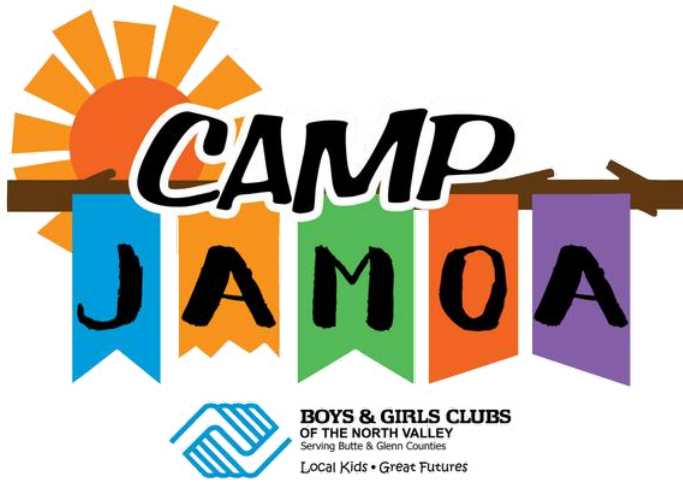

Apply for SUN Bucks A Summer Nutrition Program for Children

You can get extra money for food this summer – Apply for SUN Bucks!



Do you know that your family can get extra money to buy food during summer months? Your child can participate in SUN Bucks program via automatic enrollment or through application!

Each eligible child gets one SUN Bucks card with \$120. Kids who get SUN Bucks can still participate in other food assistance programs such as CalFresh and summer meal programs. SUN Bucks does not affect your immigration status.

Apply by submitting a Universal Benefits Application (UBA) at your child’s school by **August 31, 2026!**

Some children may automatically receive SUN Bucks. If your child is not automatically enrolled, you must apply to get benefits, even if your child gets free school meals. If you are unsure, applying can help ensure your child doesn’t miss out.

More Information about SUN Bucks

SUN Bucks is California’s summer nutrition program that helps families with school-aged children buy food during summer months when kids might not have access to school meals.

You can use SUN Bucks for food at grocery stores, farmers markets, and other authorized retailers. You cannot use SUN Bucks for hot foods, pet foods, cleaning or household supplies, personal hygiene items, or medicine.



Your child will be **AUTOMATICALLY ENROLLED** if they meet any of the following conditions:

- They get CalFresh, or CalWORKs, or Medi-Cal with family income at or below 185% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) or
- They are identified by the school as a foster, homeless, migrant or runaway child.

If not automatically enrolled, you must apply to receive SUN Bucks!

Important Things to Keep in Mind

- **The deadline to submit a Universal Benefits Application to your child’s school for Summer 2026 is August 31, 2026. Apply today!**
- SUN Bucks cards will start arriving in mail as early as June 2026. Keep your address updated with your child’s school and/or your county social services office to get your card.
- You will only have 122 days to use your SUN Bucks. The time starts when funds are loaded onto the card, which happens a few days after California mails it to you. Any money left after 122 days will expire and cannot be put back on the card.

Información general sobre los beneficios SUN Bucks de 2026

¿Qué es el programa SUN Bucks?

SUN Bucks proporciona a las familias \$120 dólares por cada hijo elegible para comprar comestibles durante el verano cuando no hay escuela. Los sitios que aceptan tarjetas EBT de CalFresh también aceptan las tarjetas SUN Bucks. **Recibir SUN Bucks no afecta el estatus migratorio de su familia.**

Inscripción automática para SUN Bucks de 2026

Los niños de entre 6-18 años que reciben CalFresh, CalWORKS y/o Medi-Cal con ingresos iguales o por debajo del 185% del nivel de pobreza federal (FPL) recibirán SUN Bucks automáticamente. Los estudiantes que son elegibles para recibir comidas escolares gratuitas o a precio reducido en base a su participación en beneficios públicos o su estatus de inmigrante, indigente o joven bajo crianza temporal también recibirán SUN Bucks automáticamente.

¿Cómo recibir SUN Bucks?

Si su hijo no fue inscrito automáticamente en SUN Bucks, solicítelo en el distrito escolar de su hijo **a más tardar el 31 de agosto de 2026** para ver si califica.

Los estudiantes que no reciben asistencia pública y que no están identificados por su escuela como inmigrantes, indigentes o como jóvenes bajo crianza temporal **deben** realizar una solicitud para determinar su elegibilidad para recibir SUN Bucks. Recibir comidas escolares gratuitas **no** garantiza la inscripción en SUN Bucks.

Los niños que reciben Medi-Cal solamente recibirán SUN Bucks automáticamente si los ingresos de su familia son iguales o por debajo del 185% del FPL. Por ejemplo, niños que reciben Medi-Cal e Ingresos Suplementarios de Seguridad (SSI/SSP), Programa de Asistencia para Adopciones (AAP), Pagos de Asistencia para Parientes que Son Tutores Legales de un Menor (KIN GAP) ~~asistencia monetaria o Crianza temporal (FC)~~ necesitarán realizar una solicitud porque el Medi-Cal de ~~estas familias no~~ está certificado de ser igual o menor del 185% del FPL. Si no está seguro, solicítelos.

Recordatorios:

- **¿Se mudó recientemente? Actualice su información de contacto** en la escuela o la oficina del administrador de la escuela de su hijo, en la oficina de servicios sociales del condado más cercana o en BenefitsCal.com.
- **Reporte problemas con las tarjetas SUN Bucks a la línea de ayuda de SUN Bucks al (877)328-9677.** Una familia no puede recibir más de una tarjeta de SUN Bucks por hijo o recibir SUN Bucks de más de un estado.
- **SUN Bucks vencen 122 días tras cargarse en la tarjeta.** Se aconseja a las familias que usen sus SUN Bucks antes de sus beneficios de CalFresh. Su saldo en www.ebtedge.com.

PAR-303: Family Dynamics

This course assists parents and caregivers in learning the characteristics needed for healthy environments and relationships in the home while recognizing the uniqueness of each family dynamic. The focus is on ways parents and caregivers can care for themselves while providing the stability needed to meet the physical and emotional needs of children.

PAR-304: Emotional Regulation at Home

This course provides parents and caregivers with an overview of emotional health. Participants will learn to identify and understand signs of mental health distress and applicable tools to regulate emotional reactions, resulting in reducing stigma and encouraging supportive conversations. The focus is on exploring factors that influence mental health and emotional regulation in our homes. The course will provide protective measures and skills needed to aid in healthy coping and regulation strategies for parents, caregivers, and youth in the community.

PAR-305: Co-Parenting

This course is designed to support parents in building healthier, more cooperative relationships for the benefit of their children. Participants will develop practical skills in communication, conflict management, and problem-solving to navigate the challenges of parenting across two households. Key topics include navigating divorce and separation, managing high-conflict situations in and outside the home, and fostering emotional repair and resilience for both parents and children. By the end of the course, parents will be better equipped to work together constructively, reduce stress, and create a more stable and supportive environment for their children.

PAR-306: Connected Parenting

This course empowers caregivers to build strong, lasting connections with their children through simple, research-backed techniques. Learn essential strategies to help children regulate their emotions, foster a deep sense of safety and security, and reduce challenging behaviors. Whether you're a new parent or seasoned caregiver, Connected Parenting offers practical tools to nurture trust, resilience, and a lifelong positive relationship.

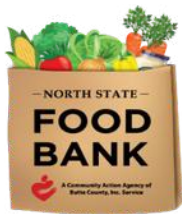

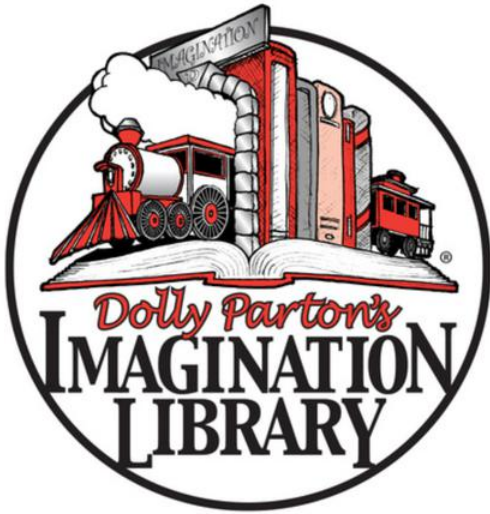

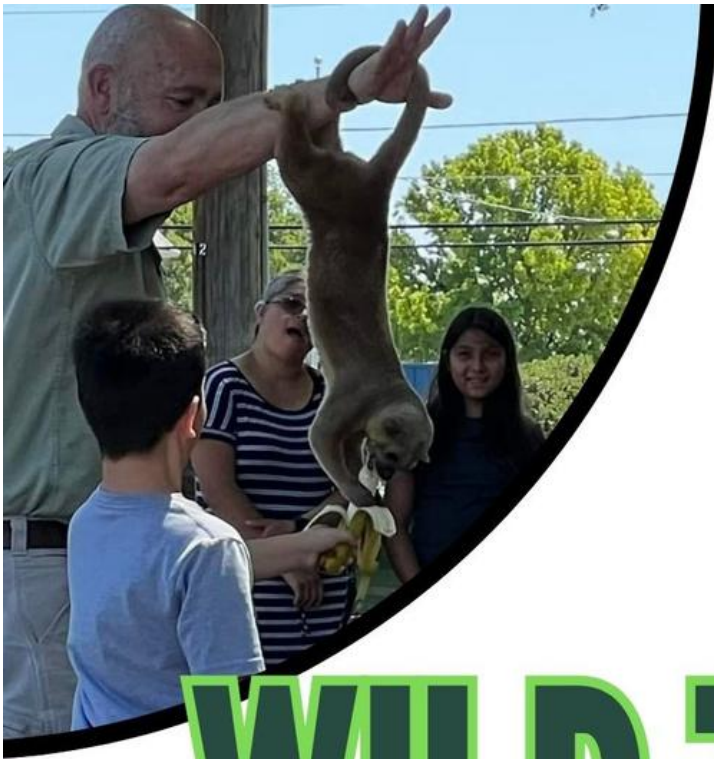
