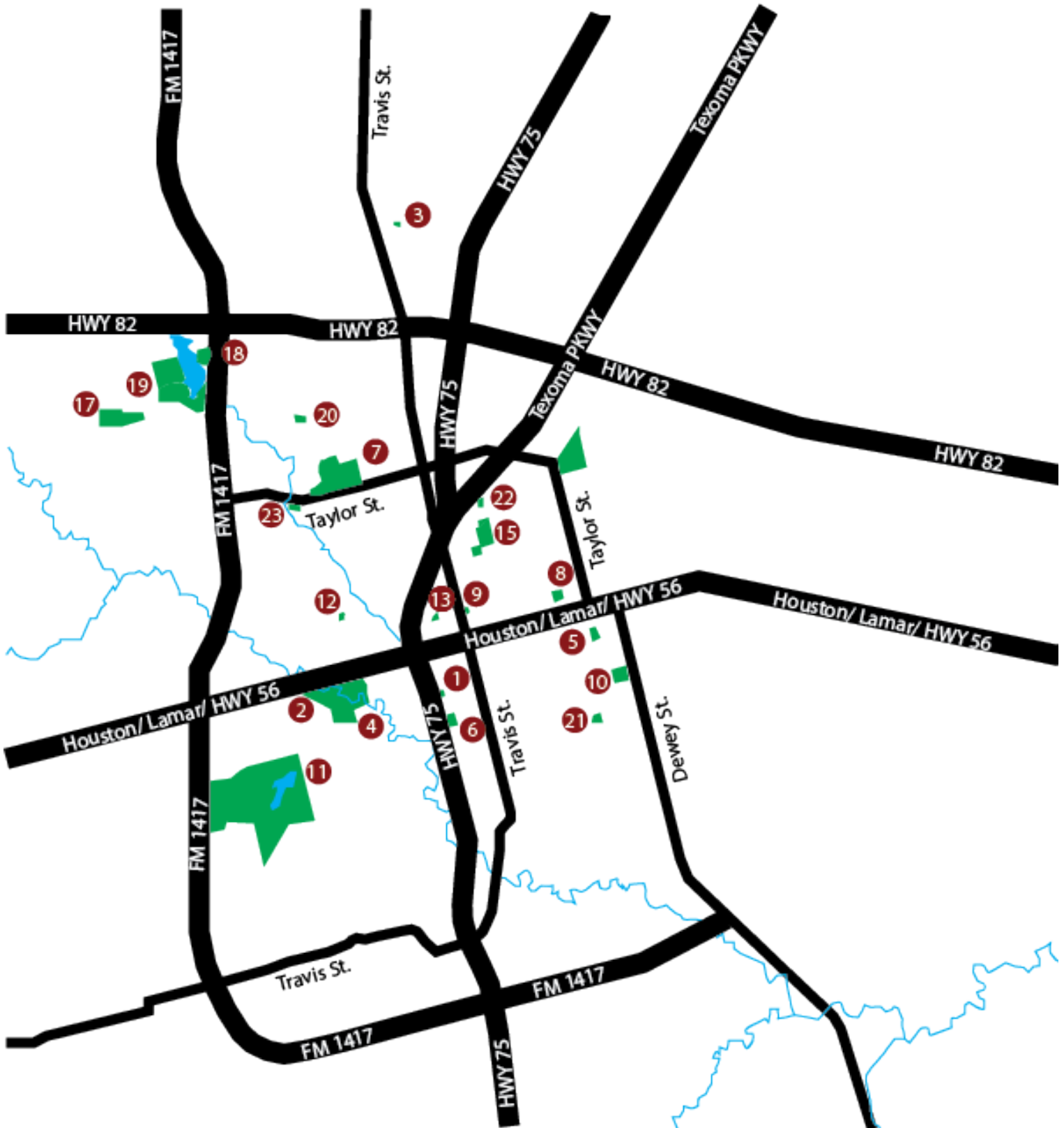

FAIRVIEW PARK

The addition of Fairview Park's pavilion and mixed-ability playground represents an important step in our ongoing efforts to enhance the quality and inclusivity of Sherman's park system. By investing in these upgrades, we not only uphold the strategic goals of our Parks, Recreation, and Open Space Master Plan but also reaffirm our commitment to providing exceptional recreational spaces for everyone in our community. Upon entering the play space, visitors will be met with a monumental piece—the tree house tower. This zone offers a fully ramped PlayBooster® playstructure, two custom-designed tree house towers and various climbers, slides, bridges, panels and more.

Further down the path is a zone filled with thrills for all ages and abilities. A Double ZipKrooz® with an accessible seat delivers the feeling of flying across the play space to everyone. Plus, more traditional playground swings offer high-flying fun.

The marsh zone is where the original vision for the playground design is apparent. Sky-high cattail climbers, mushroom and log steppers, leaf-themed wall climbers and activity panels provide a variety of play experiences for kids of all ages and abilities. Even more, climbers, bridges and slides are built into mounds for additional fun and challenge. Nearby is a zone dedicated to hillside climbers and slides. Funding totaling \$1,810,750 has been secured for this project as part of the fiscal year 2023-24 Capital Improvement Program, affirming the City's steadfast dedication to enriching recreational opportunities for all residents.



PECAN GROVE EAST

We're thrilled to share some exciting news about Pecan Grove East Park. This spring, an all-inclusive playground and Story Walk are coming to the park! This amazing project is the result of a wonderful partnership between the City of Sherman and our community members, all focused on making our recreational spaces welcoming and accessible for everyone. It really aligns with our vision from the 2017 Parks, Recreation, and Open Space Master Plan and highlights our dedication to enhancing the quality of life for all Sherman residents.



A big shoutout to the Sherman Evening and Sherman Noon Lions Clubs! They've been incredible partners in this journey, generously contributing \$115,000 to help us acquire the all-inclusive playground equipment.

The playground will feature a ramp system connecting various areas of the play structure, plus a range of sensory play elements to engage all the senses—sight, sound, and touch. And there will be an inclusive glider so kids of all abilities can have fun together, along with a ZipKrooz that includes an accessible seat for a little adventure!

We're also excited to highlight that the Grayson County Rotary has provided funding for a Story Walk installation at Pecan Grove East Park. The Story Walk allows kids and families to enjoy reading while exploring the park's beautiful tree canopy along a concrete path.

Additional parking and trail lighting will be installed at Pecan Grove East Park. Stay tuned for more updates!

SHERMAN SENIOR CENTER

We're excited to announce some improvements coming to the Sherman Senior Center! These upgrades are designed to better serve all of our senior citizens.

We'll be revamping the handicap parking area to ensure it meets all slope and path requirements, making it easier and safer for everyone. Additionally, we'll be creating a new accessible path leading from the parking to the building. A part of the front porch will also be modified to ensure seamless entry into the facility. Once inside the building, we're adding brand-new ADA compliant restrooms and renovating the existing kitchen to enhance functionality. In addition, the doors on the north side of the building will get some updates.

We anticipate finishing all of this by 2025, and we can't wait to share the finished results with you!

The Lifeguard Certification course provides comprehensive training in water safety, rescue techniques, CPR, first aid, and AED use, equipping participants with the skills to respond to emergencies, prevent accidents, and maintain a safe swimming environment. Through classroom learning, online modules, and hands-on practice, participants will develop surveillance, rescue, and professional lifeguard skills. Prerequisite skills will be tested at the start of the course, and those who do not pass will be unable to continue. Upon successful completion, individuals will receive certification valid for two years.

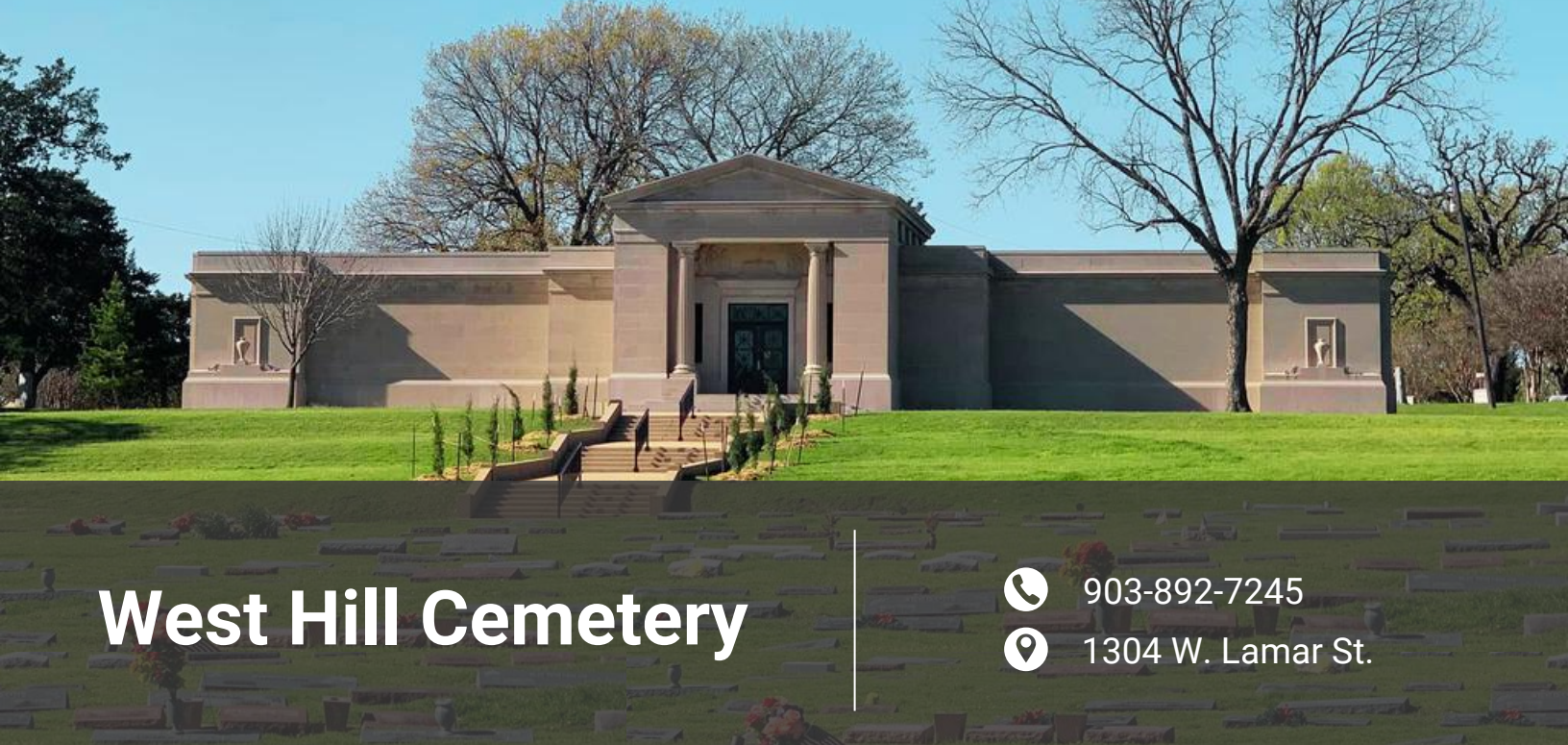

ABOUT US

With its rich history dating back to the mid-1800s, West Hill Cemetery is a one-of-a-kind cemetery in Grayson County. Sitting on 63 acres in the heart of Sherman, the cemetery is easily accessible from Hwy. 75 and FM 1417, and it is the only active city owned cemetery at this time. Within the cemetery there are seven historical markers dedicated to notable persons and events from Sherman's history. The mausoleum, built in 1929 and transferred to the city in 1952, was one of the first of its kind in Texas, and possesses authentic Tiffany stained glass windows. The cemetery has an outdoor chapel at the corner of D Street and 24th within the cemetery which is used for funeral and memorial services. The cemetery is the only city park with its own dedicated staff. The office is located at 1304 W. Lamar, at the corner of Lamar and McKown. 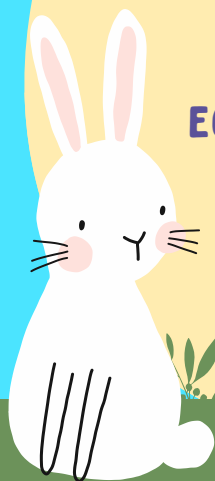

Where do I put THAT?!

Batteries pose safety risks, such as fire hazards, if placed in regular recycling bins due to volatile materials like lithium. They should be disposed of through special recycling programs - please tape battery terminals. TCOG collects batteries Monday through Friday 8-5. Batteries+, Home Depot and Lowe's have collection bins; however, they do not accept single use batteries.



Plastic bags should not be placed in recycling bins because they get tangled in the machinery at the facilities, causing injuries, breakdowns and delays. Alternative ideas:

- Donate to food banks, Habitat for Humanity, charity thrift stores, etc...
- Make sleeping mats for the homeless
- Recycle at your local grocery store

Food waste is not meant to go down the drain because it can clog the pipes and contributes to methane production at the wastewater treatment plants. Composting is an eco-friendly option, converting waste into nutrient-rich soil.

Texoma area residents can put food waste in trash thanks to Texoma Area Solid Waste Authority's methane capture system which is now online.
