Overview

The Certificate Course in Arbitration (the Certificate Course) has been specifically structured to provide Associate members of the Association with an introduction to the theory of law, the law of contract and the law and practice of arbitration. The Certificate Course is a prerequisite to undertaking the Fellowship Admission Course. The course is intended for members who wish to further their knowledge of arbitration as a positive alternative method for resolving disputes.

Learning Format/Course Structure

The course consists of two modules, Modules 1 and 2, which may be undertaken concurrently. Any Associate member wanting to undertake the course may make application via the e-learning portal and is expected to be familiar with the Certificate Course Information Booklet. The link to this facility and the Certificate Course Information Booklet can be found on the Association's web page, www.arbitrators.co.za. Any member wanting to undertake the course may make application by completing the application form.

The Association's Certificate Course is an online learning course which is presented exclusively through e-learning. Students are expected to be able to independently work through the course material, undertake relevant research, submit assignments and prepare for the online examinations. For each module, students are required to attend an online introductory workshop at the beginning of the year and a further online workshop will take place towards the middle of the year.

Students will therefore be required to have access to a stable uninterrupted Internet connection and possess the ability to type in order to be able to download the course material, submit the compulsory assignments, receive communications from the Association and write the online exam. Students, when applying for the course, must be familiar with the course requirements and information set out in the Certificate Course Information Booklet which is available on the Association's website.

Requirements for Application

The prospective student must be an Associate Member of the Association.
