WORD OF ENCOURAGEMENT



Spiritually we need to get into position.

Remove the fleshly garments of the world so that you may enter the birthing room. Allow yourself to be robed with the garments of praise and righteousness.

Isaiah 64:6 But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.

Zechariah 3:4 "And the angel said to those who were standing before him, "Remove the filthy garments from him." And to him he said, "Behold, I have taken your iniquity away from you, and I will clothe you with pure vestments."

Your birthing place will be unique to you. The date and time you allow yourself to be used by God, to bring forth, and give life to that which has been spiritually placed within you. Will be determined by you getting into position! The Lord knows where we are to be. Allow Him to tell you where to go and what position to get in.

In I Kings chapters 17 & 18 we see several times Elijah obeyed the Lord and got into position. Here we will highlight two of the instances, look at I Kings 17:2-4.

Then the word of the Lord came to him, saying,

"Get away from here and turn eastward, and hide by the Brook Cherith, which flows into the Jordan. And it will be that you shall drink from the brook, and I have commanded the ravens to feed you there,"

Then dropping down to verses 8-10 we read:

Then the word of the Lord came to him, saying,

"Arise, go to Zarephath, which belongs to Sidon, and dwell there, See, I have commanded a widow there to provide for you. So, he arose and went to Zarephath."

When we obey the voice of the Lord, whether it comes from Holy Spirit, or from our delegated authority we will receive all that it is that our Heavenly Father has for us.

I could not share about *Getting Into*Position without including this chronicle from the book of Acts.

The Promise

Acts 1:4-5

The disciples were told to get into position.

<u>Obedience</u>

Acts 1:12-14

The disciples got into position.

Promise Received

Acts 2:1-4

The disciples are in position and on one accord. In position both physically and spiritually. They received the promise of the Holy Spirit, and they out of their mouths spoke or brought forth that which had been placed within them.

And so...whether you have been directed to get into position collectively, or individually, we all need to get into position.

I can't resist a little football analogy.

The play has been called. You are the receiver. The ball will be thrown to you. The quarter back (the one who throws the ball) in this analogy is Holy Spirit. Your quarter back has designed the play. He knows and tells you the spot you are to run to. You must trust and have faith that when you reach your assigned spot you will receive that which the quarter back has promised.

You know the play, because not only have you studied it, you've done it hundreds of times in practice.

Understand that the other team has their strategy as well. They are the defense and are comprised of the enemy and his hordes. They will do everything they can to hinder you from getting into position.
