About Us

Angels LoveNest Sanctuary is South Africa's first dedicated residential Non-Profit Company (NPC) providing integrated addiction recovery and family preservation services for single mothers—without separating them from their children.

Registered under the Companies Act of 2008, Angels LoveNest Sanctuary was established to address a critical gap in traditional rehabilitation models, where mothers are often forced to choose between recovery and retaining custody of their children. We believe that healing is most effective when families are preserved, bonds are protected, and dignity is restored.

Rooted in faith and guided by compassion, our Sanctuary offers a secure, home-like environment where mothers can heal, parent, and rebuild their lives while remaining the primary caregivers to their children.

Our Mission

To provide a faith-rooted residential sanctuary that enables single mothers battling substance abuse to recover, parent their children, rebuild their lives, and restore their families through compassionate, integrated care

Our Vision

To pioneer and scale a national model of family-centred addiction recovery that eliminates mother-child separation barriers and breaks cycles of intergenerational trauma across South Africa.

Our Core Values

- Faith-Based Compassion – We serve with love, grace, and purpose.
- Family Unity & Child Protection – Mothers and children heal together in safety.
- Holistic Support – Addressing physical, emotional, spiritual, and economic needs.
- Dignity & Empowerment – Restoring self-worth and independence
- Transparency & Accountability – Ethical governance and responsible stewardship.

The Need We Address

Substance abuse among women—particularly single mothers—remains a growing crisis in South Africa. Many mothers avoid treatment due to fear of losing custody of their children, while conventional rehabilitation facilities rarely accommodate infants and young children.

As a result:

- Mothers remain trapped in addiction.
- Children are exposed to unstable and traumatic environments.
- Cycles of addiction and family breakdown continue across generations.

Angels LoveNest Sanctuary responds directly to this challenge by treating the mother and child as a unit—healing families, not separating them.



Our Programs & Services

Angels LoveNest Sanctuary offers a structured 12–18 month residential recovery programme in a safe, nurturing environment.

1. Medical & Addiction Recovery

- Medically supervised detox through professional partnerships
- Individual and group counselling
- Relapse prevention using evidence-based and faith-integrated approaches

2. Parenting & Child Development

- Age-appropriate childcare support
- Parenting education and attachment-building activities
- Early childhood development interventions to reduce trauma

3. Life Skills & Economic Empowerment

- Vocational and skills training
- Financial literacy education
- Job readiness, placement support, and entrepreneurship guidance

4. Spiritual & Emotional Support

- Bible studies and prayer groups
- Trauma-informed counselling
- Mentorship and pastoral care

5. Aftercare & Reintegration

- Transitional housing pathways
- Ongoing support groups
- Community and church-based reintegration

Initial Capacity: 10–15 mother-and-child pairs (infants to approximately 6–8 years), with scalable growth over 3–5 years.

Governance & Management

Angels LoveNest Sanctuary is registered as a Non-Profit Company (NPC) with the Companies and Intellectual Property Commission (CIPC) and governed by a Memorandum of Incorporation (MOI).

Planned professional roles include a Program Manager, Clinical Lead (Addiction Specialist), Social Worker, Childcare Coordinator, and Administrative Staff. All staff and volunteers undergo background checks and comply with child protection legislation.

Partnerships & Compliance

- Medical professionals for detox and treatment
- Department of Social Development (DSD) for referrals and compliance
- Churches and faith-based organisations for volunteer and spiritual support
- NGOs and corporate partners for skills development and funding

The organisation is pursuing:

- NPO Registration with the Department of Social Development
- PBO Status with SARS to enable tax-deductible donations (Section 18A) Marketing and Outreach

Funding & Sustainability

Angels LoveNest Sanctuary is funded through:

- Local and international grants
- Corporate Social Investment (CSI) partnerships
- Fundraising events
- Potential government subsidies

Funds are allocated responsibly to ensure programme impact, operational sustainability, and transparent reporting.
