Aged combination of 3 casks (sherry, bourbon, marsala) rich in tropical fruits & sweet vanilla

## Bourbon Whiskey Flight \$48

Barrel-aged whiskey primarily distilled from corn, with roots in the Bourbon dynasty of the United States in the 1850s

### **Elijah Craig Small Batch Kentucky Straight Bourbon**

Distinctive warm spice and subtle smoke flavor, aged in charred oak barrels for deep rich flavor

### **Baker's Bourbon 7 Year Single Barrel**

7 years old and 53.5% ABV, sweet and spicy profile with bold flavor

### **Basil Hayden Kentucky Straight Bourbon Whiskey**

Light and full flavored with a spicy, smooth, rich, and sweet flavor profile

MASH

**Sour mash is the most common whiskey distilling method. The word “mash” simply refers to a mixture of grain, water and yeast that is fermented to produce alcohol. Mash has is an acidic, nutrient-rich product that is left behind when the distillation process is complete.**

**Sour mash whiskey manufacturers will use a portion of spent (leftover) mash in the manufacturing of a fresh batch of whiskey. This spent mash offers acceptable levels of pH and ensures that the same flavour continues into fresh batches. Many whiskey lovers do however prefer sour mash whiskey due to a deeper, sweeter and richer taste.**
