AFRICA Upon arrival to O.R. Tambo International Airport an Orbridge representative will be waiting to assist with your transfer to the hotel.

landmarks including the Union Building and the Nelson Mandela Statue on a guided panoramic tour. As embarkation begins late afternoon, settle into your private sleeping car featuring large windows and en suite bathroom. Venture into the cozy lounge car to admire the passing scenery from its panoramic windows or observation porch. On board, four-course dinners are a highlight. Talented chefs prepare African and European cuisine served in two comfortable restaurant cars.

safari through Kruger National Park. Then travel by bus along the panoramic route through the Drakensberg mountain range.

yourself in the untamed beauty of the Makalali Game Reserve, a diverse landscape providing a rich tapestry of habitats for a plethora of wildlife. Spot for the Big Five and an abundance of other species during a game drive, and gain insight into the area's history.

through the Limpopo Province, pass by the Soutpansberg mountain range and the lands of South Africa's Rain Queen. Enjoy a biltong (traditional spiced jerky) tasting. Embrace time for introspection or listen to a presentation by the tour guide.

Day GREAT ZIMBABWE Following breakfast

embark on a bus journey to the ruins of Great Zimbabwe, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and unravel the mysteries of this ancient civilization. The legacy of Great Zimbabwe lives on as one of the largest and most culturally important archaeological sites of its kind in Africa.

Take a guided panoramic city tour of Bulawayo. After lunch visit Matobo National Park—a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Later see the Grave of Cecil Rhodes.

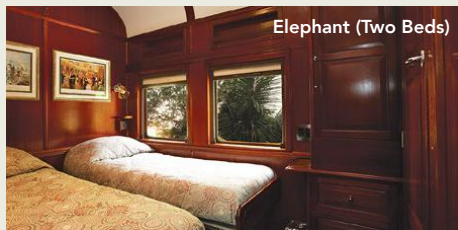
Elephant: approx. 75 sq. ft. accommodating two guests in either two single beds or one double bed

Leopard: approx. 107 sq. ft. accommodating two guests in either two single beds or one double bed

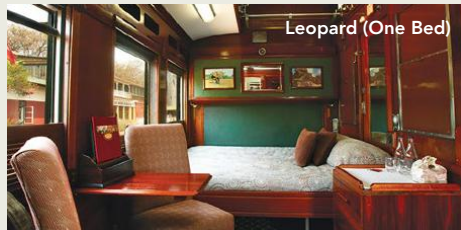
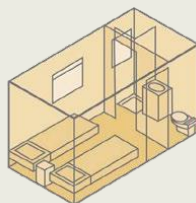
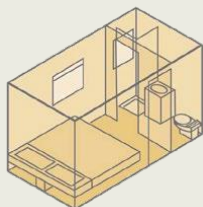
Single travelers can select from either category. There is no internet access on the train.



Elephant (One Bed)



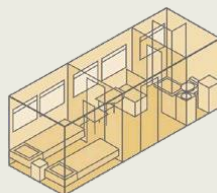
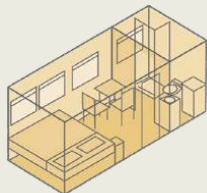
Elephant (Two Beds)

At the southernmost tip of Africa, Cape Town offers a perfect blend of natural beauty, cultural richness and outdoor experiences. Explore this vibrant region's iconic landmarks, sample its exquisite flavors and admire the peninsula's captivating landscape.

Day +1 EN ROUTE FROM U.S.

Day +2 **ARRIVE IN CAPE TOWN, SOUTH AFRICA** Upon arrival to Cape Town International Airport, transfer to the hotel to enjoy an evening at leisure.

Day +3 **CAPE TOWN** Today's first highlight is a cable car ride ascending Table Mountain (weather permitting). At the summit, take a leisurely walk to the various lookout points. Continue with a panoramic tour of the city, passing by some of Cape Town's most iconic landmarks. Afterwards enter the eye-catching Bo-Kaap neighborhood where you'll delve into South Africa's rich and complex food heritage during a food tasting featuring a blend of flavors and techniques.

Day +4 **CAPE TOWN | CAPE PENINSULA** Set off on a scenic drive south along the Atlantic Seaboard towards Cape of Good Hope. En route, take advantage of brief photography stops at Hout Bay and Chapman's Peak Drive. Immerse yourself in the vibrant atmosphere of Hout Bay Market. Then journey into the heart of the winelands for an exclusive food and wine pairing experience. At the iconic Cape of Good Hope, ascend to the summit aboard the historic Flying Dutchman Funicular. Visit Boulders Beach to observe a charming colony of African Penguins. The evening is at leisure.
