Programming and Curriculum

Children learn by exploration, experimentation and observation. The first 5 years of life is a time of rapid growth and development, where every moment matters.

We enable our little ones to expand their growing awareness and appreciation of the world around them, working to establish a strong sense of curiosity, critical for future learning.

Our program and curriculum are continually evolving and carefully considered to be inspiring and wonderful, whilst ensuring safety and connection is our highest priority.

We believe that every child should be able to develop at their own pace but with the right support and guidance. Our programs introduce structured activities that are age-appropriate and based around child-led interests.

Fostering a passion for learning, we introduce early numeracy and literacy as children grow in a gentle and measured manner. As social and emotional intelligence takes leaps and bounces, activities around group interaction and participation are encouraged, whilst respecting personality and individuality.

As children become preschoolers, we weave school readiness concepts into our Kindy rooms. We include a variety of regular incursions and excursions to provide an opportunity for knowledge and interest expansion, as well as yoga and mindfulness exercises to allow for little minds to flow and little bodies to stretch.

We see every child as an individual who deserves their own ongoing learning and development plan to ensure they reach their full potential and are school ready! We set individual learning goals and provide 6 monthly check-ins on your child's development with families.





Environments

Your little one learns through the building and sustaining of relationships, through interaction and engagement with others. The environment in which they spend their time is therefore an essential space, designed to facilitate and foster learning and creativity.

Early childhood is a time of discovery; and structured lesson plans are no match for genuine interest when it comes to learning. Our environments initiate self-discovery and intrigue.

Our beautiful Early Learning Sanctuary has been carefully designed to allow deep connection with nature to create conversation and catalyst for learning. Our purpose-built centre offers an abundance of natural light and easy access to the great outdoors.

Our environments are built with nature and natural play at their centre, with wood and other environmentally-sound materials carefully selected. We want to create environments where your little one is able to run, discover and play like children of days gone by. Safety is always considered, but with room for the adventurous at heart to explore and to build all-important gross motor skills.

School Readiness

Ready, Set, School.

The transition into formal schooling can be exceptionally daunting. We will nurture your little one through these years and the emotional, social and physical skill set required.

This program has been specifically designed for our children who are preparing to start school in the coming years and will equip them with all the necessary skills and knowledge to allow for their seamless transition into the formal school environment.

Our School Readiness program includes developing those independent skills, such as putting on and taking off coats, shoes and other clothing items. Placing our items back into our own bag. Asking to refill our water bottle and having a go ourself. Independent toileting and hygiene practices. Opening a lunchbox and closing it back up before we stow it away. Nothing overly daunting but just bit-by-bit support for the foundational aspects to their school day and building gentle confidence around them.

Our preschool program teaches children about sustainability and learning about the world around us. We incorporate sustainable practices into our daily routine including the importance of recycling and being an active member in our community.

In addition, we assist children to build self regulation skills and awareness of oneself. Through fun activities children will learn about teamwork, sharing, cooperating, showing empathy and turn taking.

Children can learn through play and fun, they just need the right guide. Let us guide your little one into this exciting new phase of their life



Nutrition

Ensuring your little one is healthy, satiated and nourished is a passion for us; and so, Food Education is an essential component in each and every day.

Our menus have been carefully designed by our team of chefs, ensuring a wholesome, healthy diet packed with a variety of fresh fruits and vegetables, based around Australian Dietary Guidelines, but with informed input from Nutritionists.

All of our meals are cooked in-house by our professional Cook and our menus are seasonal and based around locally and responsibly sourced ingredients. Our program encourages healthy eating and home-grown produce.

As little ones start to express eating preference and develop their own palate, we create conversation around food preference and use group meal times as a way of gently encouraging through peer imitation and positive reinforcement. Eating is never forced, and little tummies are respected.

We are a nut conscious centre and will ensure all food allergies are respected and given paramount importance. The safety of your little one is always our first and foremost concern.







People

After over 28-years of owning and operating Early Childhood services, we have complete confidence in our ability to recognise those who are passionate about what they do. We know what we are looking for and we definitely know when we find it.

6-weeks to Confident Walker

There is no point in a journey more important, than the start.

Returning to work after having your baby is an extremely emotional time; and a monumental adjustment for you and your little one. We understand the challenges and the triumphs, the sleep deprivation and overwhelming to-do lists, not to mention the transition into a brand-new routine for your family.



Whether this is your first child, or you've been here before, we understand you will want to be kept informed about not just the particulars of eating, sleeping, nappies and mood; but of those precious little moments that make this time so special. Smiles, laughs, rolling, crawling, first friends, comforters, starting solids and your little one's ever-emerging personality. We will ensure you feel connected and comforted.

Our Nursery Room is a safe and nurturing place for your baby to thrive. The Educators in this room are handpicked as our most nurturing, attentive and in-tune. The environment is carefully considered to be inspiring and wondrous but also safe, as this is the age of exploration and discovery, with everything ending up inside little mouths.

The first year of life is a time of rapid growth and development, where every moment matters. Enabling our littlest ones to expand their growing awareness and appreciation of the world around them is imperative and works to establish a strong sense of curiosity, critical for future learning.

We also understand however; that during this time of boundary testing and exploration, the world can be a scary and overwhelming place at times, so our focus, more than anything else, is to ensure that equally important sense of safety and connection.



Babies

Confident Walker to 2 years

So much to do and so much to learn,
for such little people.



The progression from Baby to Toddler is a time of rapid development and milestones. A time of intense discovery and exploration as your little one learns to walk, learns to talk and starts to develop an even deeper sense of their environment. With this discovery of new skills, comes the intensifying of new emotions and a greater sense of self. Big leaps and even bigger emotions.

In our Babies Room, we nurture little ones and allow them to develop that all-important sense self and independence; whilst balancing their need for security and stability. Relationships come to the forefront, as they learn to decipher trust and navigate the tricky politics of first friendships through parallel play.

We believe that every child should be able to develop at their own pace but with the right support and guidance. Here we start to introduce some structured activity, based around child-led interests.

Sensory development and messy-play are introduced to encourage creative freedom and imagination, an all-important stepping stone on the way to fostering a love of learning.

Our environment is designed to inspire imagination and so, you'll find a lot of spare parts, life objects and blank canvasses to encourage your little one to create for themselves. We aim to encourage, never overwhelm.

Children are always able to choose what they engage with and learn; they will never be forced to participate. Whilst we have a Room Routine to allow consistency, there is always flexibility and freedom.

We will work with you on nap times, eating preferences, comforters, interests, likes, dislikes and any other aspect of their day you feel is important. The care and comfort of your little one is our number one priority.

Our babies are introduced to the natural world from a young age, utilising 4-seater strollers to enable them to join us on wonderful excursions in the countryside.

Toddlers

2 to 3-years

A time when first friendships develop, and sense of self strengthens.

Parallel play turns to social play and a whole new world opens up for little ones, as they learn, not just from the ideas they conjure; but from those born of the imaginations of others.

As your Toddler starts to step ever-so-lightly towards school readiness, their thirst for answers to their questions intensifies. The endless seeking of knowledge and information is the perfect time to gently introduce a more structured learning environment, without stepping away from our ethos of child-led learning opportunities.

Through our carefully constructed internal and external environments, we create catalysts of wonderment and excitement. Fostering a passion for learning and introducing early numeracy and literacy in a gentle and measured manner.

Social and emotional intelligence takes leaps and bounds at this age, so activities focused around group interaction and participation are encouraged, whilst respecting personality and individuality.

Awareness of toileting and development of taste preferences and palate are also key milestones at this age, so we work with you on developing these important areas.

Building relationships and ensuring happy and healthy body, mind and soul is at the heart of our Toddler Room, for this is where Tall Trees grow.



Kindy



3 to 5-years

A time in childhood to celebrate freedom, imagination and first friendships, as your little one tip toes towards starting school.

Such a special time that can never be recreated. Never again will a time so full of wonderment and freedom exist. In their final years of pre-school, we believe children should enjoy the pure delight of being children. Running in fresh air, creating at will, climbing, imagining, forming a firm foundation of positivity and well-being, from which their future can spring.

Programming and curriculum come more to the fore, to support developmental milestones. We work with you on any areas of concern in a positive and proactive manner, tailored to the personality and learning style of your child.

The transition into formal schooling can be exceptionally daunting. We will nurture your little one through these years and the emotional, social and physical skill set required.

Through the forged partnerships we have in place with the local primary schools, we have arranged for our children to attend regular excursions, to get a firsthand feel for the school environment and routines they will face during their time in school. Our **Qualified Early Childhood Teacher** also works closely with the Kindy and Pre Primary Teachers to make sure that our curriculum is on track with what the schools are teaching, further enabling our children's smooth transition into school. We weave intentional learning moments delivered in a way that's fun and engaging.

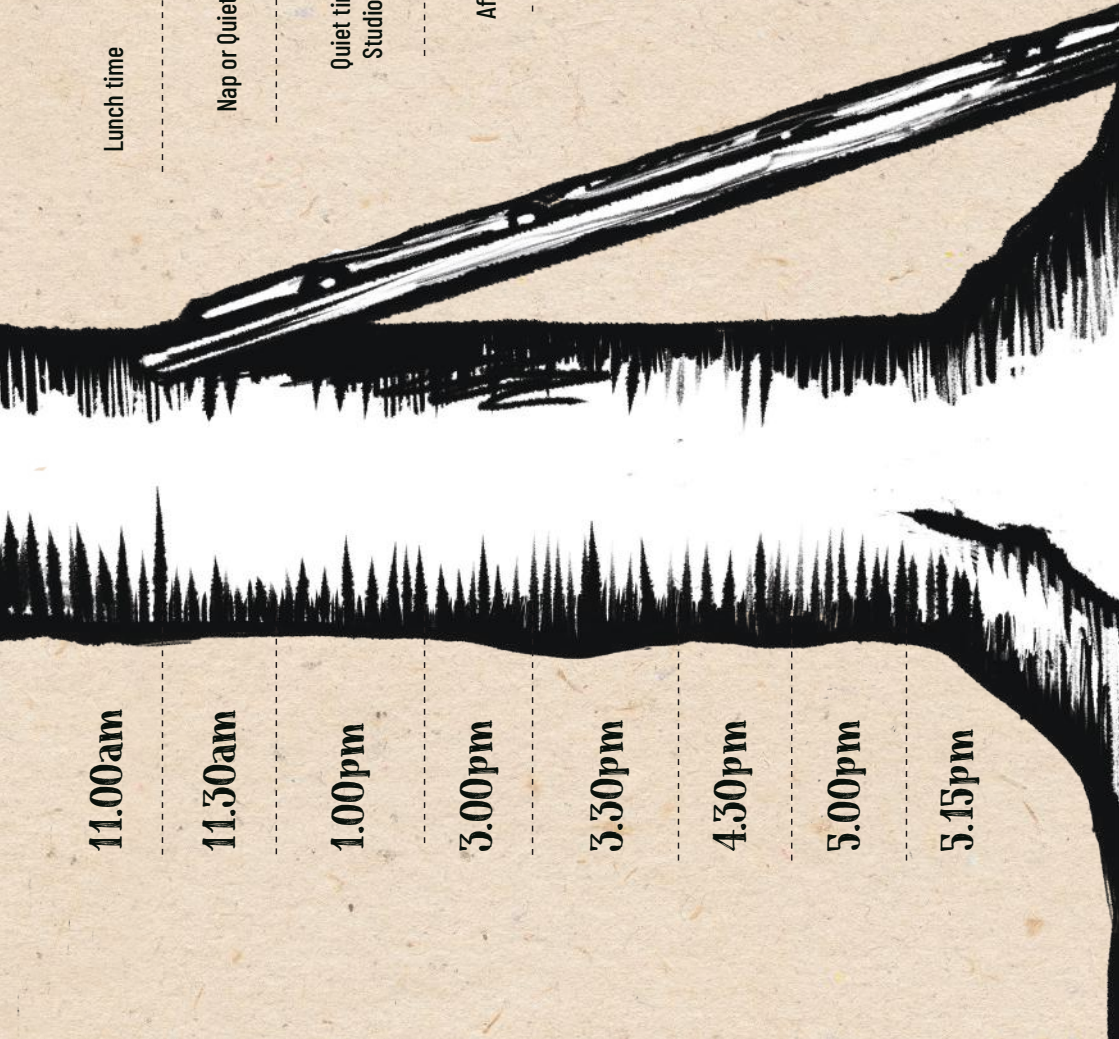

What to pack in my bag

- A backpack for all my belongings
- 4 x nappies (if required) or a change or two of underwear just in case
- Nappy cream (if required)
- Breast milk or formula (if required)
- Bottles (if required)
- Water bottle with my name on it
- Changes of clothes (see note below)
- Long-sleeved t-shirt for outdoor play
- Hat for outdoor play (Bucket or Legionnaire style, no peak caps)
- Seasonally-appropriate clothing (Jumper or Jacket for cooler months)
- A raincoat/waterproofs in Winter
- Sunscreen (if there's a certain brand I need)
- Please clearly label all my belongings so I know they're mine.



Just a little note on clothing...

Early Childhood is messy and fun business. We ask that you only send little one's in clothes you are happy to come home paint-stained, muddy, scuffed or otherwise.

We like to let children, be children.

We cannot guarantee clothes will be returned in the condition you drop them off, so please only send children in clothing you are happy to be 'learned in'.
