#### **Bull Branch Upsizing Phase I**

Phase 1 of the Bull Branch sewer improvement project will upgrade existing infrastructure from West Lake Drive to West 12th Street, including upsizing from Main Street to East Seventh Street and from East Seventh to Robinson Park. This is the first of a proposed 3–5 phases, focusing on lower Bull Branch.

Construction is progressing at the Doris Roznovak Aquatic Center in Murphy Park. Crews are finishing up the main support piers and will soon begin pouring the main shell of the pool. Piers for the water slide are coming up next. The new pool will also feature a playscape, lap lanes, and a lazy river.

#### **TH Johnson/Lake Drive Street Maintenance**

The 2024 Street Conditions Assessment identified TH Johnson Drive and Lake Drive as top maintenance priorities. TH Johnson will undergo full-depth reclamation and resurfacing, while Lake Drive will receive targeted repairs and full resurfacing. Both roadways will also be restriped. Work is expected to begin by summer.

The Taylor on Foot community walk program is launching this month!

Its mission is for City leadership to meet residents where they live, foster two-way communication, listen to resident concerns, identify solutions in collaboration with community partners, humanize the City and build trust with residents.

Each quarter, a small team of City and community leaders will be out walking to visit residents at their homes in Taylor.

Those teams will include City Councilmembers, Taylor Police Officers, City staff and other community leaders.

We'll knock on doors and have conversations with residents to listen, learn and work together to make Taylor a better place! We're looking for feedback, suggestions, concerns and complaints. One district will be targeted per quarter with your councilmember choosing the neighborhood we will walk. We will look to talk with residents from up to 50 homes per walk.

The walks will happen on a Saturday morning from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM. Check our website calendar for the upcoming dates and where we plan to walk.

We'll let you know we're coming by placing signs in the district in the month of the walk and distributing door hangers to the 50 homes we plan to visit in the week before we walk.
