

Synopsis

For Leander Lost, Portugal seems like a land of sunshine - until his colleague Teresa disappears. Together with Graciana Rosado and Carlos Esteves, he searches urgently for her.

The case appears linked to the visit of Angolan journalist Flores Yola. When Lost uncovers a blackmail plot, he begins to suspect a murderous plan. The trail leads to corrupt elites in Angola and ruthless contract killers - and time is running out.
