

The Redruth Challenge: A Clash of Titans

Today's opponents, Redruth, present the season's most difficult home game so far. Following an narrow opening-day loss to the currently second-placed Wiveliscombe, the Cornish side have been in devastating form, racking up impressive victories against league leaders Paignton, Plymstock Oaks, and, most recently, Torquay.

The history between these two sides promises a thriller. Last season, honours were even; Redruth edged a tight contest 26-21 in Cornwall, before a rampant Barnstaple side exacted revenge in March with a dominant 40-7 victory on home soil.

Given Redruth's current form, a repeat of that score line seems unlikely. Instead, the Pottington Road faithful should brace for a fiercely contested, edge-of-the-seat encounter. This is a clash that could very well go down to the final whistle and live long in the memory of North Devon's rugby supporters. Be prepared for a cracking game of rugby.

Whilst on the main field, Barnstaple Athletic will take centre stage, the Barnstaple Buccaneers welcome local rivals Torrington on the second pitch.

Bucc's eye first win of the season

All eyes will be on the Buccaneers as they hunt for their first victory of the campaign after a challenging start with three consecutive losses. However, the mood within the camp is one of growing optimism, with a new-look squad showing significant and rapid improvement in recent weeks.

The team signalled their rising form a fortnight ago in a hard-fought battle against last season's Merit Table champions, Crediton. Despite ultimately falling 31-22, the narrow margin against such strong opposition proved the Buccaneers are quickly shaking off their early-season blues.

As the team continues to gel, today's match against Torrington presents the perfect opportunity to convert their progress into a maiden win and kick-start their season in front of a home crowd.



Sellick's Ice-Cold Boot Seals Epic Chiefs Comeback in Pottington Road Thriller

In a finish that will be etched into Pottington Road folklore for generations, Henry Sellick held his nerve amidst a deafening silence to slot a last-gasp penalty, snatching a dramatic 25-23 victory from the jaws of Cinderford and sending the Barnstaple faithful into voluminous, unbridled euphoria.

The scenes of sheer ecstasy that greeted the final whistle were a world away from the anxiety that had gripped the ground just seconds before, as Sellick, with the weight of the season on his shoulders, delivered a perfect strike to secure a win that felt like destiny fulfilled.

What a thriller! It was a complete, edge-of-your-seat, heart-pounding spectacle. It wasn't always the most polished rugby, but the sheer volume of heart-stopping moments made for an utterly electrifying contest. As I've often said, whenever Cinderford visits Pottington Road, they seem to love our pitch, because we're always guaranteed a close game.

It was another slow start from Barnstaple, with Cinderford in the ascendancy for the first half-hour. They commanded possession, put us under pressure, and made all the running. Their scrum had a clear, if not massive, edge over ours, earning a number of penalties from the pressure. They

converted one in the 10th minute to take a 3-0 lead, and capitalised fully in the 25th minute with a try, extending their lead to 10-0.

Finally, in the last 10 minutes of the half, Barnstaple began to find their stride. After a few penalties, we saw Cinderford defending the maul by pushing us towards the sideline—a strategy I suspect more teams will adopt to counter our strengths. However, following a series of pick-and-goes, Matt Gohl crashed over with five minutes left, making the score 5-10 at the break.

Cinderford started the second half stronger, slotting a penalty within two minutes to extend their lead to 13-5. But a change from the bench ignited Barnstaple. We began to play our game, building pressure through multiple phases and mixing up our attack. This soon paid off. A powerful rolling maul made significant inroads into the Cinderford 22 before Bertie Stretch peeled off and found Ross Swales, who was stopped just short. From the ensuing pick-and-goes, Matt Gohl stretched those long arms of his over the line to bring us level.

The pressure continued. Opting to run a lineout instead of mauling, the Chiefs kept mixing it up. Bertie Stretch, a threat all game, almost broke through, and several phases later, Viliame Kotobalavu spotted a gapping hole and smashed his way through for our third try. Henry Sellick's conversion gave us the lead for the first time at 17-16. Ben Jago then added a further 5 points, crashing through from close range.

But Cinderford weren't done. With just five minutes left, a converted try put them back in front, 22-23. With seconds on the clock, Barnstaple marched downfield and earned a penalty right in front of the posts. Up stepped Henry Sellick. The entire ground fell completely silent—even children were hushed. With nerves of steel, he slotted the ball over, securing a fabulous Barnstaple win and relieving all of us from a massive amount of stress.

What a way to win! It was a brilliant afternoon's entertainment, and it really doesn't get any better—though my heart could do with a little less drama.

So, not the complete 80-minute performance we hoped for and for the first thirty, Cinderford certainly had the measure of Barnstaple. The Scrum creaked and we allowed them too much possession which they capitalised on. The Chiefs fitness and unshakable self-belief that they can beat anyone was the difference. As the half drew to a close we started to get the juices flowing and some fluidity in our game. The second half saw a better return for our endeavours as we pressured more, got ourselves not just back into the game but for large parts of the second half started to dominate it and produced results.

Even when the defence faltered and allowed Cinderford to retake the lead late on, they never gave up. That belief was absolute, and the memory of that final, silent kick is one that will live with me for a long, long time. As a result the Chiefs now sit second in the league with five try bonus wins and that all important try bonus point when they lost to Exeter Uni.

Chiefs Embark on Pivotal M5 Mission Seeking Redemption Against Luctonians

Fresh from the euphoric high of a last-gasp victory, the Barnstaple Chiefs now face their toughest test of the young season: a formidable 180-mile journey north for a top-of-the-table summit against the powerhouse Luctonians this Saturday.




