


OUR STORY 50 FAR

At Speak! for the Unspoken, we rescue, rehabilitate, and rehome special needs dogs and cats—especially double merles born with hearing and vision impairments due to irresponsible breeding.

We believe that every animal, regardless of ability, deserves a life full of love, joy, and dignity. Through rescue, education, and advocacy, we challenge misconceptions about special needs pets and prove that these animals aren't broken—they're simply extraordinary.

Speak! Nation,

As I mark my eighth year as Executive Director of Speak! for the Unspoken, I'm filled with gratitude and awe. What began as a handful of passionate volunteers in Grove City making calls to shelters in search of double merle dogs has grown into a life-saving network spanning six states. Today, we field hundreds of calls each week from across the country—each one a plea for help for a dog or cat with special needs. And together, we've answered those calls—over 2,900 lives saved and counting.

2024 has been a year of impact and resilience. This year alone, we saved 185 animals, ensuring they received the medical care, rehabilitation, and love they needed to thrive. Our total medical costs reached \$250,000, covering everything from routine vaccines to emergency surgeries. One of our most unforgettable success stories was Linus—a young husky abandoned in a livestock trailer. After being rescued, Linus developed a mysterious illness that required weeks of isolation, advanced diagnostics, and care from multiple vet hospitals. Thanks to your generosity, Linus made a full recovery and is now thriving in a loving home!

As we continue to grow, Speak! is at a pivotal moment. The need for our services has never been greater, and to keep expanding our reach, we must strengthen our foundation. In 2024, we took a major step forward by hiring our first-ever employee, Chelsea DeRosa, our Development Director. While Speak! remains 99% volunteer-run, Chelsea has been instrumental in refining our internal processes, challenging us to think bigger, and leading our first-ever Giving Tuesday campaign, which raised over \$26,000. This milestone proved that when we take bold steps forward, our community rises to meet the challenge.

Speak! is powered by people—our fosters, volunteers, and donors. You make this mission possible. And as our motto says, Special Needs and Good Deeds go hand in paw. Here's to another year of saying "yes" to the animals who need us most.

RESCUE HAS NO BORDERS


WHILE OTHERS SAY NO, WE FIND A WAY

In 2024, **105 foster families** gave dogs and cats the second chance they needed. What started in Ohio has now expanded across the Midwest, with rescues coming from **12 states**—each one with a different story and an urgent need.



WHERE OUR DOGS COME FROM




In 2024, most of our dogs came from puppy mills, owner surrenders, and shelters—each an extremely vulnerable situation where special needs pets are often out of options. **We couldn't say no.**





We rescued 185 animals and found homes for 204—185 from this year, plus 19 who had been waiting since last year. As foster homes decline and adoption rates shift, we're finding new ways to connect pets with the people who need them most.






In 2024, you helped raise 327,000-57% from donors like you. We spent 249,000 on rescue care—including 122,000 for lifesaving vet care.
