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Executive Summary

GeoTE Tanzania in collaboration with YouthMappers, is spearheading a geospatial training program that integrates open geospatial technologies into university curricula. This initiative includes a five-week **Field Practical Training (FPT)** at Sokoine University of Agriculture, engaging over 60 students and with plans to expand to other academic institutions. Midway through the FPT, a one-day event **“GeoSpark”** connects YouthMappers students with YouthMappers alumni, faculty and industry experts for skill-building, inspiration, recognition and networking, offering students insights into career opportunities

WHAT WE SUPPORT

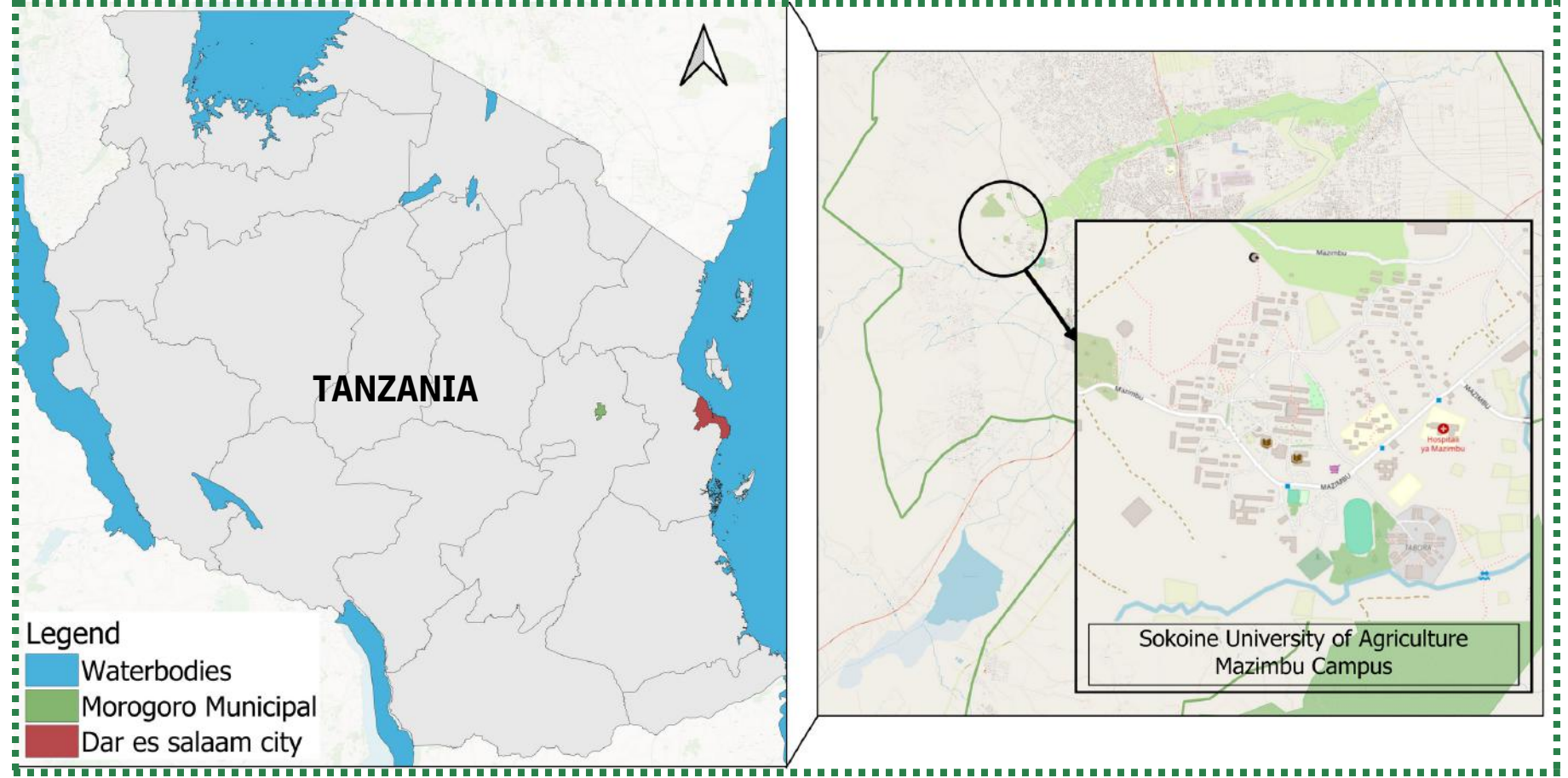




- In partnership with Sokoine University we have secured in-kind support for two computer labs that can accommodate over 60+ students, equipped to support students during the 5 weeks FPT

TIMELINE



Month, Year	Activity	Description
October, 2024	Initiation and Planning	Establishing goals and objectives, identifying key stakeholders, outlining primary activities, forming a planning committee, and developing sponsorship packages for outreach
November, 2024	Stakeholder Engagement & Resource Mobilization	Initiate outreach to key stakeholders, partners, to secure commitments, and collaborate in designing FPT modules, defining challenges and mapping projects
December 2024 to January 2025	Co-Design, Logistics & Outreach	Finalize program design with partners, secure venues and Goodies for FPT and GeoSpark, university student recruitment, and finalize sponsorships.
February 2025	Pre-Event Preparation & Briefing	Conduct staff training, prepare materials and resources, hold stakeholder review meetings, and deliver a final program briefing to all facilitators and sponsors
March –April 2025	FPT & GeoSpark 2025	Conduct the 5-week FPT, culminating in the GeoSpark event on March 22, followed by a project ideation and pitch week for students presentations to sponsors
May – September 2025	Feedback & Future Planning	Collect feedback from participants and compile a post-event report to assess program impact, share findings and lay the groundwork for next year's program.

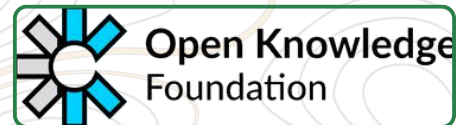
