A free service for all children age 3-5 to check your child's: vision, hearing and development progress. Screening helps identify children who may benefit from resources to help in their development.

Preschool and PreK

A variety of morning or afternoon classes 2-5 days a week to support your child's learning through play-based, meaningful, hands-on learning experiences and kindergarten readiness. For children 3-5 on or before Sept. 1.

Individualized Family Education

Free parenting support, information and activities for your family to encourage the growth and development of your child. Family educators can meet with you by phone, virtually or in-person.

Cov hoob rau Preschool thiab PreK:

Muaj ntau hoob thaum sawv ntxov thiab tav su li 2-5 hnub ntawm ib lub limtiam los pab koj tus menyuam txoj kev kawm los ntawm kev uasi, kawm ntawv kom muaj qab hau, kawm ua ib yam dabtsi thiab kev npaj tus menyuam rau qib kindergarten. Rau cov menyuam uas muaj 3-5 xyoos rov saud lossis ua ntej lub 9 hlis tim 1.

Npaj Kev Kawm rau Tsev Neeg (Individualized Family Education):

Kev pabcuam dawb rau tsev neeg, ntau yam xovxwm pab thiab kev xyaum ua pub rau tsev neeg los txhawb thiab pab kev loj hlob rau tus menyuam. Cov xibfwb cobqhia rau cov tsev neeg kuj ntsib tau nrog koj ntawm kev hu xovtooj, ntsib virtually lossis tuaj sib pom sib ntsib uake.

Kiểm tra sức khỏe sớm:

Một dịch vụ miễn phí cho tất cả trẻ em từ 3-5 tuổi để kiểm tra: thị giác, thính giác và tiến độ phát triển của trẻ. Khám sàng lọc giúp xác định những trẻ có thể hưởng lợi từ các nguồn lực nhằm giúp trẻ phát triển.

Các lớp mầm non và PreK:

Nhiều lớp học buổi sáng hoặc buổi chiều 2-5 ngày một tuần để hỗ trợ việc học tập của con quý vị bằng trải nghiệm học tập thực hành, ý nghĩa, dựa trên trò chơi và chuẩn bị sẵn sàng cho mẫu giáo. Dành cho trẻ từ 3-5 tuổi vào hoặc trước ngày 1 tháng 9.

Evaluación de la Temprana Edad:

Un Servicio para todos los niños de 3 a 5 años para comprobar la visión de su niño, audición y progreso del desarrollo. Las pruebas de detección ayudan a identificar a los niños que pueden beneficiarse de los recursos para ayudar en su desarrollo.

Clases Preescolares y Pre Kinder:

Una variedad de clases matutinas o vespertinas de 2 a 5 días a la semana para apoyar el aprendizaje de su hijo a través de experiencias de aprendizaje prácticas basadas en el juego, interesantes y de preparación para el jardín de infantes. Para niños de 3 a 5 años antes del 1 de septiembre.

Educación Familiar Individualizada:

Apoyo gratuito para padres, información y actividades para su familia para fomentar el crecimiento y desarrollo de su hijo. Los educadores familiares pueden reunirse con usted por teléfono, virtualmente o en persona.

Baarista caruurnimaa hore:

Registration is based on age of the infant at the start of the class.

What to expect in an infant class

Come to interact with your baby in a space designed especially for infants (Birth to 18 months) and meet other families with infants in the community. You will learn fun play ideas, songs to sing and gain information and support for parenting your baby. Discussion time will be focused on parenting an infant. Topics typically include: parent and child bond and attachment, adjusting to family life, brain development, developmental milestones, establishing routines, feeding, sleep and more! Infant classes are non-separating classes. Families stay together for the entire class time in a group. Sibling care is only available where listed.

Birth to 18 months

Interact with your baby in a space designed especially for infants and meet other families with infants. Learn fun play ideas, songs to sing and gain information and support for parenting your baby. Discussion topics typically include: parent and child bond and attachment, adjusting to family life, brain development, developmental milestones, establishing routines, feeding, sleep and more! Infant classes are non-separating classes. Families stay together for the entire class time in a group.

Infant Massage (Birth to 9 months)

Understand and respond to your baby's cues and signals as you deepen your bond through the relaxing practice of massage. Learn massage for better infant sleep and digestion, ways to increase brain and nervous system development and how to deepen your baby's sense of safety and attachment.

Classes that meet one time will give a general overview. Classes that meet two times will go more in-depth and provide opportunities for you to practice and reflect on strategies learned.

The Fourth Trimester (Birth to 12 weeks)

Classes begin with an opportunity to weigh and measure your newborn to track growth. Then a parent educator and public health nurse will be available to provide information and support on topics such as sleep, attachment, development, perinatal mental health, and other topics related to a newborn. Join this supportive community and connect with other new parents. Come every week or as often as you can.

What to expect in a class

Your 1-2 year-old child is experiencing a time of rapid growth and development. These classes are designed for you and your child to discover new learning in a space your child can safely explore and move. Discussion time will be focused on parenting one to two-year-olds and the interests of the group. Topics typically include: safety, language development, nutrition, separation and more! Parent and child separating time will be determined by the needs of the group.

Your two to five year-old child is gaining new language and social skills. These classes are designed for you and your child to explore together and spark your child's emerging curiosity, independence and interest in interacting with others. Discussion topics will be focused on parenting 2-5 year-olds and the interests of the group. Topics typically include: setting limits, toilet learning, social-emotional development, play ideas and more! Parent and child separating time will be determined by the needs of the group.

Drop off Preschool for Young 3s

Children 2 1/2-4 years-old on or before September 1, 2023.

This is a drop off class for children who are ready for more separation time. Teachers encourage a child's natural curiosity in early literacy, language, observation and problem solving skills. They will enjoy songs, stories, art, dramatic play, sensory, movement and games while being introduce preschool readiness skills. Students currently enrolled in Practice Preschool will have priority registration for the Drop off Preschool for Young 3s class. The lottery will fill remaining spots.

Preschool Together

For parents and children 3-5 years-old on or before September 1, 2023.

This class is an opportunity to do preschool together with your child! You and your child will explore new activities and play together. Your child will be learning about interacting with others, taking turns and problem solving. Parent discussion will explore topics such as managing child's technology use, responding to your child's questions and ways to support their school success.



Family ECFE classes for parents and children

For children birth to five years old on or before September 1, 2023.

What to expect in a family class

Multi-age classes are designed for parents and children birth to five years old. There will be a variety of activities for children of all ages to explore and learn. Discussion topics will be focused on parenting children from birth to five years old and the interests of the group. Topics may include developmental milestones, positive guidance, sibling relationships, use of media and more! Infants birth to 5 months old attend parent group with their adult. Parent and child separation time will be determined by the needs of the group.

Adventures with Dad

Dads, grandpas, uncles and father figures, this class is for you and the young child in your life! During discussion time, dads and father figures will dig into important parenting topics-all things fatherhood!
