2. COLLABORATE AND CO-CREATE



At the Women's Center in Nairobi, we are committed to providing a safe and supportive environment for women to gather and learn. Our center offers much more than just a space - it is a place where women can access meals, basic healthcare, reproductive education, and essential resources like condoms and feminine hygiene products. Additionally, we provide computer and job skills training, creating opportunities for women to enhance their employability. This holistic approach fosters a sense of community, where women can find emotional support and access mental health resources.

Scholarships: Breaking Barriers, Building Futures

We believe that education is a powerful tool for empowerment. That's why we offer primary and secondary education scholarships to a remote Masai community. These scholarships cover not only tuition but also room and board, ensuring that students have the resources they need to succeed academically. By investing in the education of these young individuals, we are breaking the cycle of poverty and giving them the chance to build a brighter future.

Community Outreach: Paving the Way for Higher Education

Collaborating with community social outreach programs, such as Hawker's Market, we identify talented individuals who are eager to pursue higher education. To date, we have awarded over 20 nursing scholarships and are currently sponsoring 10 women in various higher education pursuits, including university-level communications and computer sciences. By supporting these women in their educational journey, we are opening doors to new opportunities and empowering them to reach their full potential.

Access to quality healthcare is a fundamental right that should be available to all. That's why we provide healthcare education not only in Nairobi but also in remote areas of Kenya. OUR IMPACT

Jackline

Born and raised in Korogocho, one of Kenya's largest slums, Jackline faced numerous challenges from a young age. Her father left when she was just two years old, leaving her mother to care for Jackline and her two brothers. Jackline overcame financial constraints and societal pressures to pursue an education.

Despite the odds stacked against her, Jackline's determination and academic potential led to a scholarship that allowed her to attend a local community school. She vividly recalls the struggle to pay the modest school fees required, a testament to her family's financial hardships. Nonetheless, she persevered through primary school, a significant achievement in a community where many lose hope and drop out by the age of 13.

As Jackline approached high school, she faced even greater challenges, including a lack of sanitary towels and a deteriorating uniform. She reflects on moments when she considered desperate measures to acquire these basic necessities but remained steadfast in her commitment to education. Jackline's academic prowess earned her another scholarship, which enabled her to attend high school, even though her family could not fully support her education. Her experience epitomizes the resilience and determination of girls striving for education in challenging circumstances.

Upon completing high school, Jackline faced uncertainty about her future due to financial constraints. She turned to odd jobs to make ends meet. However, her perseverance and dedication to her dreams caught the attention of Global FICCS, which offered her a scholarship to pursue further education. This opportunity was a turning point in Jackline's life.

Her journey from a challenging upbringing in Korogocho to pursuing her dreams against all odds exemplifies the transformative power of education and support. Jackline's hope is that other girls in her community will also receive the support they need to pursue their ambitions and make a positive impact on the world.

OUR IMPACT

Pauline

Pauline attended a public primary school where government sponsorship made it more accessible, allowing her to study alongside her brother. However, her challenges became more apparent when she transitioned to a boarding secondary school. Financial constraints made it difficult for her family to afford the necessary fees and supplies. Pauline's family relied on contributions from community saving groups, and sometimes she had to attend school without all the required items, which was emotionally challenging as she compared herself to students from wealthier backgrounds.

After successfully completing her secondary education, Pauline's pursuit of higher education presented new hurdles. While she had excelled in her exams, the financial burden of self-sponsored university studies was overwhelming. She relied on government scholarships and financial assistance from organizations like Global FICCS, which helped her cover tuition fees and living expenses.

Pauline's academic journey was not without sacrifices. She initially aspired to study computer science but faced the reality of the high costs involved. She chose a government-sponsored general science course to ease the financial burden. However, her unwavering commitment to her dreams led her to enroll in a boot camp to gain valuable tech skills. With the support of organizations like Global FICCS, she successfully completed the boot camp and acquired essential computer science skills, which opened up new opportunities for her.

Today, Pauline is a shining example of how determination and support can pave the way to a brighter future. His journey began with humble initiatives, such as generously donating stethoscopes and textbooks to underserved healthcare providers. Over time, his endeavors have transformed, expanding to encompass the teaching of advanced medical procedures, including pacemaker insertion and complex angioplasty, to cardiologists across Africa.

Dr. Patel's profound connection with Kenya was forged during a pivotal three-month visit, which ignited his unwavering dedication to the cause. Prior to this transformative trip, he had been a college athlete, but a life-altering injury prompted a soul-searching journey. It was during his time in Kenya that he witnessed the stark resource deficiencies facing the community, compelling him to take action.

With each visit, Dr. Patel's contributions evolved, transitioning from stethoscopes and textbooks to life-saving pacemakers and stents. The realization dawned that community outreach went beyond material donations; it necessitated a sustained commitment to fostering lasting change. Today, Dr. Patel, an Interventional Cardiologist based at Advocate Aurora Lutheran General Hospital in Chicago, Illinois, continues his mission to provide essential healthcare resources and expertise to those in need, embodying a profound commitment to transforming lives and improving healthcare access for communities in Kenya and beyond.

Currently serving as the Director of the Simulation Training Lab at FICCs-Nairobi, Shem is passionate about utilizing his professional experience and clinical expertise to provide advanced cardiac life support training.



OUR HISTORY

Having initially provided critical medical equipment and performed complex cardiac procedures, Dr. Patel recognized the imperative need for sustainable healthcare improvements within communities. To address this, he commenced advanced medical training for Kenyan cardiologists, equipping them with the skills to enhance individual and collective well-being through expanded healthcare access. Witnessing substantial and enduring progress with each training initiative, in 2007, Dr. Patel achieved a significant milestone by performing the first biventricular pacemaker procedure in East Africa. Over the years, he has trained numerous Kenyan cardiologists, empowering them to independently perform these life-saving procedures. Between 2007 and 2014, Global FICCS trainees successfully implanted over 50 biventricular pacemakers and automatic implantable cardioverter defibrillators (AICDs), advancing heart rhythm monitoring and healthcare outcomes.

2007 Cardiac Care

1980-2000 Foundation and First Initiatives

Global FICCS, founded by Dr. Parag Patel, a Kenyanborn interventional cardiologist, saw its beginnings in the 1980s when Dr. Patel, who had moved to the United States for his medical training, started frequent trips to Kenya to explore ways to enhance cardiac care in his homeland. During these visits, he connected with dedicated medical professionals and community leaders who were striving to enact change but lacked essential resources. In 1995, Dr. Patel initiated his mission by modestly donating textbooks and stethoscopes to trainee physicians, later expanding to offer complimentary cardiovascular procedures, thus laying the foundation for Global FICCS' impactful journey.

2009 Community Outreach

In 2009, a pivotal connection was made with Hawker's Market, a community organization dedicated to equipping young women with sewing and entrepreneurial skills. From this collaboration emerged three remarkable women—Caroline, Rebecca, and Isabella—who would play pivotal roles in Global FICCS' mission. Global FICCS provided them with educational scholarships, marking a significant organizational milestone. Today, Caroline serves as Global FICCS' Social Program Manager in Kenya, Rebecca is an RN managing a community clinic, and Isabella, armed with a degree in Clinical Psychology, leads Hawker's Market towards transformative community empowerment.

Basic life support and advanced cardiac life support are necessary tools for every healthcare provider, but courses and certifications in these areas are extremely cost prohibitive. In 2015, Dr. Erin Nasrallah joined the team, and her leadership marked a significant shift in Global FICCS's mission; focusing on hands-on training and skill mastery in First Aid, Basic Life Support (BLS), and Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS). In 2016, FICCS partnered with The Disque Foundation, addressing cost barriers for BLS and ACLS courses, creating a successful program that has trained over 350 ACLS and 500 CPR providers since 2017. Notably, some trainees started Medswipe, a Kenyan-based company dedicated to year-round healthcare training. FICCS also expanded its training to the hospitality sector and donated automated external defibrillators (AEDs).

Global FICCS' approach has adapted to address the global pandemic by centering efforts on a donation campaign aimed at gathering PPE for both community members and healthcare providers in Kenya. Furthermore, Global FICCS has initiated training programs in both Chicago and Kenya to reinforce fundamental PPE principles, promote proper hand-washing and hygiene practices, and disseminate treatment protocols for COVID-19.

2021 Adapting to the Times

2012 Community Center

The glaring gender-based disparities in health, safety, and education across Nairobi and its surrounding areas prompted Dr. Patel to establish The Women's Center. This community hub is committed to offering young women a secure space for learning, personal development, and empowerment. delivering healthcare, life skills, computer training, introductory academic and vocational education, and mental health support. Each year, The Women's Center benefits a cohort of 20 young women and funds two scholarships for those aspiring to pursue careers in healthcare. Through this initiative, hundreds of women have gained the skills and opportunities needed to flourish, not only improving their own lives but also contributing to the well-being of their families and communities.

2019 Advanced Cardiac and Casualty Training Course (ACCT)

In early 2019, Global FICCS launched the Advanced Cardiac and Casualty Training (ACCT) course, a hands-on, simulation-based program designed to enhance physicians' skills in cardiac and emergency medicine. Furthermore, this established a valuable partnership with Rescue.co, a Kenyan-based emergency medical services organization, to bolster the training of EMTs and first-responders in the region.

2023 and Beyond Continue the Focus

Global FICCS will remain focused on raising awareness of limitations to access education and healthcare, continuing to expand medical and community outreach programs and focusing on providing additional scholarship opportunities to impact as many lives as possible.

The organization's commitment to empowering girls and creating lasting change ensures that there is still much important work ahead, promising a brighter future for countless young lives in Kenya.

THE FUTURE OF GLOBAL FICCS:

Expansion of Magadi Community Scholarships

Global FICCS has been working in the Magadi community for the last 10 years and has provided funding for 20 annual scholarships, including room and board, tuition, and books. These scholarships allow young women to have a safe place to live, study, and thrive. Global FICCS wants to scale its impact even further by providing 100 scholarships annually for primary schools, secondary schools, sewing internships.

Program Development

Global FICCs aims to enhance its educational programs in two key areas:

- **Healthcare Training:** Global FICCS programs will equip young women with essential skills in emergency response, first aid, CPR, and women's health advocacy. The objective is to empower them as healthcare advocates, improving access to vital services.
- **Empowerment Initiatives:** These programs will focus on entrepreneurship, leadership, and personal development, providing young women with the tools they need to succeed in both their careers and personal lives. The goal is to foster self-sufficiency and break the cycle of poverty within their communities.

Expansion of The Women's Center

In 2012, Global FICCS established the Women's Center in Kariobangi, Kenya as a haven for young women to live, learn, and thrive. The center delivers essential services, including health and life skills training, computer education, and mental health support to 20 young women annually. Global FICCS has also awarded scholarships to aspiring nurses, childhood development professionals, and computer scientists, further expanding the impact and fostering valuable community connections. Global FICCs is looking to expand this center to be able to service more of the community.

Essential Resources + Technology Funds

One of Global FICCS' key objectives is to boost funding for essential resources and technology. This includes financial support for providing basic necessities like sanitary pads, food, and even covering rent for the Women's Center. Global FICCS is also working towards equipping students with computers to enhance their educational experience and prepare them for a tech-driven world.
