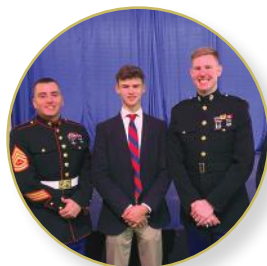
Students were served by Riverview Learning Center during 2023-2024.

You set a firm foundation for future generations of Nation Changers to be fully equipped and empowered in Christ through a campus environment that truly reflects the excellence of our community. The Upper School building officially opened on August 7, surrounded by faithful donors committed to the ongoing success of the StoneBridge mission.

Your generosity also equipped the immediate improvements prompted by the building completion.

- 1** The Annex was remodeled to include 3 classrooms with in-room bathrooms for Preschool and Pre-Kindergarten.
- 2** Two modulares by the gym were renovated to house the Library, Student Support Services, Extended Care, and the Lower School Art Room.
- 3** The main front wing of the campus was renovated to house Upper School classrooms, reducing student movement outside the building.
- 4** The back parking lot was repaved, reconfigured and restriped, with much-needed lighting, curbs, and added landscaping.

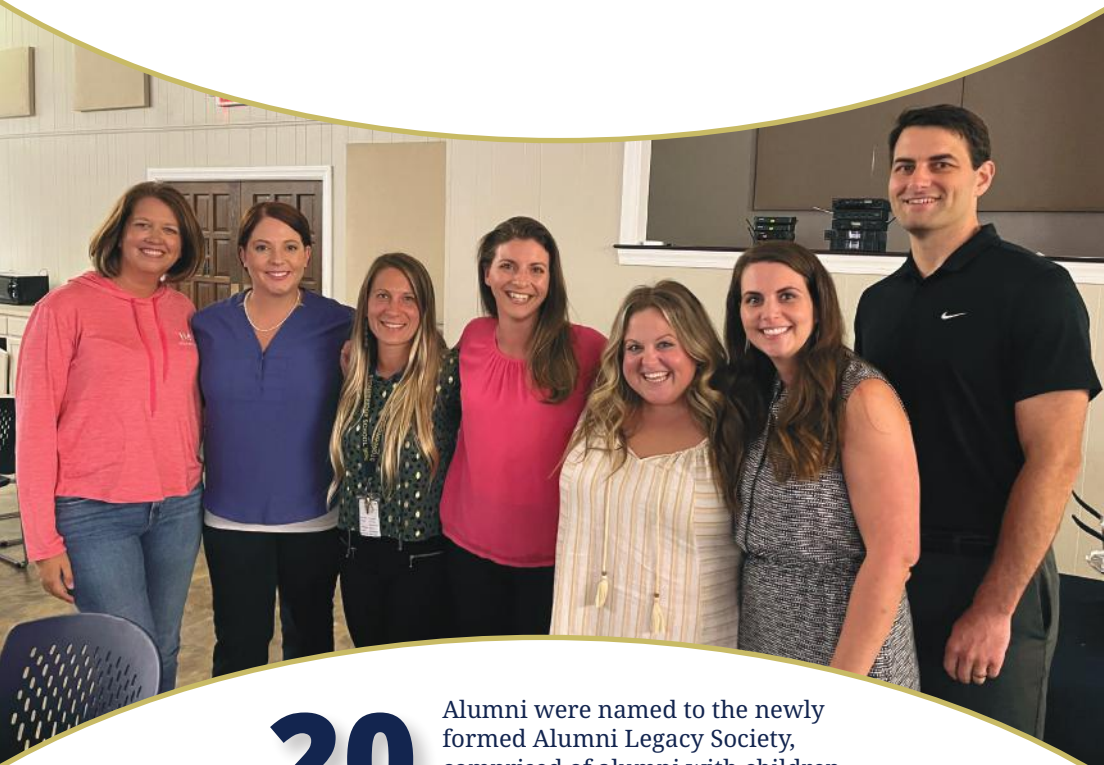


YOU ARE CREATING A LEGACY

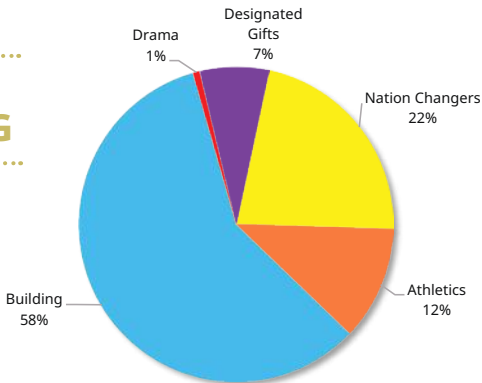
