Connections

According to our website, there are Black Sheep HDFC members in 47 states and at least three other countries. We have over 50 chapters and numerous Area Contacts – serving, praying, and hoping to get more members to become chapters. There are times like The Gathering, Sturgis, Four Corners, Daytona, and HOG Rallies where we see others from different states or regions and are reminded of our spread. If you get the weekly Prayer List, you'll be reminded of others across the country as you read and pray for their needs or concerns. Here is another example of connecting with Black Sheep around the world.

A couple of years ago, Dee's cousin was in a bad motorcycle accident in Southern Maine. We live in Virginia and were much too far away to visit, care for, and minister to him, his wife, and small son. But we had friends. We knew Ken and Mary Hawko and Bob and Jen Foss – Black Sheep in that area. So, we did what felt natural. We reached out to them and had them be our hands and feet. They visited, sent cards, and otherwise loved on

our cousins when we couldn't. In the time since then, we've also reached out to members in Houston when a friend of a friend was in a bike accident. Or, when someone was in the hospital in another state that needed a visit. As International Chaplains, we've seen numerous times when Black Sheep have connected with others in different states to do the same thing. Sometimes, we've helped make that happen. What a blessing that is! Another great example is when someone from a northwestern region was being ministered to by his Black Sheep friends and traveled south. There he was ministered to by the Black Sheep down there. If you know this story, you'll recognize that it has a powerful connection where this rider came to know Christ as his Savior through these interactions! That is a story for another time and someone else's to tell!

So, why am I bringing up this history again? Because I've had the opportunity to do something similar again. Here in Virginia Beach, we're losing our top mechanic. Life situations have caused him to move his family to Southern California. When we found out where our friend was going and what dealership he'd be working with when he arrived in So. Cal., we used the Sheep Locator feature on the new App to find the person who was at or near that dealership. We were able to get the contact information, connect with them, and help prepare the way for our friend when he arrives on the other side of the country in a week or so. Black Sheep will be there to continue ministering to this man and his family even after moving 3000 miles away!

Did you download the new App? Have you checked out the different features? There are a great many resources available, including the Sheep Locator, a Bible, Chat/Message groups for each region, and a place for Prayer Requests. We hope you'll check it out. Thank those involved with the development of this new tool, and connect with us and with others to share God's love to a hurting world. God Bless!

My Black Sheep calling came into my life at just the appointed time, in 2012. My girlfriend, Andy, and I were attending a church service on a Saturday, which was out of the ordinary for our schedule. Little did I know, a divine appointment with Brother Newman had already been planned for me that evening. "Bro from Black Sheep Lake Elsinore Chapter" greeted us at the church door with a welcoming smile, open arms, and an obvious love for the Lord. We spoke briefly, but the impact Bro made lit a fire in me. He even went so far as to invite me to his home to fellowship.

By the Lord's design, I had just been surprised with the gift of a Harley from my soon-to-be fiancée. This would align all the pieces perfectly for God's plan. I had been searching for purpose since becoming injured and wanted to be part of something greater. I hadn't ridden for years, but somehow she knew the gift of a motorcycle was just the beginning of something beautiful. Andy insisted that I honor the Lord with the bike. She knew I was made with a serving heart and couldn't wait to watch me grow as a Christian. At the time, I had no idea what that would look like, but I began researching motorcycle ministry. Little did I know, Bro was part of the BSHDFC Ministry. I went to Bro's house that Monday, and my growth in Christ and in this ministry hasn't stopped since.

In the years that followed, I have fellowshipped and served with countless others whom I now call my brothers and sisters. Through hugs, smiles, laughs, tears, and relentless prayers, I have found my calling and continue to glorify God through all I have to offer, as a once-broken man who is now repurposed to be His hands and feet. I have served as Vice President and President of three chapters (Lake Elsinore, Temecula Valley, and Idaho Falls) and am now the Regional Director of the Mountain West. God's calling has guided my family to relocate to Southeast Idaho, an area where there is great



need for BSHDFC to serve. He is preparing all of us here for growth, and it's exciting to see His hands at work.

One of the things I take the most joy in doing in our ministry is shining boots. Getting to know riders in the area while sharing the Lord with them can take only a few minutes but can open doors, just like Bro's open arms and smile did for me in 2012, at the doors of the same church where I gave my life to the Lord in front of a crowd of strangers. We never know what people are dealing with in their lives or how much they need that 10-minute conversation and the prayerful words we have to share. Just a couple of weeks ago, I met a man while shining his boots. Afterward, I prayed for him and his family. He burst into tears and told me that his wife of 40+ years had been diagnosed with stage 4 liver cancer just 24 hours earlier. As Black Sheep, we are called to inspire each other, and I had boldly done so, with God's guidance, without even realizing it. At that event, I declared, "We have soles to save, and not much time to get it done."

It is an honor to be part of this ministry, to go out and share the love of our Lord with those in the motorcycle world. There is not a path I wouldn't follow for Him. Let's go out, encourage each other, and spread the Lord's love.
