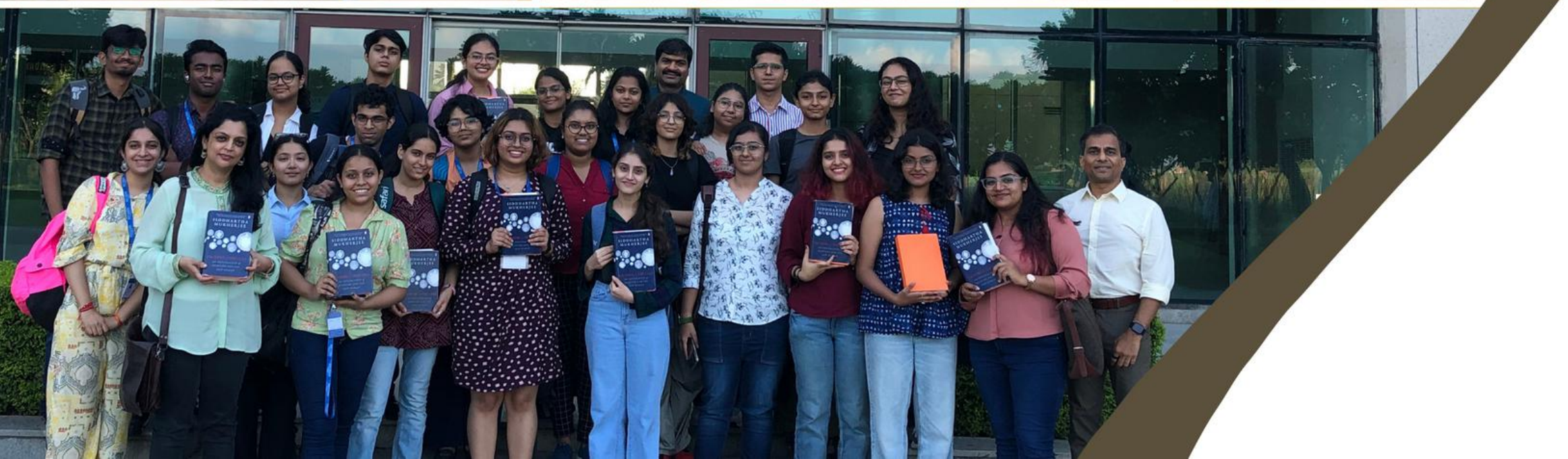




VISION AND MISSION

- Fund regional meetings to support local networking and collaboration

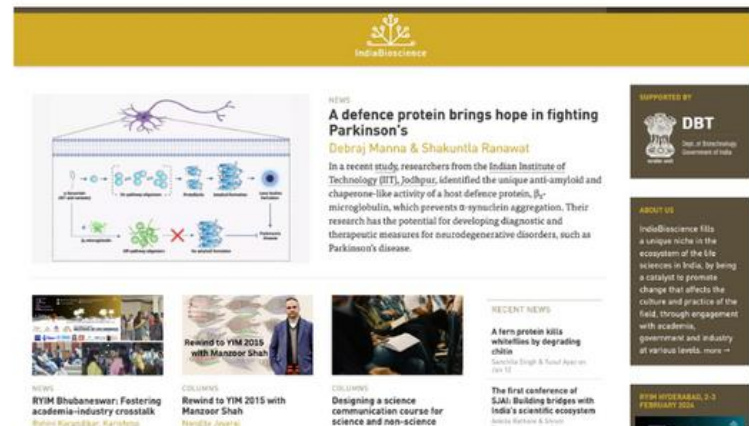

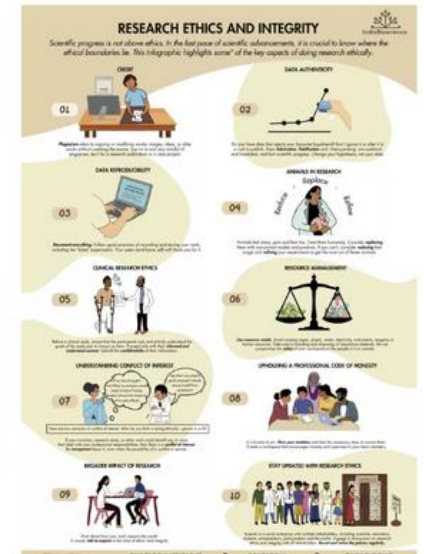
- iGAP provides information and resources for international grant applications from Indian life science researchers.

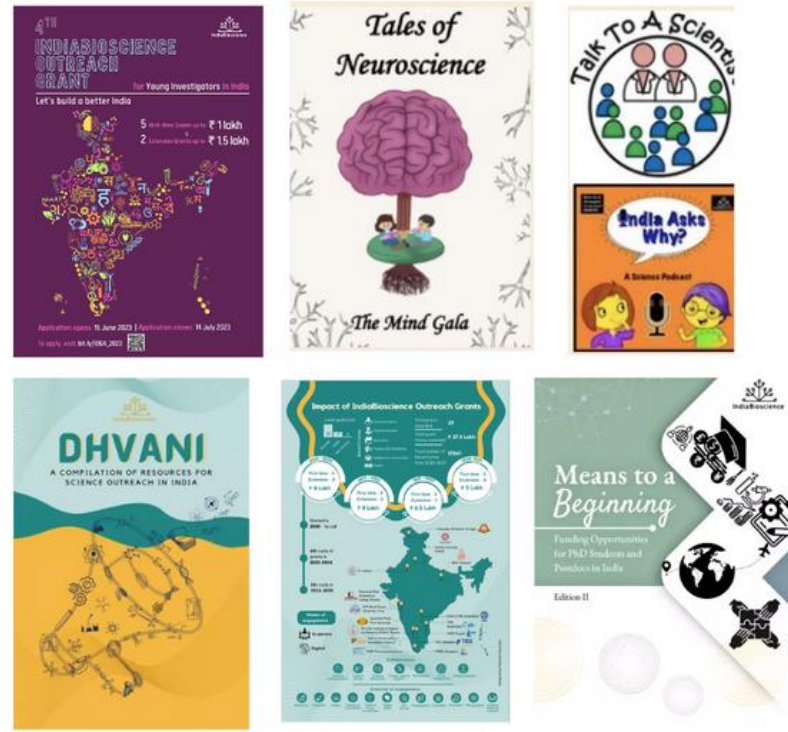

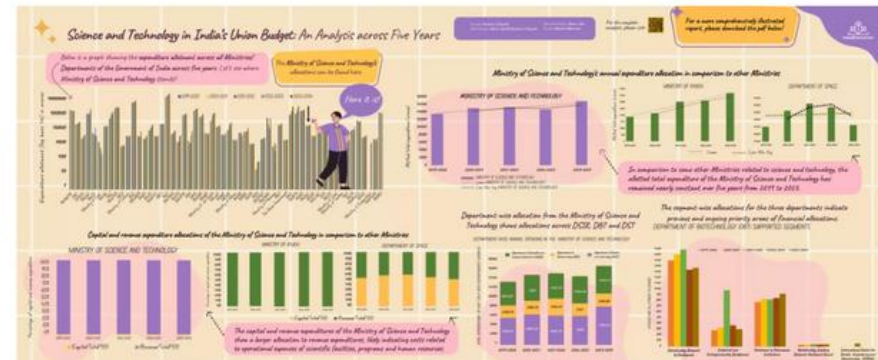
