

Flavors of Tuscany | Itinerary and Highlights (subject to change)

Day 1: EN ROUTE FROM U.S.

Day 2: ARRIVE IN FLORENCE, ITALY I CASTELLINA Upon arrival an Orbridge representative will be waiting to assist with your transfer to the property. Take time to unpack and settle in before joining fellow travel companions for a convivial four-course welcome dinner. Overnight: Castello La Leccia (D)

- Day 3: CASTELLO LA LECCIA Today meet with chefs from the property for an informative, hands-on cooking experience, then indulge on your creations during a leisurely lunch. The remainder of the afternoon take advantage of free time to fully immerse yourself in Castello La Leccia's varied amenities. Later gather together for a guided vineyard tour and wine tasting. Overnight: Castello La Leccia (B,L,D)
- Day 4: PIENZA Set out for the charming village of Pienza. This UNESCO World Heritage Site was designed to exemplify the principles and philosophy of classical times and the great Italian Renaissance. Continue to Podere Il Casale, a small organic farm, to meet the owners for a tour followed by lunch. Return to the property with time to freshen up before another five-star gastronomic experience—a specially crafted four-course dinner.

Overnight: Castello La Leccia (B,L,D)

Day 5: CORTONA Travel to the hilltop town of Cortona where a local guide will escort you through neo-Gothic Santa Margherita Basilica, past Villa Bramasole, around Cortona's city center, and to the Etruscan museum. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure to explore Cortona. Overnight: Castello La Leccia (B,D)



Day 6: VOLTERRA I SAN GIMIGNANO Stroll through Volterra's bustling, narrow streets before reaching an overlook to view the ancient Roman theatre. Continue to San Gimignano for an inside visit to its Romanesque Duomo. Afterward meet Sergio Dondoli, master gelato creator and owner of Gelateria Dondoli and taste his decadent

Overnight: Castello La Leccia (B,D)

Day 7: MONTERIGGIONI I CASTELLINA IN CHIANTI I GAIOLE Visit the walled medieval village of Monteriggioni —a popular stop on the Via Francigena pilgrim trail. See the medieval abbey at Abbadia a Isola, then stroll through the shops in the small village of Castellina in Chianti. This evening visit Badia a Coltibuono for a cooking class with Benedetta Vitali who will demonstrate the simple techniques and preparations of classic Tuscan dishes. Afterward gather in the dining room for a special dinner. Overnight: Castello La Leccia (B,L,D)

Day 8: SIENA Today explore Siena—a UNESCO World Heritage Site—including its celebrated Duomo and the Sanctuary of Santa Caterina. During free time wander the shell-shaped Piazza del Campo. This afternoon meet Lorenzo Rossi, a third-generation artisan baker and owner of Il Magnifico. He will share his special family traditions of baking unique Sienese sweets. Tonight join fellow travel companions for a farewell dinner. Overnight: Castello La Leccia (B,D)

Day 9: CASTELLINA | FLORENCE | DEPART FOR U.S. After breakfast transfer to the airport for flights home. (B)

(B = Breakfast, L = Lunch, D = Dinner)





What's Included

Accommodations (subject to change)

Become part of *la famiglia* as you settle into this authentic Tuscan wine estate. Sip a glass of Chianti on a sun-dappled terrace, stroll the grounds and admire vineyards draped with Sangiovese, Merlot and Petit Verdot grapes.

Historical sources cite that La Leccia castle's ownership was divided among 16 owners for strategic purposes. Near the mid-1400s, the Ricasoli family dominated a large part of the Chianti Classico region as well as the castle.

After being modified to serve more as a villa in the 18th century, the entire property was purchased in 1920 by Giuliano Daddi, greatgrandfather of the current proprietors, and subsequently was the site of heavy bombardments during WWII that destroyed part of the tower, the last medieval testimony and devastated a wing of the villa.

Recently undergoing more than four years of careful and rigorous restoration, the castle and the surrounding garden have returned to life.

With a focus on sustainability and the environment, the original spaces remain intact but feature modern enhancements using eco-compatible materials and technologies. To warm the surroundings, wooden floors, beamed ceilings, pastel colors and furniture were designed exclusively for the common spaces and made by Florentine craftsmen.

Each room offers climate control, desk, LCD TV, complimentary Wi-Fi, phone, safe, minibar, and en suite bathroom with a shower or tub and shower, sundries and hairdryer.

CATEGORIES

Superior: Enjoy elegant furnishings and a serene area to unwind after an enriching day of exploration (approx. 301-484 sq.ft.).

Deluxe: Delight in absolute refinement with beautiful views of the surrounding countryside. Each room is different from the others, but all provide modern comforts and tasteful décor (approx. 452-603 sq.ft.).







Optional Post-Tour Florence

Florence is arguably the cultural capital of Europe and the showcase of Renaissance exuberance. Lovers of beauty, art and history can extend their experience in Tuscany to embrace the treasures of this magnificent city.

Day 9: DEPART CASTELLINA | ARRIVE IN FLORENCE Upon arrival meet a local art historian guide for a walking tour of the historic city center. Discover the city's beginnings as a Roman settlement, wander through narrow streets past the fortified houses and towers that marked the medieval town and emerge onto the open Piazza della Signoria, the political center of the city since the Middle Ages. See the Duomo and Ponte Vecchio, then visit the local market for lunch. Taste different local specialties then enjoy a sweet break with an Italian cappuccino or scoop of gelato. This afternoon explore the hidden craft workshops of artisans who create jewels and leather goods—flagships of Tuscan local production. And finally, weather permitting, set out on a private boat excursion on the river Arno. Sail underneath the Ponte Vecchio and capture views of the Uffizi Gallery and palaces that are part of Florence's history. Return to the hotel for an evening at leisure. Overnight: Hotel De La Ville (L)

Day 10: FLORENCE Join your guide to visit the Baptistery of San Giovanni, one of the oldest churches in Florence. Next enjoy a tour of the Uffizi Gallery[†] which has drawn visitors to view masterpieces by important artists of the Renaissance, including Da Vinci, Giotto, Botticelli, Tiziano and Michelangelo. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure. Overnight: Hotel De La Ville (B)

Day 11: FLORENCE I DEPART FOR U.S. After breakfast guests departing during the suggested times take the complimentary transfer to the airport for flights home. (B)

[†]The Uffizi Gallery tour is included in this itinerary because it holds a significant number of masterpieces. Touring will conclude at approximately 12:30 pm. Guests who would like to see Michelangelo's statue of David at Accademia Gallery may additionally schedule their own visit during leisure time.
