Calrossy at a glance;

- Prep to Year 6, provides the foundation for success and future learning through coeducational classes on our rural William Cowper Campus.
- Calrossy 7 9, we aim to develop courageous and confident learners in inspiring and supportive single gender classes on the William Cowper Campus.
- Senior Secondary 10 12, our goal is to equip senior students for success in their final years of school and beyond.
 Students learn in coeducational classes on the Brisbane Street Campus in the heart of Tamworth.
- Calrossy owns and operates a school farm, Tangara, which is also the base for the school's Shorthorn Stud, Kamilaroi Shorthorns and the Tamworth Area Agri-Industry Skills Trade Training Centre.
- eCalrossy, distance education for Year 5 9.

Calrossy prepares your child for success at every stage, this begins in our Junior School in Prep. With dynamic learning environments and specialised programs at Calrossy every student is valued as an individual and can reach their full potential.

Underpinning all we do in Junior School is a focus on learning to learn and how can our students do this with courage and confidence. This begins in Prep, so as the children journey through Calrossy they share a common language for learning.

There is a focus on providing engaging learning, experiences and opportunities, both in and out of the classroom, that are purposeful (the children know why they are doing something), relevant and authentic (the learning experiences are real and relate to real life).

Our Year 10 students are given a great headstart for success in life, the Higher School Certificate and/or industry pathways. Our learning, wellbeing and expedition programs focus on the knowledge, skills, values and discipline needed for success academically, professionally and personally. Our Year 11 and 12 students have access to a wide range of academic and vocational courses, in partnership with TAFE. Calrossy has consistently been the best performing school in Northern NSW in the HSC for the last 10 years, including top ten in the State placements in various subjects each year. Our dynamic Careers Program ensures senior students and their families are supported and informed of tertiary, industry and career pathways.

At Calrossy student leadership plays a powerful role in decision making and fostering an environment that empowers student confidence and value. We believe that all students are leaders. We provide opportunity for formal badged leadership roles in Peer Support, Student Representative Council, Co-curricular leaders and much more.

At Calrossy we set paths that will bring about the most gain for our students. We offer countless opportunities, ensuring that everyday, every boy and girl are learning, growing and serving in an inspiring and supportive community.

Those opportunities are within and far beyond the classroom. Students who require academic extension are given the chance to take part in more rigorous academic pathways such as competitions, enrichment activities and classroom extension. Likewise, students requiring specialist support are assisted by expert learning and wellbeing staff.

Calrossy's Expedition Program centres around targeted experiences that focus on growth and values that help shape confident, courageous individuals and team performance. The Program includes day trips for Infants, with overnight expeditions from Year 2 onwards culminating in the Emu Gully Excursion in Year 11 based on the ANZAC theme with a focus on mateship, resilience, sacrifice and courage. Beyond the classroom Calrossy ensures all students are encouraged and have the opportunity to take part in a diverse range of activities from Prep to Year 12. These pursuits include artistic, cultural, sporting, musical, civic, charitable and academic opportunities. Calrossy sees sport as integral to the development of every boy and girl. The School offers a comprehensive range of sporting opportunities to its students and representative pathways through the Hunter Region Independent Schools. Sports incude but are not limited to, Rugby, Netball, Cricket, Basketball, Hockey, Soccer, Equestrian, Horse Sports, Athletics, Tennis, Swimming, Cross Country, Touch Football, Bouldering, Mountain Biking and Shooting.

Various areas of the School also have speciality co-curricular activities and clubs including Cattle Team, Sheep Team, Orchestra, Jazz Band, Dance, Debating, Public Speaking, Enviro, Coding, Garden, Chess, Science, Art, Lego, Cooking and Christian Clubs.

eCALROSSY (5-9)... revolutionising distance education.

Calrossy now offers a highly successful distance education program called eCalrossy. The program is open to students from Year 5 to 9 and is now teaching students in their homes and on the road right across Australia. eCalrossy helps bridge the gap for families and students wanting a quality education, in a supported and connected environment but who are seeking another option to traditional schooling.

WHAT IS eCALROSSY?

- Full-time distance education for students from Years 5 - 9, based on the relevant NSW Curriculum.
- Students are in almost 100% of school time in contact with their teachers and fellow distance education students. This allows online interaction between students with facilitated discussions and group work.
- Learning is technology based, with a MacBook and IT support provided by the school.
 There is very little physical mailing of learning materials to/from school.
- eCalrossy is a dedicated distance education class where the teachers' focus is purely on the distance education students during that lesson.

- Students follow a typical school timetable within the hours 8.40am to 1:25pm and are taught by Calrossy specialist teachers for each subject.
- The eCalrossy class is coeducational.
- There are three compulsory residential sessions throughout the year, where students carry out essential practical components of learning, as well as accessing wellbeing and co-curricular activities, annual year group expeditions, sporting carnivals and pathways.
