

After a rewarding day on the greens, return to the ship for dinner as you set sail. Relax on board as the cruise continues down the Seine toward your next destination.




DAY 3 Rouen's History and Optional Golf at Champ de Bataille

Rouen

Les Andelys & Mantes-La-Jolie


Golf at Le Golf National – Albatros Course



SELECTED GOLF CLUBS



1 Aigle Course of Le Golf National

Located near the Palace of Versailles, Le Golf National is an iconic club and home to the Open de France. The Aigle course, designed by Hubert Chesneau and Robert von Hagge, features traditional links-style fairways, manicured greens, and minimal hazards, creating a challenging experience for all skill levels.

Champ de Bataille Golf Club

Situated on the grounds of Château du Champ de Bataille in Upper Normandy, this woodland course is set within 370 acres of historic parkland. Designed by Robin Nelson and Thierry Huau, it winds through natural valleys, lakes, and forest, offering a scenic yet challenging game amidst centuries-old trees and springtime blooms.

3 Golf d'Étretat

Perched atop Étretat's cliffs with views of the English Channel, Golf d'Étretat is one of France's top seaside courses. Established in 1908, this historic 18-hole course offers dramatic cliff-edge fairways and unique challenges, especially across its back nine.

Barrière de Deauville Golf Club (optional)

Located near Deauville on Mont Canisy, Barrière de Deauville Golf Club is known for its scenic views and technical challenges. The course, designed by Tom Simpson and Henry Cotton, features three 9-hole layouts that mix parkland and tree-lined holes, making it a favorite for experienced golfers.

Albatros Course of Le Golf National

Designed as the permanent home of the Open de France, the Albatros course at Le Golf National is renowned for its risk/reward layout and Ryder Cup legacy. With undulating fairways, links-style bunkers, and water hazards around the final holes, it offers a masterful blend of traditional links and target golf.
