PENDING HOME SALES SHOW MODEST RECOVERY AMID FALLING MORTGAGE RATES

August Sees Slight Increase in Contracts as Affordability Improves, Yet Yearly Transactions Remain Down

Pending home sales experienced a slight uptick in August, attributed to a decline in mortgage rates that encouraged some buyers to re-enter the market. According to the National Association of Realtors (NAR), contract signings rose by 0.6% compared to July, although this increase comes off a record low from the previous month.

Despite this modest gain, the overall demand for home purchases remains weak. The growth fell short of Wall Street's expectations, which had anticipated a 1% rise. Year-over-year, pending sales are down by 3%, indicating ongoing challenges in the housing market.

Several factors continue to hinder home-buying activity, including sellers' reluctance to move due to the "lock-in" effect, low inventory levels, and uncertainties related to the upcoming elections. While the 30-year mortgage rates have decreased by 110 basis points since last year, industry experts caution that it may still take time for significant changes to occur.

Lawrence Yun, NAR's chief economist, highlighted that even with the increase in pending sales, contract signings are still near historic lows, with home prices reaching new highs. Looking ahead, Yun anticipates that as mortgage rates decline further, sales activity could improve, noting that potential savings on monthly payments could be significant for buyers.




