- THE LABOR FORCE INCREASED BY 2,688 FROM THE PREVIOUS MONTH
- THE NUMBER OF EMPLOYED INDIVIDUALS INCREASED BY 4,212 FROM THE PREVIOUS MONTH
- THE NUMBER OF UNEMPLOYED INDIVIDUALS DECREASED BY 1,524 FROM THE PREVIOUS MONTH

- EL PASO, TX MSA UNEMPLOYMENT WAS AT **4.0**% WITH A TOTAL OF **15,144** UNEMPLOYED INDIVIDUALS
- EL PASO, TX MSA ADDED **3,600** NONFARM JOBS SINCE NOVEMBER 2022
- EL PASO, TX MSA ADDED **2,500** NONFARM JOBS FROM THE PREVIOUS MONTH



The three Super Sectors with the least employment for the El Paso MSA in November 2023 were:


- 1. Financial Activities






EMPLOYMENT in November 2023









UNEMPLOYMENT in November 2023














In the Works
