


Topics for discussion: holidays and traditions of English-speaking countries

- Why do people wear costumes on Halloween?
- Do you think Halloween should be celebrated worldwide? Why or why not?
- Is there a similar holiday in your country? If yes, how do they compare?







St. Patrick's Day (Ireland)

Discussion Questions

- Who was St. Patrick, and why is he celebrated?
- Why is the color green associated with St. Patrick's Day?
- What are some popular symbols of St. Patrick's Day (e.g., shamrocks, leprechauns)?
- How do people celebrate St. Patrick's Day in Ireland and other countries?
- How do you celebrate cultural or religious figures in your country?







New Year's Traditions (Hogmanay in Scotland)

- Discussion Questions

- Do you think celebrating the New Year is more about fun or reflection?








Valentine's Day
