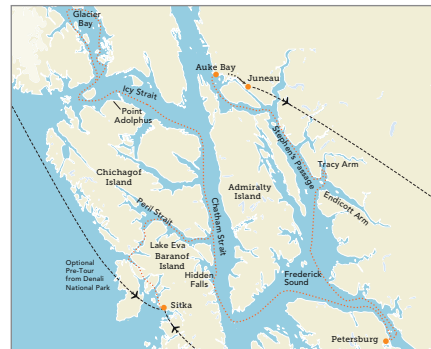

JANUARY 18-24, 2025

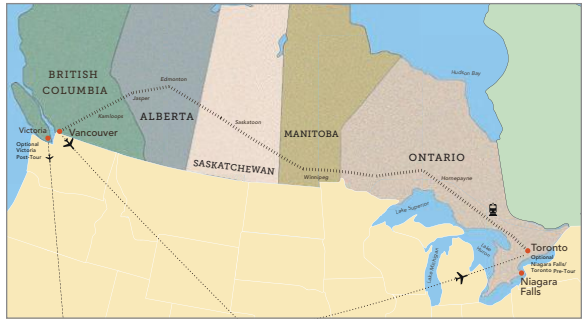

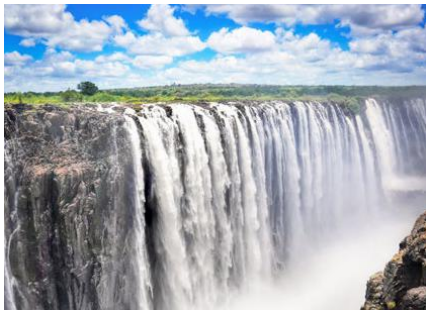
