- Upload high school transcript through application portal.
- Upload college transcript(s) through application portal (dual enrollment, if courses were taken).
- Submit your free application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
FMU school code **001486**.
- Log into application portal for “Checklist” updates and next steps.

Students may choose to also apply to FMU through the **Common Application** or the **Common Black College Application (CBCA)**.

December 1 - Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is available.

November 1 - Priority application deadline and early decision.

February 1 - General application deadline.
