WORKPLACE FATALITIES A STARK REMINDER THAT SAFETY MATTERS EVERYWHERE



The Health and Safety Executive (HSE) has released its latest work-related fatal injury statistics for Great Britain (April 2024 to March 2025). While many of these tragic incidents occurred in high-risk industries like construction and agriculture, the findings offer an urgent reminder: no workplace is immune to risk — whether you're operating in hospitality, education, or an office environment.

Key Findings You Should Know


124 workers lost their lives in work-related incidents last year. While this is lower than the previous year (138), it aligns with prepandemic figures, showing that the danger hasn't gone away.

The most common causes of fatal injuries — including falls from height (35 deaths), being struck by moving objects (18 deaths), and collapse/overturning incidents (17 deaths) — can happen in any workplace, not just high-risk settings.

Tragically, 92 members of the public also died in work-related incidents. These were individuals not employed at the workplace — such as visitors, customers, parents, delivery drivers, or contractors. This highlights the critical importance of protecting everyone, not just employees.

Mesothelioma Still a Major Threat

In 2023, 2,218 people died from mesothelioma, a cancer caused by past asbestos exposure. This remains a real concern in older buildings, especially in schools, offices, and hospitality venues. Effective asbestos management must remain a top priority in buildings constructed before 2000.


