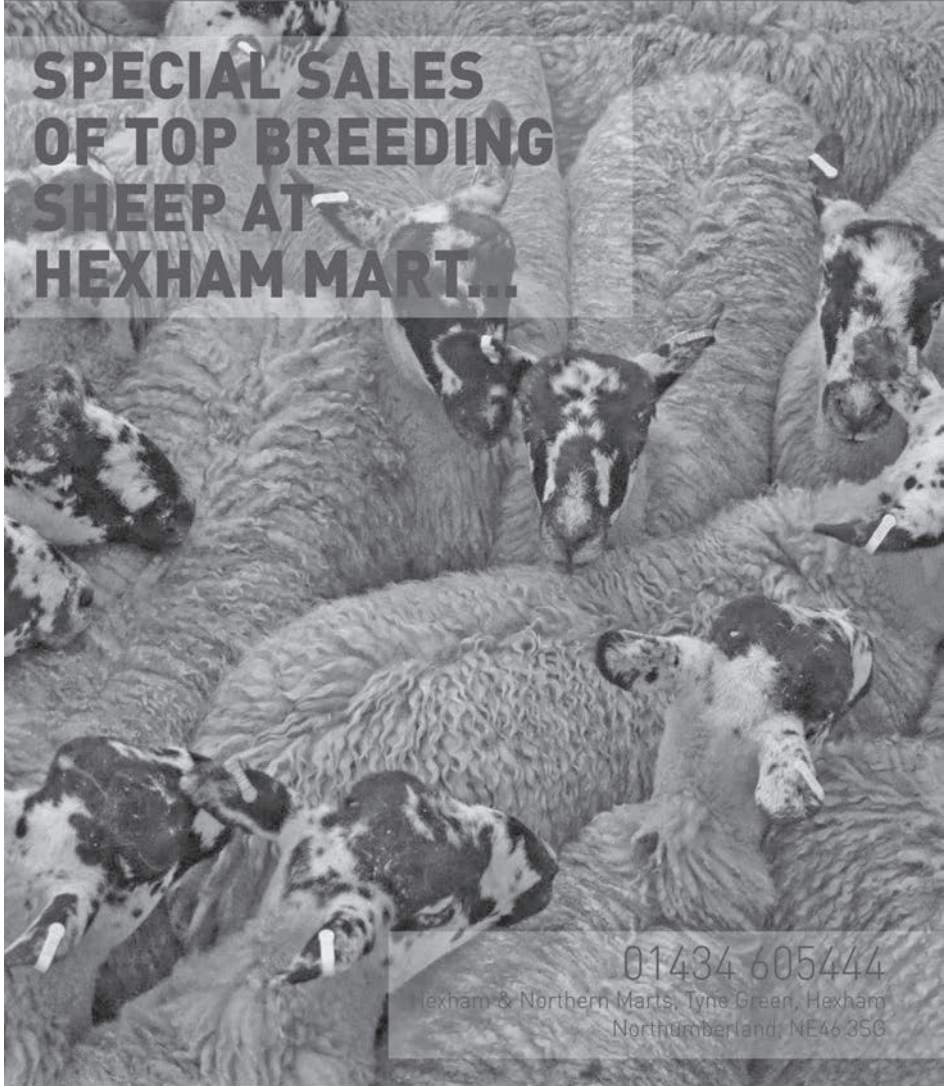

3. Exhibitors must use segregated areas for livestock movement, loading and unloading where provided and when requested to do so.
4. No straw bedding to be used.
5. That all Sheep Exhibits be entered into one Class only, except Special and Group Prizes.
6. All exhibits competing for prizes given by the Society must be the property of the Exhibitor or employee except where otherwise stated in the Schedule.
7. Any dispute arising shall be settled by the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.
8. All protests must be lodged in writing, together with a deposit of £5, with the secretary not later than 6.00 p.m. on the day of the show. Should the protest not be sustained, the deposit will be forfeited.
9. The Committee reserves the right to substitute goods for money where the gifts are obtained after the printing of the prize list. Where this is done it will be shown in the Catalogue.
10. Any Exhibitor who removes any Exhibit from its place on the Show Field before 4.00 p.m. without written permission from the Secretary, shall forfeit all Prizes and at the discretion of the Committee, may be debarred from exhibiting at future Shows.
11. Cheques in payment of prizes which are not presented within 3 months from the date of issue will not be honored.
12. The Society will not be responsible for loss or damage which any person, animal, dairy product, implement, or other article may sustain at the Show or in transit, nor any charges for freight, carriage or delivery etc, incurred.

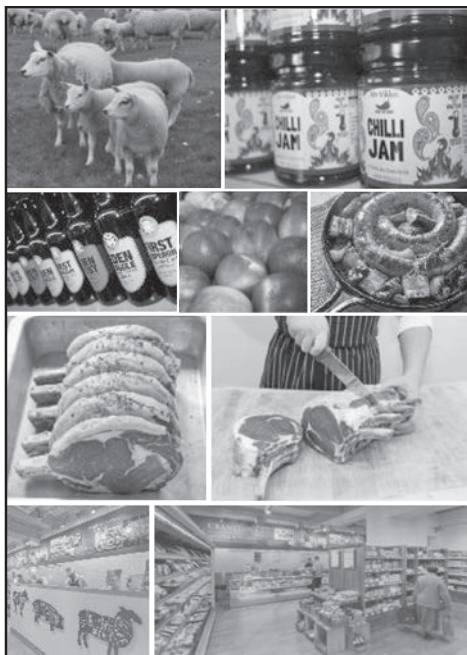
