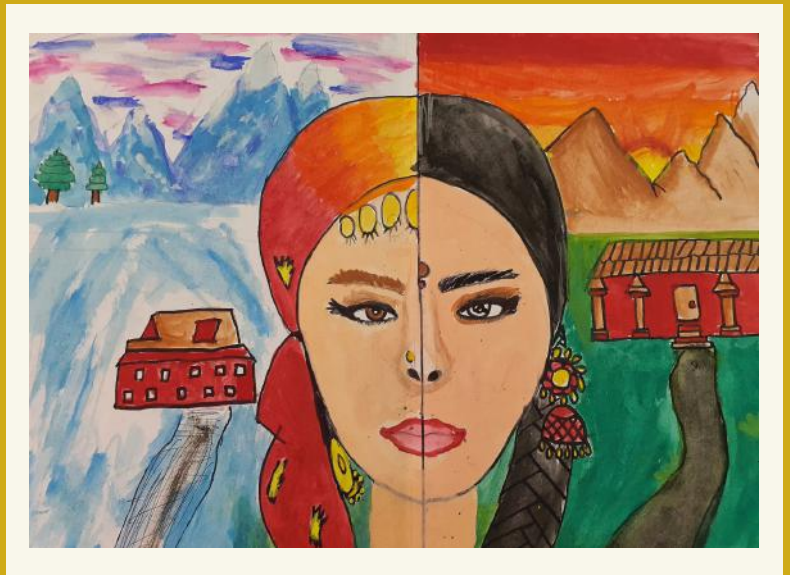
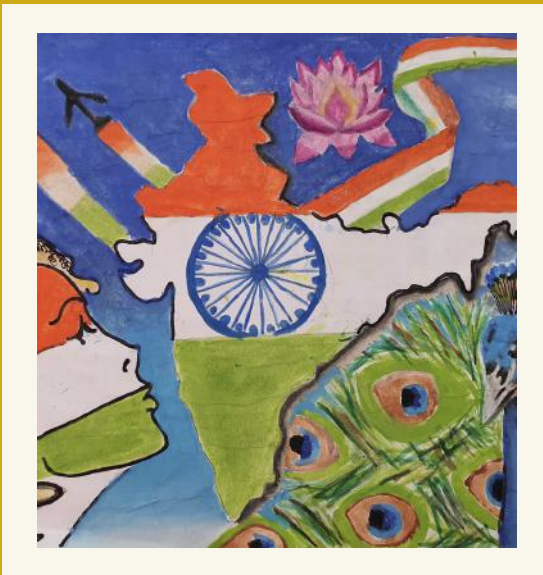
