



2026 Schedule of Fees

RESIDENCY PERIOD

Residency fees are charged for the full academic year, excluding the semester vacation weeks, commencing at midday on the first Sunday of each semester, and ending at 10:00am on the final Sunday, as follows:

- Semester 1: Sunday 22 February to Sunday 21 June 2026
- Semester 2: Sunday 26 July to Sunday 22 November 2026

Fees are payable for the entire academic year, irrespective of whether students choose to spend days during the semesters away from College.

A. Vacation periods
