We suggest visiting each site on the Philanthropy Trail in chronological order, as listed below. The full walk around the College takes approximately 1 hour. The location of each plaque is detailed below.

- 1 New College opens St Lucia Campus
 At the main entrance of the College, on the circular drive at the corner of the Sallyanne Atkinson Building.
- 2 New Wing, Freda Bage Room and enlargement of Kitchen and Dining Hall building projects
 In between the Freda Bage Common Room and the Chislehurst Room (outside), overlooking the Quad.
- 3 Piddington Wing and Playhouse Building Project
 At the Chislehurst Room corner of the Quad.
- 4 New Century Project Stained Glass windows
 At the Piddington Wing corner of the Quad.
- (5) Maureen Aitken Garden
 To the right of the Chiselhurst Society Alumnae Circle, on the
 New Wing side of the Maureen Aitken Garden.
- 6 Centenary Wing 100th Anniversary Campaign
 At the Thynne Road entrance to Centenary Wing.
- 7 Study Hub Project
 On the basement level, under the Harriet Marks Dining Hall.
 Access is via the staircase from the Deck or from the walking pathway from plaque #4.
- College Playhouse Refurbishment
 To the right of the doors to the Playhouse, in the courtyard opposite Piddington Wing.
