Through early detection and intervention, Cochlea Pune has become a beacon of hope for children from the ages of 0 to 6 years. Over the years, we have grown from a single classroom to a network that reaches beyond Pune, providing support even in rural areas and other regions like Goa. Today, we are proud to be helping over 125 children develop essential hearing and speaking skills.



THE SWARANAAD PRE-SCHOOL: A SPECIAL PLACE FOR SPECIAL CHILDREN

Our Swaranaad Pre-School is at the heart of our efforts. This specialised pre-school provides children with the skills to communicate, understand, and confidently join mainstream education. Last year alone, we welcomed 22 new children to the pre-school, which continues to grow in enrolment. Through dedicated programs focusing on language, mathematics, and general knowledge, these children are gaining the confidence they need for the future.





Our Swaranaad Pre-School remains at the core of our mission. It provides children with a nurturing environment to learn essential skills in language, mathematics, and general knowledge. Through personalised programs, the children gain the confidence to join mainstream schools. The project provides essential post operation care, providing the children and parents essential education, which without, the cochlear implant is worthless.



A PERSONAL STORY: ASAWARI'S JOURNEY

Take the case of Asawari Kulkarni, a young girl suffering from progressive hearing loss. For her, hearing aids no longer provide any benefit. Without a cochlear implant, Asawari's career and life opportunities would have been severely limited.

Thankfully, with support from Sewa UK, she is now on a path to a brighter future, and is now working as a Graduate Trainee Data Analyst for a German company.

COCHLEAR IMPLANTS: CHANGING LIVES FOREVER

Cochlear implants have revolutionised how we address profound sensorineural hearing loss. Unlike hearing aids, which merely amplify sounds, cochlear implants bypass damaged parts of the ear to directly stimulate the auditory nerve, providing a sense of hearing to those who are profoundly deaf.
