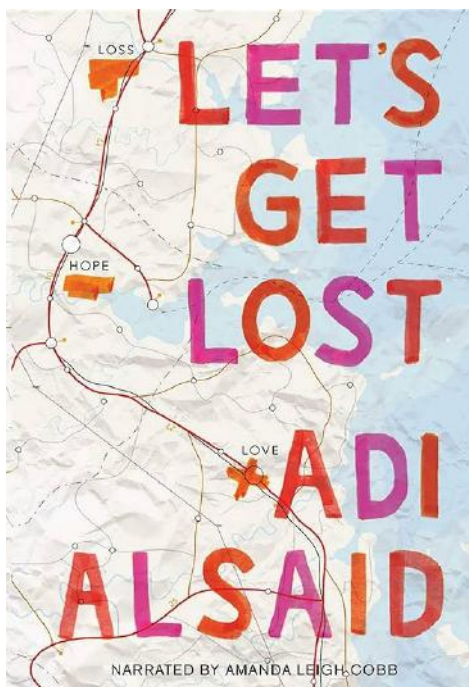

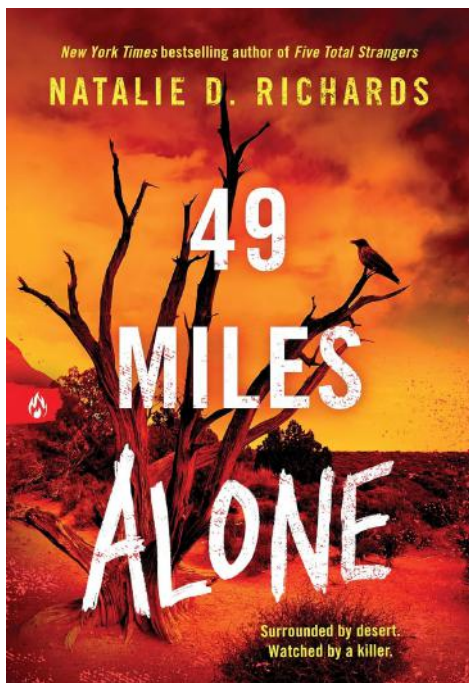




Alsaid, Adi

Let's Get Lost

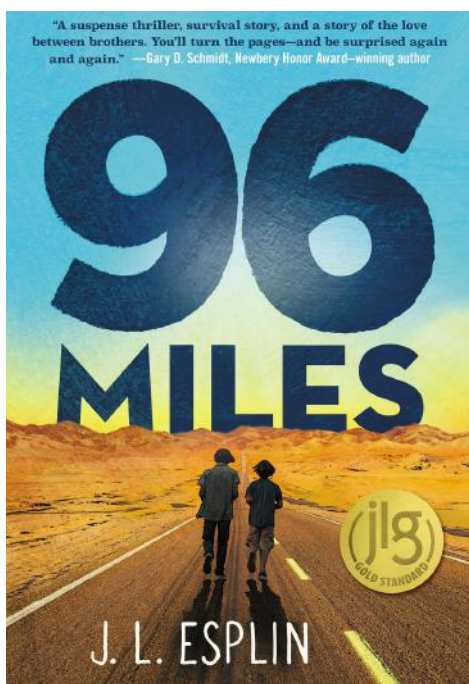

49 Miles Alone

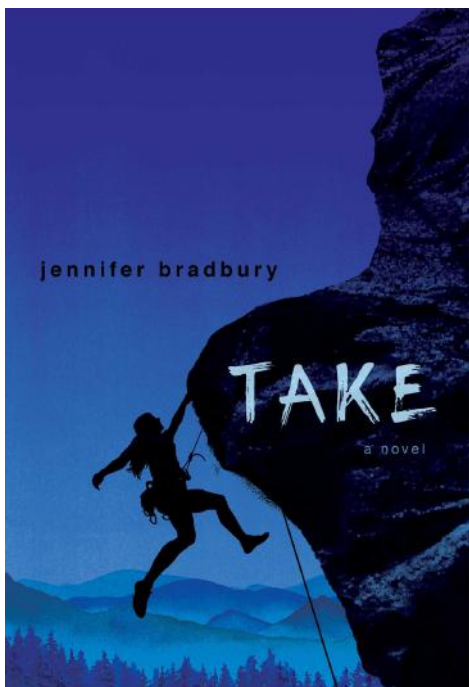

96 Miles

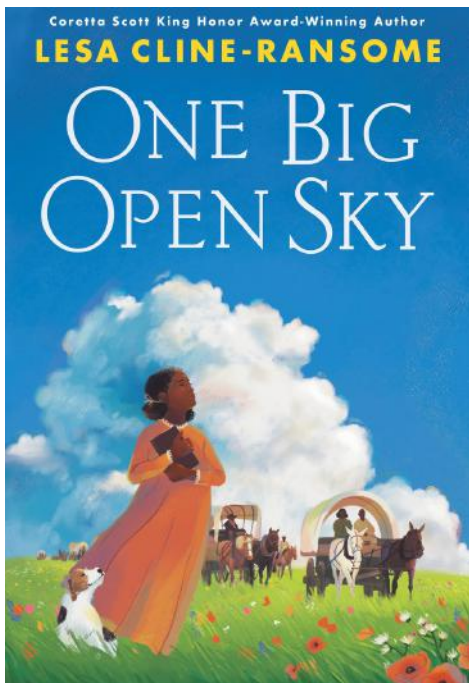

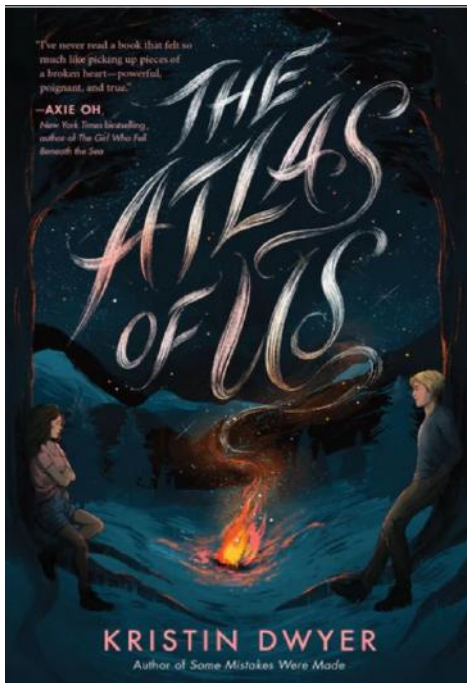
But Thomas' hopes and mouth are bigger than his ability to follow through. With few supplies and even less money, the only thing that feels certain is danger.

The Lake House

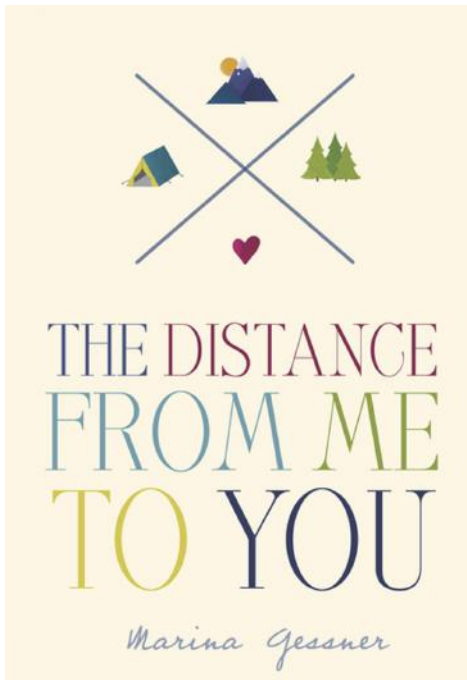

The Atlas of Us

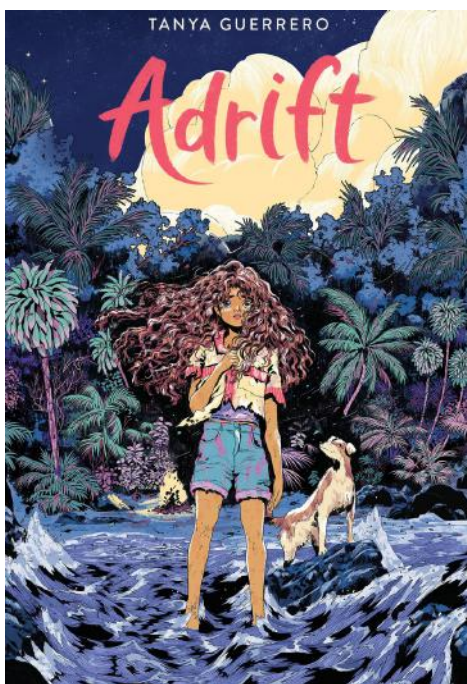

The Distance From Me To You

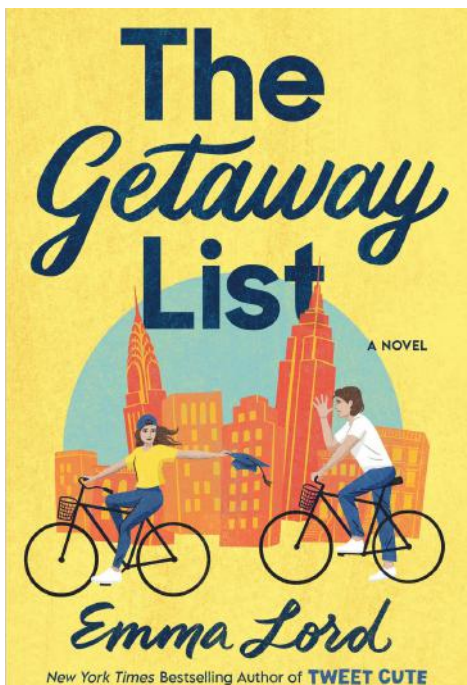

The Getaway List

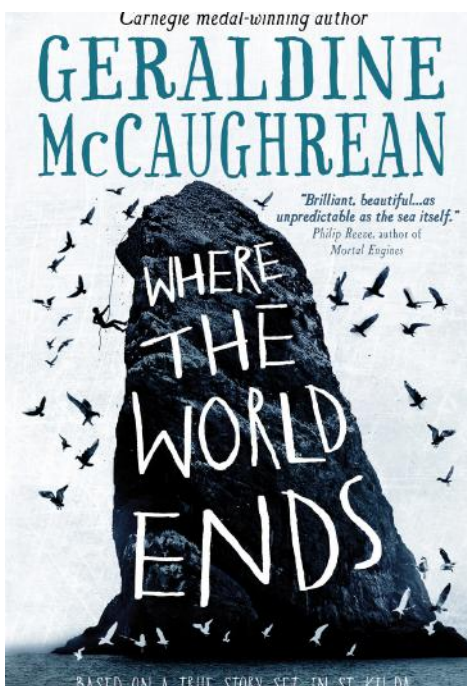

The Secret Library

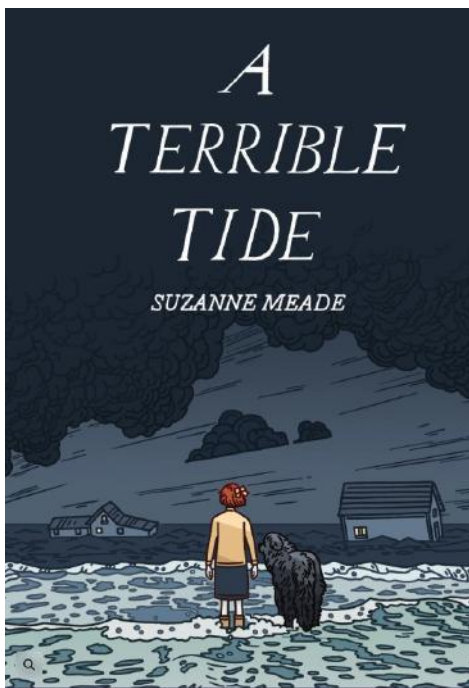

Where the World Ends

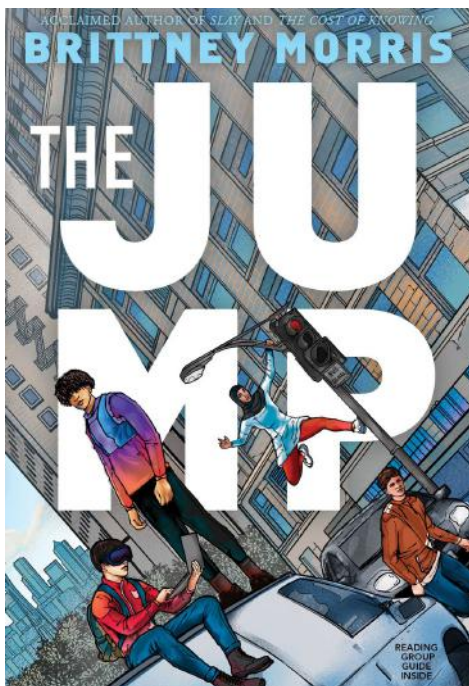
Abandoned on a remote sea stack to harvest birds, Quill and his friends are left to endure storms, starvation, terror and the end of the world while awaiting rescue.

A Terrible Tide

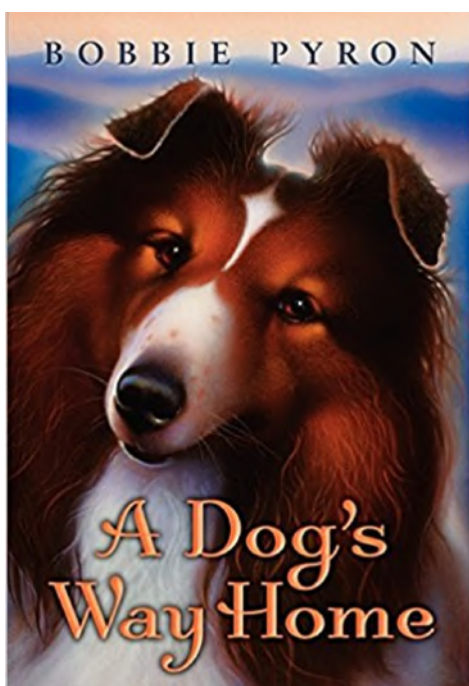

The Jump

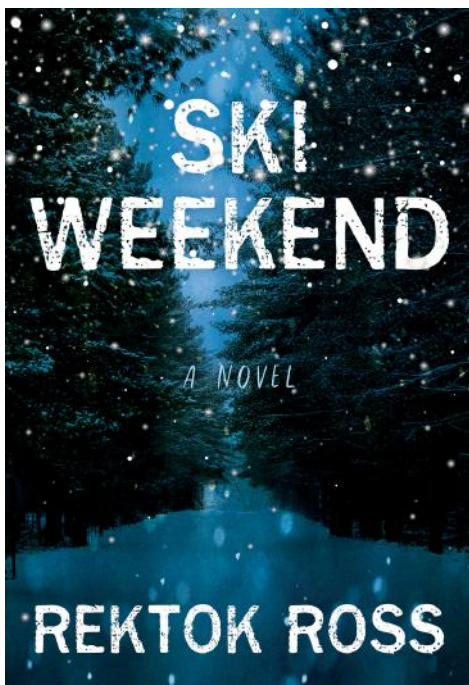

Ski Weekend

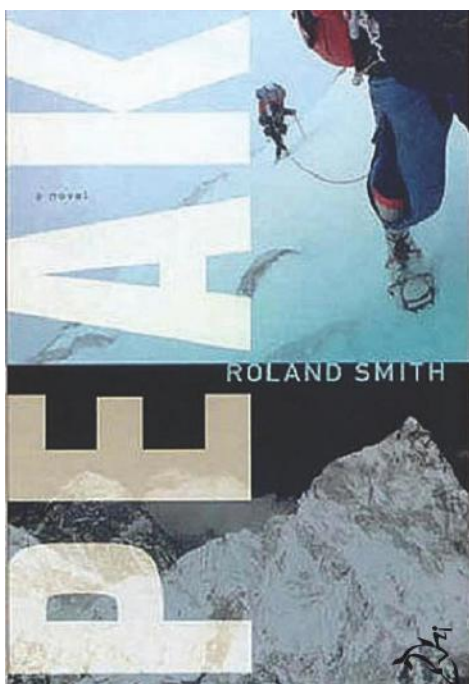
