PROGRAM	DESCRIPTION
Ventura County WORKS	Located across Ventura County to help all residents with their employment and training needs.
Ventura County NextGen	Gain access to work through job-readiness training, coaching and/or mentorships, paid internships and post-secondary education. Ages 14-24.
Pre-Apprenticeship Building & Construction Trades Training Program	Training in Multi-Craft Core Curriculum (MC3) to prepare for apprenticeships in the building trades. Ages 18+.
Student Training and Employment Program (STEP)	Work experience for students with disabilities. Ages 16-21.
SkillUp Ventura County	Free online training and one-on-one job search help for Ventura County residents.
Job Connect Ventura County	Training at Ventura, Moorpark, or Oxnard College in specific programs and connection to employment in those fields.
Second Chance	Employment services for formerly incarcerated or justice-involved individuals.
Sowing Seeds of Success	Career navigation, literacy skills, and job skills training for farmworkers.
Ventura County Public Service Fellowship	Paid work experience at public organizations and training in project management. Ages 18-28.
Fields of Opportunity for Farmworker Families	Job search assistance, literacy skills, and skills training for farmworkers and their dependents.
Ventura County Heal Healthcare Careers	No-cost training for careers in healthcare for individuals who are low-to-moderate income.

General eligibility requirements

- Right-to-work in the U.S. (only if looking for work)
- Selective Service registration (for males)
- Income verification, if applicable
