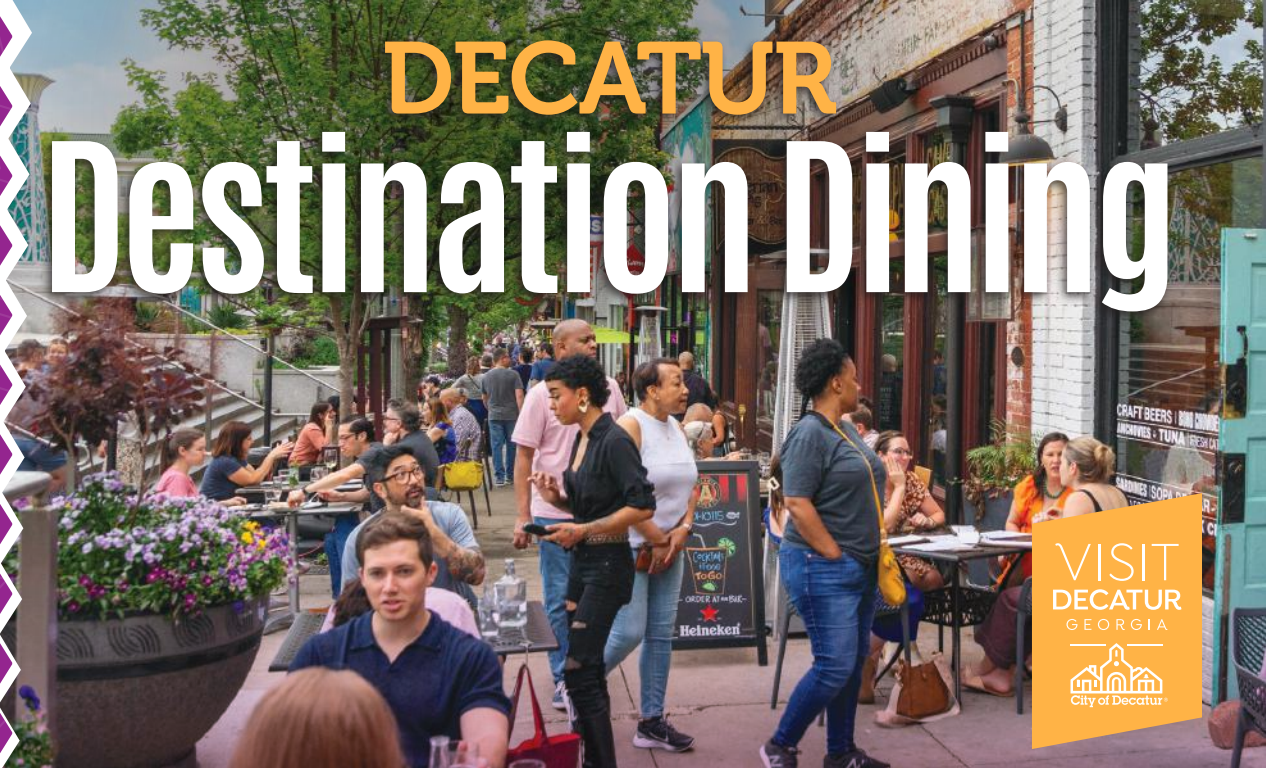

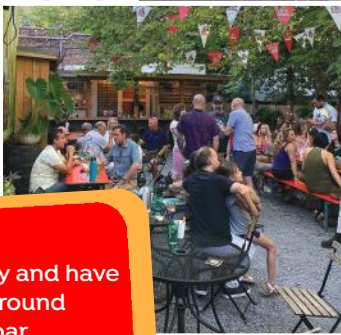
Brick Store Pub

Casa Balam is an upscale Mexican restaurant featuring flavor-filled dishes by Chef Luis Damian (co-owner of two popular metro Atlanta restaurants, El Valle and Oaxaca). The gorgeous space has hand-painted textured walls reminiscent of old haciendas, high ceilings, gold and wooden accents, and large semi-circular leather booths. Try the **smoked ceviche Ahumado**, Wagyu flat iron steak, bone marrow tacos, and corn tres leches with blueberry. They also have decadent eggnog French toast for brunch. And “The Bee Word” is the buzz of the cocktail menu.

Vibrant colors, Bollywood posters, and chaat – crunchy, spicy, sweet, tangy, brightly flavored **Indian street snacks** like the beloved SDPD (sev potato dahi puri). Order a few dishes to share at dinner – kale pakoras, butter chicken, saag paneer, matchstick okra fries, daal, naan... All go great with a mango lassi, Lime Rickey, or bottomless chai. Or taste test at the daily lunch buffet. Chai Pani is widely praised in Atlanta and beyond. The restaurant is Michelin Guide recommended restaurant (2024), the James Beard Foundation's Outstanding Restaurant for 2022; and regularly featured by food critics.
