





CELEBRATING PABLO

THE FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF PABLO PICASSO'S DEATH



Málaga's amazing regeneration from a dirty and dismal forgotten city, known only for its airport, to one of the most popular cultural, leisure and sporting destinations in Spain owes a huge debt to Picasso, who was born in the city on October 25, 1881.

One of the major factors in kick-starting Málaga's renaissance in 2003 was the pioneering Museo Picasso Málaga. As well as celebrating the 50th anniversary of Picasso's death, the Museo is also celebrating its 20th anniversary. Housed in the beautifully restored Palacio de Buenavista, the permanent collection of over 400 works includes unmissable works ranging from Portrait of Lola

(Picasso's sister, painted in A Coruña in 1894) to Jacqueline Seated (an early portrait of his second wife, Jacqueline Roque Hutin, from 1954).

October sees the latest of a series of exhibitions celebrating the anniversary. Curated by Eric Troncy, from Tuesday,

October 3 the Museo Picasso Málaga will be hosting the second and last exhibition of the year, The Echo of Picasso. The exhibition explores the effect of Picasso's unparalleled influence on contemporary art and today's art scene. Works by Picasso will be shown alongside those of artists who acknowledged his influence, such as Francis Bacon, Martin Kippenberger and





Maria Lassnig, as well as contemporary artists like Claire Tabouret and Rashid Johnson.

Picasso's innovative techniques ranged from welded iron to painted bronze, and from collage to the use of everyday materials as supports or constitutive elements of an artwork. They also encompass ceramics, a technique that Picasso was one of the first to inscribe in the artistic language of the second half of the twentieth century.

For those who might question whether Picasso has any relevance in contemporary Spain, Matter and Body, the previous exhibition at the Museo Picasso Málaga, attracted over 150,000 people!

Picasso's birthplace, the 19th-century townhouse overlooking the Plaza de Merced on the edge of Málaga's wonderfully atmospheric casco antiguo (old town), has also joined

in the celebrations this year. Now converted into the Museo Casa Natal Picasso, The Ages of Pablo, is an exhibition charting the stages and styles of the master's lifelong career and runs until the end of October.

Any time is, however, good to explore the permanent collection here: highlights include over 80 sketches for his landmark 1907 painting *Les Femmes d'Alger* (which now hangs in New York's MoMA). As well as this, the Casa Natal will be updating its catalogue of works and including the portraits by Juan Gyenes, one of the very few photographers who Picasso allowed into his home and his studio. It will also be publishing books featuring its collection of ceramics by Picasso, as well as the sketchbook he used as he prepared to paint "*Les Femmes d'Alger*".

Although Malaga is celebrating the death of its most famous son half a century ago, it is doing

so in extremely 21st century style. The city has created an immersive virtual space inspired by Picasso or a whole metaverse where anyone the planet can attend conferences, contests and concerts on Picasso from any device. But if you prefer the more traditional way of immersing yourself, a free audio guide is available to visitors with information on all of the places that formed part of the artist's life, as well as new signage on the city's Picasso Route.

Picasso's extraordinary inventiveness, formidable stylistic freedom, scant interest in convention and compulsive creativity loom large over contemporary artists. He is probably the only artist so frequently cited, interpreted, evoked, reprised, commented and celebrated in the works of his contemporary and later peers. If you ask anyone to name three famous painters, Picasso will feature in the answer.

MARBELLA FILM FESTIVAL

LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION!



The festival is the brainchild of film producer Mac Chakaveh, who recognised the importance of Marbella hosting this type of cultural event with an international image.

Marbella will be buzzing with actors, directors, producers and other movers and shakers from the movie world as the Marbella International Film Festival gets underway in October.

Now in its 18th year, the Festival, which runs from October 5-8, will highlight more than 30 films, some of them world premieres, at the Red Dog Cinemas in Puerto Banus. This includes shorts, feature films and documentaries, and the films are screened in their original version with English and Spanish subtitles.



The Festival has expanded considerably since its launch in 2006, in collaboration with the Marbella Town Hall and Tourist Board, Marbella Film Office and the Andalucía Film Commission. The social aspect of the festival, based at the Hard Rock Hotel Marbella, includes several glamorous evening events – perfect for networking and culminates in the Gala Awards Ceremony at the Melia Marbella Banus on October 8.

With a truly global reach, last year's Marbella International Film Festival screened films from countries including the United Kingdom, Spain, the United States, Ukraine, Brazil, Georgia, Honduras, China and South Korea,

while actors including Kevin McNally, Nicole Faraday, Terry Stone and Emily Wyatt were present at the gala. Other famous actors at previous galas have included William Shatner, Steven Berkoff, Kris Marshall, Craig Fairbrass and Timothy Spall.

The festival is the brainchild of film producer Mac Chakaveh, who recognised the importance of Marbella hosting this type of cultural event with an international image. Over the years, Mac has carefully curated the wide variety and genre of films from all over the world that has become the festival's trademark.


Underlining the international aspect of

the awards, last year's Best Feature went to 'Secrets', the Brazilian drama directed and starring the talented Emiliano Ruschel. Kevin McNally was a deservedly popular winner as Best Actor for 'Musketeer' – the "Pirates of The Caribbean" star looking relaxed on his first visit to Marbella while Best Actress was Nicole Faraday for 'Not by The Book' – a British Comedy/Crime caper.

Highlights of this year's festival include hard-hitting documentaries such as 'The Wagner Group. Putin's Mercenaries' that uncovers the

true face of the organisation that its late leader, Yevgeny Prigozhin, boasted “will win over Ukraine, and later over NATO and the whole world”.

“The Invisible - Modern Slavery in Europe” documents the plight of the 28 million people who live in working conditions that are considered modern slavery. The film tells the story of the 100,000 harvest workers in Huelva, Spain, who talk about their lives. Feature films include “Brighton 4th” the story of Kakhi, a Georgian ex-wrestler who travels from Tbilisi to Brighton Beach, Brooklyn, to help his son Soso find a way out of a gambling debt and “I am Gitmo” set in Guantanamo Bay, shortly after 9/11.

On a lighter note, the Marbella International Film Festival also includes screenings of “Nessie”. The British comedy has the villagers

of Loch Ness trying to prove Nessie is real to receive \$50million bequeathed to them in a will. “Kindling” is a coming of age drama that sees a group of young men who return to their hometown in order to turn their friend’s final days into a celebration of life and friendship.

Finally, the successful Rise of the Footsoldier franchise is back with the latest chapter in the saga. “Rise of the Footsoldier:Vengeance” sees anti-hero Tate embarking on a rampage to avenge a violent death. To track down the villain responsible, Tate ventures beyond his comfort zone of Essex and into the dark side of 90s Soho. As well as being one of the most popular features at the festival, the Footsoldier franchise has gained a reputation for having the liveliest showing and best after party in Marbella!



BRILLIANT BENAHAVIS

THE POPULAR PUEBLO BLANCO THAT IS ONE OF
THE MOST VIBRANT OPEN SECRETS ON THE COAST.



Driving up the recently completed new road takes you past the Atalaya Golf Course and into the Municipality of Benahavis. You are immediately struck by the modern new developments on either side, and catch a fleeting glimpse of several others – including the recently announced Tierra Villas, whose design is inspired by renowned supercar brand Automobili Lamborghini.



Five minutes' later the road runs dramatically along a gorge with the Guadalmina River flowing down to your right. This is a popular spot for the adventure sport of canyoning, and you will spot brave individuals leaping from the rocks into the Charca de las Mozas, a deep natural pool that has been designated a "Natural monument" by the Junta de Andalucía.

Overlooking Benahavis itself are the ruins of Montemayor Castle. This Arabic stronghold was erected in the 10th century during Al – Andalus, the 700-year-period when the Moors ruled most of southern Spain. Its commanding views across to Africa highlight the strategic importance of the location. After the Christians reconquered

the region most of the castle was destroyed, just in case the Moors should attempt to retake it.

The views across from Montemayor Castle also take in the millionaires' playground of La Zagaleta. Once a huge private estate, La Zagaleta is now home to the super rich who like their privacy, including Hugh Grant, Rod Stewart and powerful





figures from the worlds of international business and politics. The highly visible security underlines the fact that La Zagaleta is the most expensive real estate per square metre in Spain.

Stroll through the streets of Benahavis and you will quickly realise why the village is so popular. Several years ago, the Town Hall came up with a brilliant concept to attract visitors - its food. Calling itself the culinary centre of the Costa del Sol, Benahavis is packed with restaurants of every style you could wish for – from tapas to traditional Spanish, south east Asian to Indian. The most famous restaurant in Benahavis is Los Albinacos, which has been serving superb Spanish food in a traditional low-key setting for decades, while the luxury Anantara Villia Padierna Hotel, on the southernmost edge of the municipality, has a superb range of

culinary experiences. If you need to work off the extra calories from all that food, then Benahavis has more than enough activities. As well as the aforementioned canyoning, there are great walking trails and mountain biking routes through the countryside, as well as some challenging hikes. As always in Spain, golf is an option, with courses including Los Flamings Golf, Los Arqueros Golf, Monte Mayor and La Zagaleta – although the latter is strictly invitation only!

If culture is more your thing, Benahavis Town Hall organises film screenings, lectures, comedy shows and theatre performances in its state-of-the-art theatre. The beautiful Torre de la Leonera Park, just a short walk from the centre of the pueblo, hosts open-air performances and concerts in its amphitheatre, weather permitting. No trip to Benahavis is complete

without checking out the incredible sculptures of David Marshall. A long time Benahavis resident, who now divides his time between Spain and Colorado, David's singular style has proved hugely popular around the world. Located at the top end of the main street, the gallery showcases both his sculptures and interior design pieces.

Last, but certainly not least, is the Benahavis Sunday market. More than just a boot sale, the Benahavis rastro is a brilliant mix of the functional, the flippant and the downright fabulous! The stalls offer all kinds of items and products, from antiques to clothes, fruit and vegetables to garage sale specials. With a food truck that sells the best churros to be found anywhere on a Sunday, the rastro is fun, busy and friendly – which is what Benahavis is in a nutshell!

JAMON, JAMON

SPANISH GASTRONOMY AT ITS BEST

There are some things that Spain has given the world that we have to be truly thankful for. Picasso, Paco de Lucia, the siesta and flamenco just to begin with, and that is before you get to the gastronomy. With its wonderfully fresh produce, Spain is regarded as being at the forefront of modern cuisine. As any chef will tell you, it is all about the quality of the ingredients, and there is no better example of this quality than jamón ibérico: "Iberian ham".



“Iberian Ham” is as far away from the ham that you add to your cheese sandwich as the Valderrama golf course is to Crazy Golf. The acorn fed Iberian pigs that produce the ham are entirely native to Spain. A completely different breed to the Duroc pigs that provide jamón serrano, Iberian pigs have a dark grey and black colouring, with jet-black hooves. Which is where the term “pata negra” – black hoof comes from. (As an aside, don’t make the mistake of making “pata” masculine as I once did, when I ordered “pato negro”. If the waiter hadn’t corrected me, I might have ended up with a plate of black duck – “pato”).

The history of the jamón ibérico deigns when

the Phoenicians first settled on the Iberian Peninsula and brought their domesticated pigs with them. These pigs crossbred with local wild boars, giving birth to the Iberian pig. When the Romans conquered Iberia, they brought the curing process that they had witnessed in their German colonies. The result was immediately popular, with Roman scholars praising the quality of the hams.

Needless to say, interest in ham eating ceased during the 700 years of Islamic Moorish Spain. After the “Reconquista” of 1492, however, with the Christian King and Queen Ferdinand and Isabella back in charge, ham eating became a de facto symbol of the new Spain. To produce the jamon

iberico, the piglets are fattened on a diet of barley, before being are then released onto the “dehesa”, farmland that has oak forests, wild herbs and grass. They are free to graze - and they do, eating up to 20 kilos of acorns every day. This has two side effects; a much higher fat-to-meat ratio than other pigs and, due to the large amount of acorns scooped, the pigs absorb oleic acid; the same fatty acid found in olive oil and which share some of the same health benefits. The flavour of the acorns also permeates into the meat, giving it a delicate and unique flavour.

In order to ensure the quality of the jamón, the Spanish government controls the production and sale of ham. All Iberian hams have a tag just above the hoof, with a black tag signifying that it has come from a pig that is 100% genetically Iberian, has roamed the dehesa, eaten an acorn-based diet and been cured for a minimum of 36 months.

In addition to this, the E.U. recognises only four protected appellations of Spanish ham. In the same way that Spanish wine and olive oil are designated, these four protected regions are the only places in Spain that are legally allowed to make acorn-fed Iberian ham. They are:

D.O.P. Jabugo: From Andalucía, in the foothills northwest of Seville.

D.O.P. Extremadura: The newest denomination,

this covers the dehesas around Badajoz and Cáceres.

D.O.P. Los Pedroches: Andalucía again, near Córdoba.

D.O.P. Guijuelo: The region that produces 60% of Spain's jamón ibérico de bellota. Surrounding Salamanca in Extremadura, Castilla y León, Castilla La Mancha, and parts of Andalucía.

With such a time-consuming process, jamón ibérico does not come cheap. You can expect to pay anything upwards of €20 for a plate. But when you consider the lives that the Iberian pigs lead, contentedly grazing free on a diet of acorns, raise a glass as you take your first bite and reflect on the fact that these pigs in Spain are, in fact, happier "than pigs in sh..."
