About the Strategy Co-Creation Sessions

The purpose of the Strategy Co-Creation Sessions initiative is to **create a European Innovation Strategy for Advanced Technical Textiles across these three strategic end markets**, which will be aligned with an **Industrial Policy Strategy developed in parallel under leadership of EURATEX.**

The initiative aims to give the European high-performance textile ecosystem a strong collective voice and ensure that EU industrial and innovation policies and programmes provide support to the high-performance technical textile sector.

Textile ETP's SmartX Innovation Hub provides a structured space where industry, research, clusters and public stakeholders can meet, identify innovation opportunities and initiate collaborative projects.

Why now?

The timing of this initiative is critical. Europe is in a period of profound geopolitical and industrial transformation.

Growing security challenges, disrupted supply chains and increasing dependency on non-EU suppliers are coinciding with structural changes in Europe's industrial base.

This impacts the European technical textile industry which suffer from fierce non-European competition and stagnating end markets in areas like automotive, industrial and construction.

At the same time, demand is accelerating for advanced, high-performance textile solutions in protection, defence and aerospace sectors that are central to Europe's resilience, safety and strategic autonomy.

The Strategy will focus on three strategic end markets.

In each end markets, we will look at the different market applications, their unique requirements, opportunities, and research priorities.

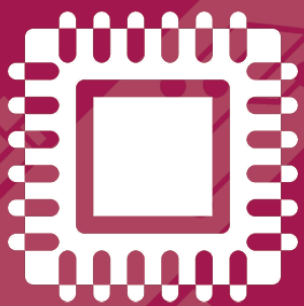

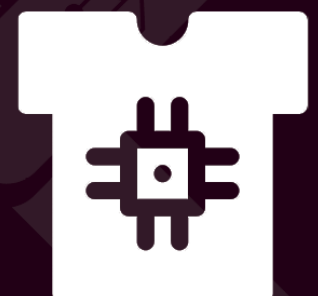
