INTERNATIONAL CENTER FOR WORSHIP, WARFARE & MISSIONS

The building project is circa 66% complete and needs £75,000 (96,000 USD) for completion. Our goal is to finish this project by 30 September 2023.

Immediate project steps include completing the roofing and walls of the office floor. Additional work includes block work, windows and doors installation, plastering of walls, laying of conduits and cables, the finishing of flooring and ceilings, and landscaping.

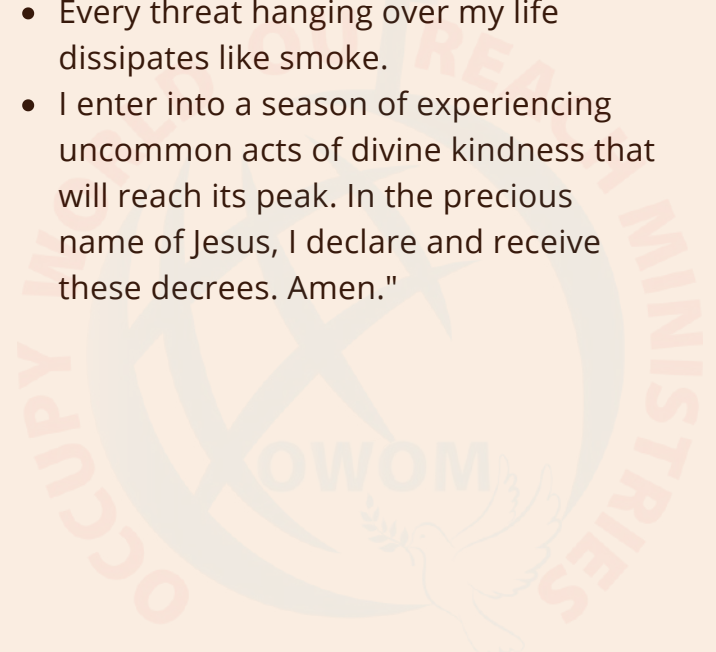
Decree and Declare
