DEL MASSEY PARK

THE LAND ON WHICH THIS PARK IS SITUATED WAS WILLED TO THE CITY OF MARSHFIELD BY DEL MASSEY "IT BEING MY DESIRE THAT THEY USE THE SAME FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE CHILDREN OF THE COMMUNITY EITHER AS A PARK OR FOR ANY EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES AS THEY SHALL DEEM THE TRACT BEST SUITED FOR." DEL WAS BORN IN MARSHFIELD, PROBABLY IN THE YEAR 1901. HE DIED ON NOVEMBER 8, 1958. HIS MOTHER, ROSETTA MUGBY PROCEEDED HIM BY A FEW MONTHS. DEL AT THE TIME OF HIS DEATH WAS THE LAST SURVIVING BLACK IN THE COUNTY. THE BLACK COMMUNITY IN MARSHFIELD NUMBERED OVER 100 IN THE EARLY PART OF THE 20TH CENTURY.

HIS FUNERAL WAS ONE OF THE LARGEST IN MARSHFIELD HISTORY. THE CHILDREN--AND TEENAGERS--LOVED AND RESPECTED HIM. HE LOVED THEM ESPECIALLY THE CHILDREN.

DEL WORKED FOR MANY PEOPLE IN THE COMMUNITY--HE INSTRUCTED AND TRAINED THEM TO MAKE THEIR HOMES AND SPAN EDUCATING THEM IN THE PROCESS.




