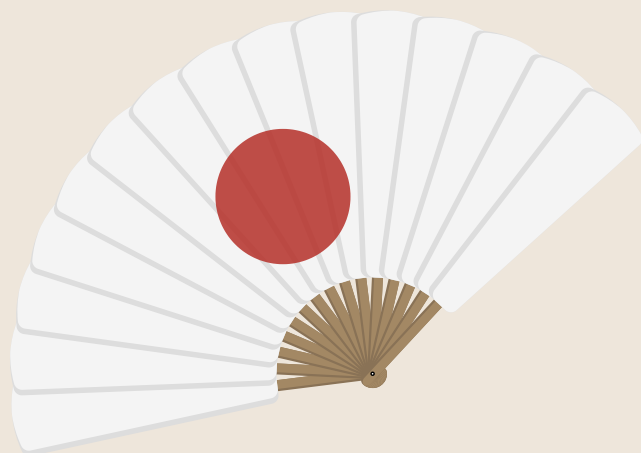


They show the building for earthquake and How to refer the patients by a helicopter.
