GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THE SHOW COVERING ALL SECTIONS

- Intending exhibitors are requested to forward their entries, together with fees, to the Secretary, Liz Black, 24 Lime Avenue, Eydon, Daventry, NN11 3PG Tel: 01327 263186, not later than Tuesday 15th July 2025. Entries received after this date will not appear in the printed Programme. Please make cheques payable to 'Blakesley Show Ltd'. Entries may be made on the day in Equestrian classes subject to an additional fee for some classes. No late entries will be accepted in any Sheep classes.
- 2. Prizes will be awarded as follows: if 3 or less catalogued entries in a class, 1st prize only: if 5 or less, 1st and 2nd prize only awarded.
- 3. All competitors must be on the showground at least half an hour before judging commences.
- 4. All objections must be lodged in writing with the Secretary within half an hour of the event, accompanied by a deposit of £10 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld. This rule applies only applies to classes not run under other Societies Rules.
- 5. Trade Exhibitors will be admitted to the Show only on production of an Exhibitor pass which will admit ONE person only. If additional guest passes are required, these can be purchased at a cost of £10 (inc. VAT) each. Trade exhibitors should contact the Trade Secretary to purchase additional guest passes.
- 6. Competitors in Equestrian and Livestock classes will the issued with two Exhibitor passes. If additional guest passes are required, these can be purchased at a cost of £10 (inc. VAT) each. Please contact the Secretary to purchase additional guest passes.
- 7. Dogs are permitted on the Showground **but must be kept on a lead at all times**.

 Dogs are not permitted inside the Member's marquee, with the exception of registered

- assistance dogs. However, Members' dogs are able to access the Members' lawn area provided they are kept under the control of their owners. Any dog causing a nuisance will be required to leave.
- 8. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and its decision on all matters shall be final.
- 9. The Committee reserves the right to make any adjustment in the order of the Schedule if necessary.
- 10. No exhibit may leave the Showground before 4pm without the consent of the Committee.
- 11. As a One Day, Open-Air Show, there is NO requirement for pre or post movement TB testing under **current** DEFRA regulations.
- 12. BCMS require all cattle exhibitors to record movements to and from the showground in cattle passports. Showground Holding Number 29/307/8000
- 13. All senior bulls must have nose rings fitted.
- 14. Handlers of senior bulls must be aged 16 years or over.
- 15. Every horse and pony being shown is liable to be dope tested.
- 16. Every rider who is mounted must wear a hard hat at all times which complies with relevant safety standards and back protectors are strongly recommended.
- 17. Equine Influenza and Tetanus vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all horses attending the Blakesley Show. The requirement for the first 3 vaccinations is as follows: the first 2 vaccinations 21 92 days apart, a third booster between 150-215 days, and annual booster vaccination within 365 days thereafter. No horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an EI vaccination. Foals should commence vaccinations at 6 months old. This Rule may be subject to change from guidance from the FEI/BEF and any changes will be notified via the Showing Council and ASAO websites. Blakesley Show reserves the right to carry out spot checks, so please ensure that in accordance with regulations your horse/pony passport accompanies them to the show.
- 18. The Company does not accept any liability for accident, damage, loss, injury or illness to owners, horses, riders, livestock, spectators, trade stands or any other persons or property.
- 19. If any section of the Show is cancelled before the closing date for entries, 50% of entry fees will be refunded.
- 20. The Show will be adhering to all current Public Health Guidance and reserves the right to restrict entries should classes become oversubscribed.





BSPS

The Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society and is a qualifier for the following: -

- BSPS Championships
- BSPS Thor Atkinson Steel Fabrications Ltd Challenge
- BSPS Binks Family Champion of Champions
- BSPS Summer Championship Show

BSPS New Horizon Plastics Heritage Ridden

The Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society and is a qualifier for the New Horizon Plastics BSPS Heritage Ridden Championship Show at Arena UK. 1st, 2nd & 3rd prizewinners from classes 28 -31 will qualify for the semi-final (qualification will not pass down the line). **Ponies, Owners & Riders must be BSPS Members to compete in classes 28-31**.

BSPS London International Horse Show Qualifiers

The Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (BSPS) and all persons entering, competing, showing, or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS, are subject to the Rules of the BSPS including the disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

The show is a qualifier for the London International Horse Show qualifying classes. Only one pony in each of classes 4, 5, 6, 7, 40, 41, 46, 47 and 48 will qualify. The highest placed (not already qualified) from the first three ponies in each class will qualify. Nonmembers of the BSPS have seven days to complete their registration and membership to keep the qualification. If not, this will pass to the next exhibitor.

The BSPS Performance Coloured Classes are open to mares, geldings and CHAPS(UK) or BSPA graded stallions, 4 years old or over to be registered in and complying with the showing requirements of the main body of the stud book of the Coloured Horse and Pony Society (CHAPS(UK)) or the British Skewbald and Piebald Association (BSPA). Ponies can be registered with either of these societies or BSPS, and owners and riders must be, or become, members of the BSPS within 7 days to take the qualification.

BSHA London International Horse Show Qualifiers

The show is affiliated to the British Show Horse Association. Classes 1, 2, 13, 15, 42, 44 and 45 qualify for the BSHA Rising Star Supreme Finals at the London International Horse Show 2025. Highest placed competitor not already qualified in the top 5 to qualify.

A results points table will run for all qualifying classes and a 'wild card' will be awarded to those unqualified with the highest points in each section following the final qualifier.

The Judge will NOT ride exhibits in these classes or at the Finals.

Open to members and pre-registered non-members, please see www.britishshowhorse. org/pre-registration-rising-stars-2025/ for further details. 15 yrs and over, eligible under Rising Star Amateur rules. Please note: Rising Star Amateur Rules 2025 are separate to BSHA Amateur rules. Please see the full list of Rising Star rules in the Rising Star section available on the BSHA website. www.britishshowhorse.org If in any doubt regarding your Rising Star Amateur status, please contact the BSHA Office directly to have your status confirmed.

Retraining of Racehorses

The Show is affiliated to Retraining of Racehorses (RoR). Class 43 is a qualifier for The Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree in August 2026.

The Showing Register
