
We encourage you to **engage** with the exhibitors and use your time efficiently. They often have had a wide range of job experience themselves or have done a course that you might be interested in.

You may not be able to get around to all of the booths so pick your favourites and discover something new!



Floor Plan Coorong Pavilion



Parking

Parking is **FREE**. Limited parking in the Magpie Car Park east of the Coorong Pavilion. Ample parking on bitumen north of the Budawang pavilion and adjacent to the Quokka Pavilion. Disabled car parks are available in front of the Budawang and Coorong Pavilions.

Covid Guidelines
