Rules & Requirements

1. Fish must be caught in designated areas. Judging is done by total stringer weight for each child. **NO COMBINING FISH.** Only legal fish will be weighed in by T.P.W. rules. Tie Breaker - Angler with the most fish.
2. Maximum 30 fish per child.
3. Only one fishing pole & hook per line per child. **NO DOUBLE LEADERS!** Port Freeport does not provide fishing equipment.
4. Parent or guardian **MUST** accompany children and are not allowed to fish during the tournament.
5. Only children ages 3-14 may participate. Prizes will be awarded in two categories:
 - Blue Fins: Ages 3-8 (Parent may help bait, cast & reel)
 - Yellow Fins: Ages 9-14 (Parent may coach only)

6. Bait will be provided - anglers may bring their own dead/ artificial bait. **NO LIVE BAIT ALLOWED!**
7. A family who has won first place within the past two years cannot have a child in their family win first prize again.
8. Children of Port Freeport employees are not eligible for first - third place prizes.
9. Fishing will start and end with a horn blast.
10. **IF CAUGHT CHEATING - YOU AND YOUR FAMILY WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND ASKED TO LEAVE THE TOURNAMENT. IF YOU SUSPECT A CONTESTANT OF CHEATING, PLEASE INFORM A TOURNAMENT STAFF MEMBER.**

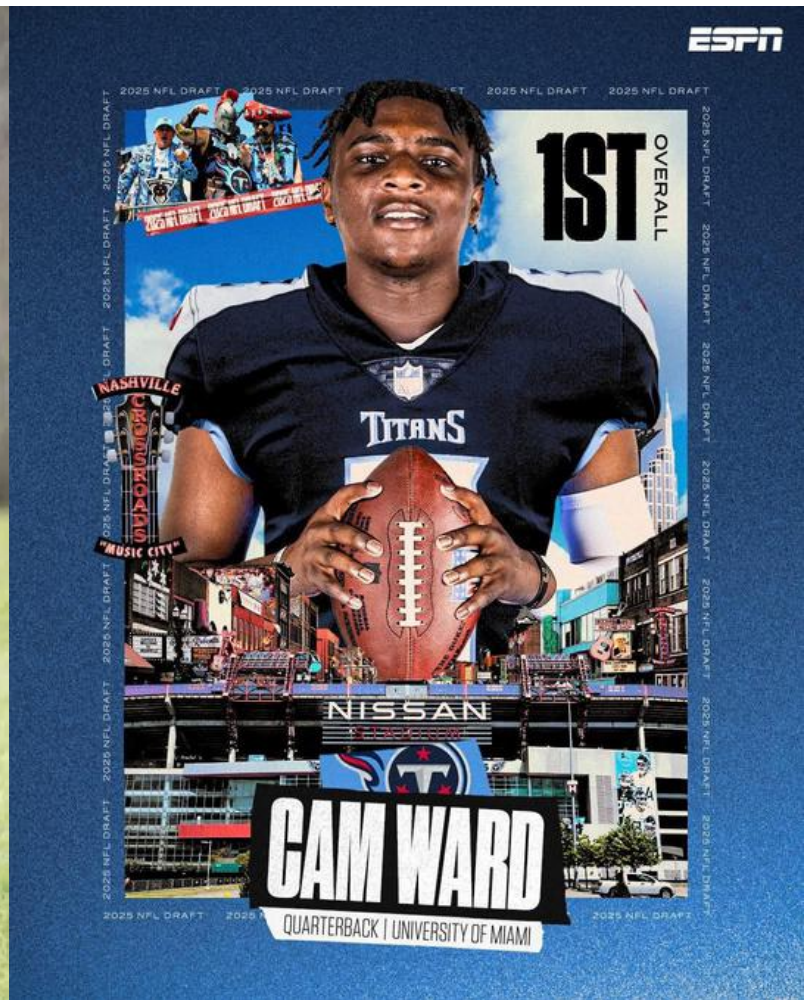
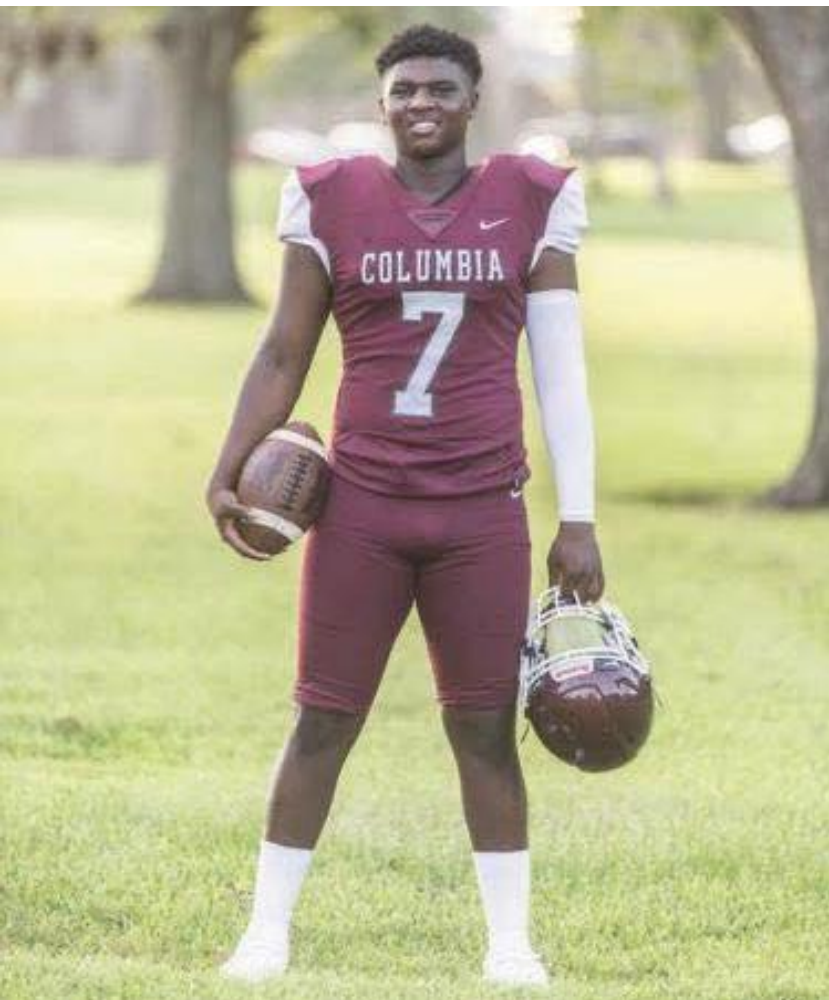
Cam Ward, former Barrow Derrickhand, has officially been selected as the first overall pick in the NFL Draft—and to say we're proud doesn't even come close!

TEXT 911

Did you know that you can Text-to-911?

Call if you can, text if you can't.

You can text 9-1-1 when it is not safe to place a 9-1-1 call, for an individual who is deaf or hard-of-hearing or if someone is in a situation where they cannot talk or during a medical emergency that renders the person incapable of speech.

How to text 9-1-1 in an emergency

Open your mobile phone's text messaging.

Enter the numbers 911 in the "To" field.

Type a message with the location of the emergency and the emergency (what is happening and whether you need police, fire or medical aid).

Press the "Send" button or arrow.

Answer questions and follow instructions from 9-1-1 call taker.

TEXT TO 9-1-1: WHEN YOU CAN'T CALL, WE'RE STILL HERE

Did you know? You can send a text message to 9-1-1 if you are unable to make a voice call.



When to Use Text to 9-1-1:

- You are deaf, hard of hearing, or have a speech disability.
- It is too dangerous to make a voice call (e.g., during a home invasion or active shooter situation).
- You are in a situation where a phone call isn't possible.



How to Text 9-1-1:

1. Open your text messaging app.
2. Enter 9-1-1 in the "To" field.
3. Type your emergency and location in the message body.
4. Send your message.
5. Respond to all of the call taker's questions.



What to Include:

- Your exact location (address, intersection, or landmarks).
- The nature of the emergency (medical, fire, or crime in progress).
- Additional details as needed to assist first responders.



Limitations:

- Texting 9-1-1 may not be available in all areas. If you do not receive a response, try calling instead.
- Do not send group texts or attach images/videos – only individual texts to 9-1-1.



Important Tips:

- Text in simple, clear language – no emojis, abbreviations, or slang.
- Stay in contact – be ready to respond to questions from 9-1-1 personnel.
- Call if you can, text if you can't – voice calls are always preferred for a faster response.
