FORGING STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIPS TO CHAMPION DATA PRIVACY: NDPC AND ISACA ABUJA JOIN FORCES FOR NATIONAL CODE4PRIVACY 2.0

In a landmark move to deepen digital trust and youth-driven innovation, the Nigeria Data Protection Commission (NDPC) has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the ISACA Abuja Chapter as a strategic partner to host the second edition of the National Code4Privacy Hackathon Competition. This highly anticipated event will form a key highlight of the 17th Annual ISACA Abuja Conference, scheduled to take place from August 26–28, 2025, in Abuja. Speaking at the MoU signing, the National Commissioner of NDPC applauded ISACA Abuja for its longstanding partnership and its active mentorship of winners from the maiden edition held in early 2024. He underscored the Hackathon's alignment with President Bola Ahmed Tinubu's eight-point agenda and emphasized the untapped digital potential of Nigerian youth.
