Competitive Categories:

Male & female competition groups in all events. The age divisions: 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, & 90+.

All participants must supply their own equipment unless otherwise specified in event description.

Athletes may enter as many events as they like but it is the athlete's responsibility to enter events that do not overlap in time. It is not the responsibility of the NJSO to wait for athletes who are late for their competition. Participants must check in at the Registration Area sometime throughout the weekend.

Rain: In the event of rain, events will proceed as scheduled, unless it becomes necessary to move or cancel them.

Costs: Some events have fees additional to the general registration fee of \$40. Your initial registration fee covers entry to 3 events. **If participants of Golf and Softball Teams wish to enter any other event, they must pay the \$40 general registration fee.**

Awards: Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals awarded in each age/ sex category.



At Majestic Lanes, squads on 9/6 are 10:00AM, 12:00PM and 2:00PM and on 9/7 at 1PM or 3 PM. An entrant may bowl once in singles and multi times in doubles with different partners. For the doubles, age classification shall be of the youngest partner. Contestants previously entered in the bowling event may re-enter on site in another squad based on lane availability. Bowlers must pay the bowling center a \$12 for every set they bowl. Certified with the US Bowling Congress (USBC) each contestant must have a current membership card or receipt for the 2025-2026 season. You may also purchase a USBC participation fee for \$5. This only entitles the purchaser to use this card for this tournament only and the individual would not be entitled to any awards issued by USBC. **NO ONSITE REGISTRATION WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

Track Schedule:

The approximate start times below are always subject to change (later, but never earlier) based on amount of participating athletes. (Schedule would only move earlier in the event of pending inclement weather.)

10:40 a.m. - 1500m Racewalk Heat 1
(novice, non-qualifying)

11:00 a.m. - 1500m Racewalk Heat 2
(competitive)

11:30 a.m. - 100m Dash

12:30 p.m. - 800m Run

Please note on qualifying years (even years) with increased attendance, the later part of the schedule can push back 30 minutes or more.

Heat Order - Women, Men 70+, Men 50-69
Please keep in mind that we often mix age groups and genders into the same heat to provide competition. The W/M70+/M50+ format is a guideline and not a rule.

Report Times – Listen for announcements!
Women should report to the start area 15 minutes PRIOR to the scheduled (or revised if the meet is late) start time for each distance for heat assignments.

Men 70+ should report AT the scheduled (or revised) start time for heat assignments.

Men 50-69 should report 10 minutes AFTER the scheduled (or revised) start time for heat assignments.

Conflicting Events: If you are participating in track events, field events, and/or other NJSO sports, times often conflict. It is your responsibility to know the schedule and listen for updates. We will try to accommodate schedule conflicts within reason, however we can not delay the meet to accommodate you. TRACK events should always take precedence over field events. If you miss your heat on a track event we will attempt to add you to another heat if that distance is still on the track, but this is very disruptive so please make all efforts to be present for your heat. Field Officials are aware of these conflicts and will accommodate you missing throws within your flight or missing jumps, but you MUST notify them that you are leaving for a track event.

FIELD SCHEDULE

10:00 a.m. - Check-In begins at Shot Put and Discus

10:30 a.m. - Check-In begins at Long Jump and Triple Jump

11:00 a.m. - Competition begins for Shot Put and Discus

11:30 a.m. - Competition begins for Long Jump/ Triple Jump

1:00 p.m. – (approx.) Check-In begins at Javelin

TBD – Competition begins for Javelin once Disc/Shot conclude

2:00 p.m. – Cut off time for Javelin check-in

Long Jump/Triple Jump: We operate an “open pit” concept to help alleviate some of the conflict caused by simultaneously scheduled events. Flights will not be set by age and gender. Early check-in will be offered from 10:30 – 11 am. These athletes will have first access to the LJ/ TJ pit at 11:30. Check-in will resume at 11:15. Please check-in no later than 12:15 p.m. Details on the “open pit” will be available from your Officials. Please note, the “open pit” does mean results/medals are not available until all athletes have jumped.



Shot Put: Flights will be set starting with Men 70+, Men 50-69, Women (oldest age groups to youngest age groups)

Discus: Flights will be set starting with Women (oldest age groups to youngest age groups), Men 70+, Men 50-69

Javelin: Flights will be set at the discretion of the Officials.

Conflicting events: If you are participating in track events, field events, and/or other NJSO sports, times often conflict. It is your responsibility to know the schedule and listen for updates. We will try to accommodate schedule conflicts within reason, however we can not delay the meet to accommodate you. TRACK events should always take precedence over field events. If you miss your heat on a track event we will attempt to add you to another heat if that distance is still on the track, but this is very disruptive so please make all efforts to be present for your heat. Field Officials are aware of these conflicts and will accommodate you missing throws within your flight or missing jumps, but you **MUST** notify them that you are leaving for a track event.



Indoor Women's Volleyball:

The women's team competition will be held at John F. Kennedy Memorial High School in Iselin.

Saturday – September 6th – Divisions 50, 55, 60 & 65+

Sunday – September 7th – Divisions 40 & 45.

Age categories may be combined for pool play but scored separately for age division winners. Divisions will be determined by the age of the youngest player. The number of games will be determined by number of entries and include pool play and playoffs.

Men's and Women's Beach Volleyball: The men's and Women's Doubles and Quads competition will be held at Jenkinson's Beach, Point Pleasant.

Saturday – September 13th – Doubles – Divisions 40, 45, 50, 55, 60 & 65+

Sunday – September 14th – Quads – Divisions 40, 45, 50, 55, 60 & 65+

Age categories may be combined for pool play but scored separately for age division winners. Divisions will be determined by the age of the youngest player. The number of games will be determined by number of entries and include pool play and playoffs.

Bocce:

A team can consist of a single player and or a team of two called Doubles. Doubles can be two men, two women or one of each. The first team to reach 10 points will be declared the winner. This is a single elimination tournament. There will be competition in each age division, and equipment will be provided. Division may be combined if not enough players in age group. **No late entries will be accepted.**

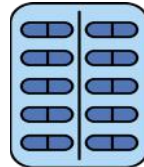
