Viviers, Tournon and Vienne all offer the opportunity to taste local wines and enjoy local culture. The last port of call is Lyon - the gastronomic capital of France, where you can visit Les Halles de Lyon - Paul Bocuse, an indoor market. There you'll have a chance to sample of the delicacies offered by butchers, bakers, chocolatiers and cheesemongers while taking in the colorful sights and enticing aromas around you.

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ITINERARY

Day 1, ARLES. Board the AmaKristina for your Colors of Provence cruise. (D)



Day 2, ARLES. Considered one of the most beautiful cities in France, Arles enchants all with its tantalizing history. Join a guided walking tour where you'll visit the Roman Amphitheatre and the Church of Saint Trophime. Alternatively, you can enjoy a bike ride along the Rhone, through town to the Langlois Bridge, famous in Vincent Van Gogh paintings. Enjoy a unique experience at the Carrieres de Lumieres, where you will be treated to a spectacular presentation of art, sound and history projected on the walls of a limestone quarry, set to music. Finally, experience the beauty of Saint Remy de Provence, where Van Gogh painted some of his most famous painting, including Starry Night. (B,L,D)



Day 3, AVIGNON. Avignon is aptly named the city of Popes”, center of the Catholic Church in the 14 th century when the “Palais des Papes” was the equivalent of today’s Vatican. Discover the history of Avignon on a guided walking tour including the Papal Palace and the well-preserved medieval walls surrounding the historic center of town. Visit three venues around Avignon to taste regional specialties. Or you can enjoy a bike tour through the city. During the afternoon, visit another UNESCO site, the impressive Pont du Gard, a Roman aqueduct that is a masterpiece of ancient engineering. (B,L,D)

Day 4, VIVIERS. Take in the quaint surroundings of Viviers, a charming commune along the right bank of the Rone. From Viviers, travel to the magnificent hilltop village of Grignan, and go in search of the highly prized “Black Diamond” truffles with a farmer and his trustworthy canine companion. Or stretch your muscles on a hike to Viviers’ St. Vincent Cathedral, taking in lovely views of the Donzere Gorge and the town of Montelimar with its magnificent chateau, or you can set off on a guided bike tour along the Rhone River. (B,L,D)



Day 5, TOURNON. Take a steam train ride past magnificent landscape carved along the Gorge du Doux, stopping at the charming little station of Colombier le Vieux Saint Barthelemy le Plein, where the train maneuvers in preparation for its return journey. Alternatively, lovers of wine and chocolate will want to visit Le Château de Tournon for a presentation and tasting session.



For a more active adventure, take a hike through the vineyards of Tain l'Hermitage, followed by a visit to a local winery where you'll sample some of the wines. (B,L,D)

Day 6, VIENNE. Situated between the wine regions of Beaujolais and Côtes du Rhône lies Vienne with a Roman past that can be seen in its marvelously preserved ruins. Follow the footsteps of the ancient Romans on a walking to see the Augustus & Livia Temple, Saint Maurice Cathedral, a Gothic church that took over 500 years to build, and St. Pierre Abbey, one of the oldest surviving churches in France, now an Archaeological Museum. (B,L,D)



Day 7, LYON. Take a walking tour that starts in Fourvière Hill, now a designated UNESCO World Heritage Site, and the old town of Lyon. In the St. Jean district, discover the city's unique covered walkways, known as "traboules". Or join a guided bike tour through the city. Later in the day, visit a traditional Beaujolais winery and learn the history and techniques of their vineyard. Plus, enjoy a tasting of their specialty. (B,L,D)

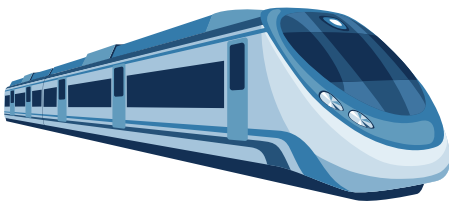

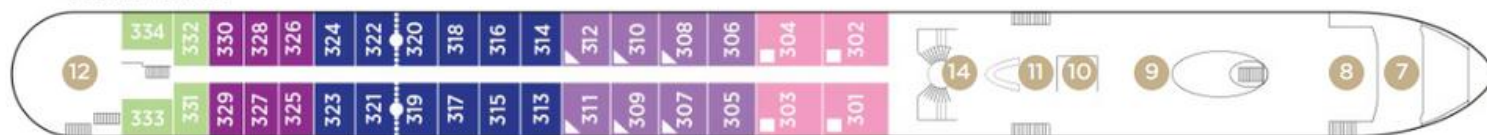
